
Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Mindarie-Halidon Racecourse by Mindarie-Halidon Club on Sunday, 18 September 2022



TRACK: Soft 5(Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)Upgraded to a Good 4 at 1.21 pm retrospective to Race 2(Track with some give in it)

RAIL: True

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 1: RADIO 801-5RM / RADIO 5MU - POWERFM MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

QUIETLY SPOKEN (NZ) (J. Eaton) – steadied inside the 100m away from the heels of HALLSTATT, which shifted out.

RATTLESNAKE RIDGE (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly with its head up.

REGAL MOSHE (S. Fawke) – fractious in the parade ring and again behind the barriers. Co-Trainer Mr J. Hickmott was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its pre- race and barrier manners. On jumping away was steadied when bumped by JUSTICA'S BONUS.

TOUGH PARTY (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped JUSTICA'S BONUS onto REGAL MOSHE.

HALLSTATT (J. Doyle) - shifted out under pressure inside the 100m hampering QUIETLY SPOKEN (NZ). Rider was reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

JUSTICA'S BONUS (J. Hampson) – crowded and buffeted at the start between TOUGH PARTY and REGAL MOSHE.

RACE 2: PPHS PTY LTD / COLLINS INDUSTRIAL PTY LTD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

DIVINE WATERS (A. Lindsay) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

PRINCESS EMMELINE (S. Fawke) - slow into stride.

RACE 2: PPHS PTY LTD / COLLINS INDUSTRIAL PTY LTD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres (Cont'd)

STREET HUSTLER (S. Metcalfe) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was almost 12 months since it last raced and was deemed suitable to race.

SUGAR GLIDER (K. Sardelic) - had its tongue tie replaced upon arrival at the barriers. Trainer, Mr S. Whittle was issued a warning and reminded of his obligations in relation to tongue ties in accordance with the National Gear Registrar.

LOTZA BUBBLES (K. Crowther) - raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: KELVIN WESTBROOK TRANSPORT & FEEDLOT / LOXTON IRRIGATION CENTRE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1380 Metres

SOARLIKEANEAGLE (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MYSTIC GALAXY (J. Benbow) – difficult to load. Trainer Mr T. Doudle was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to being difficult to load. Hung in, in the straight and proved difficult to ride. Mr T. Doudle was advised a warning had been placed in relation to its racing manners.

NUFEN SPECIAL (B. Price) - slow to begin. When questioned the rider explained that after being slow to begin, the mare travelled well however, when placed under pressure made abnormal respiratory noises. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery and exhibiting abnormal upper respiratory noise. Co-Trainer Mr D. Clarken was advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

MIZZ BEEBEEFF (M. Collett) - stumbled on jumping away.

TOMMY TOMATO (F. Atkinson) - hung out rounding the first turn.

RACE 4: FLEA & DOUG FULLSTON BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

GRAND HOST (T. Pannell) - shifted in at the start and bumped RODNEY.

DUSTIN DHAHRAN (R. Hurdle) - held up momentarily near the 350m behind LORD VARYS. Held up again near the 200m being GRAND HOST and to the inside of TOUGH LASSIE.

LINAS MAGIC (B. Vorster) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced for over a year and was deemed suitable to race.

RODNEY (A. Lindsay) - bumped and crowded at the start between GRAND HOST and UTAH JOE, which both shifted ground.

TOUGH LASSIE (D. Caboche) - laid in, in the early stages of the straight.

UTAH JOE (J. Potter) - shifted out at the start and bumped RODNEY.

RACE 5 - MALLEE DIPPING AND MULESING / ZADOW WELL DRILLERS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1380 Metres

DON'T WAIVER (S. Fawke) - stood flat-footed at the start and lost considerable ground. Trainer Ms D. Wilson was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its starting manners.



OBELOS (GB) (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

WRITTEN IN HISTORY (S. Metcalfe) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

RACE 5 - MALLEE DIPPING AND MULESING / ZADOW WELL DRILLERS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1380 Metres (Cont'd)

GOOD LUCK CHUCK (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at it is over 10 years of age and was deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: MURRAY PIONEER BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1380 Metres

INDY MAGIC (T. Pannell) - hung in, in the straight and proved difficult to ride. Trainer R. Balfour was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding's racing manners.

BIGNOTA (D. Caboche) – checked inside the 200m by IT'S ALL GOSSIP, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery.

KIKUYU KING (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IT'S ALL GOSSIP (A. Lindsay) - shifted in shortly after the 200m when insufficiently clear of BIGNOTA, which was crowded for room and had to be checked. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 18 September 2022 and to conclude at midnight on Sunday, 25 September 2022: a period of three meetings.

RACE 7: SWAN REACH HOTEL MINDARIE-HALIDON CUP - 1800 Metres

SHOCK ALERT (NZ) (T. Voorham) – after acceptances Co-Trainer Mr J. Dodgson made a gear application to add blinkers to the gelding's race gear. Stewards acceded to his request and acting under AR206(2) he was fined \$200. Rider reported the gelding proved disappointing when let down in the straight however, in her opinion, the gelding should benefit from the run.

LOMAX (L. Overall) - when questioned regarding the gelding's performance, rider explained LOMAX travelled well however, failed to respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: MEMORIAL RACE - VAL & NORM HUMPHRYS, BARRY GOWLING, KEITH (SKEET) LORD BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

MUFFLA (J. Toeroek) - hung in from the 400m.

STAR LYRIC (L. Overall) – when questioned regarding the riding tactic's adopted on the mare in particular racing forward at a fast tempo and challenging MISS ELEGANCE for the lead, rider explained that he was instructed to allow the horse to be comfortable in the race and given the wide barrier, he was of the opinion that the best option was to slide forward to take the lead. Trainer Mr P. Hardacre advised he did expect STAR LYRIC to be a little bit more forward than at its last start however, was anticipated a mid-field positon with cover. After considering all the evidence, rider was advised that in future he was expected to make a far greater effort in assessing the tempo of the race when in the lead.

MISS ELEGANCE (E. Wong) - when questioned regarding his riding tactics on the mare, in particular setting a fast tempo and challenging STAR LYRIC for the lead, rider explained that from the wide alley, he was instructed to go forward as per usual and realising that STAR LYRIC was also going forward, he elected to take a sit briefly before again improving to the lead near the 1200m. After considering all the evidence, rider was advised that in future he was expected to make a far greater effort in assessing the tempo of the race when in the lead.

TIZA (S. Logan) - hung in when placed under pressure in the straight.

I'M BULLETPROOF (K. Sardelic) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
