RACE 1: ATKINS PHOTOGRAPHY 21-22 GBJC HORSE OF THE YEAR - TOYETIC MAIDEN PLATE - 1516 Metres

CALLED TO ACCOUNT (NZ) (T. Pannell) - slow to begin. At the entrance to the straight was taken out by MAJESTIC MOSHE, which was hanging out and shifted out, onto VANITY STAR and bumped with that gelding.

I'M A MILLENNIAL (E. Wong) - slow to begin. From the 400m until the entrance to the straight bumped with SOARLIKEANEAGLE on a number of occasions.

MAJESTIC MOSHE (S. Fawke) - hung out rounding the home turn, shifted out and bumped CALLED TO ACCOUNT (NZ), which was taken out and bumped VANITY STAR.

SOARLIKEANEAGLE (J. Holder) – slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. From the 400m until the entrance to the straight bumped with I'M A MILLENNIAL on a number of occasions. Held up for clear running from the 150m until approaching the finish and near the 100m, raced in restricted room and was obliged to be steadied when racing between FOXY EAGLE and VIC REEL, which was taken out by JUST JAZZ, which was hanging out and shifted out.

VANITY STAR (B. Vorster) - at the entrance to the straight bumped with CALLED TO ACCOUNT (NZ), which was taken out.

FOXY EAGLE (A. Livesey) - near the 100m raced in restricted room and was obliged to be steadied when racing between SOARLIKEANEAGLE, which was held up and taken out, and CALLED TO ACCOUNT (NZ).

JUST JAZZ (T. Voorham) - hung out from near the 600m for the remainder of the event. Near the 100m shifted out taking VIC REEL wider. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight.

PRINCE TIKEA (J. Benbow) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

VIC REEL (E. Boyd) - taken wider from the 200m and near the 100m, was taken out by JUST JAZZ, which was hanging out, onto SOARLIKEANEAGLE. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight.

RACE 2: COOPERS BREWERY MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

DR CHOCCY (R. Hurdle) – form update: finished seventh of eight at Jamestown on Saturday, 1 October 2022 in a 1340m 3yo and Up Maiden, beaten 16.8L. On arrival on course underwent a prerace veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Near the 250m shifted out onto MR NAFPLION (NZ), which was inconvenienced and taken wider. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and advised to ensure that he keeps his mounts straight in future.

MR NAFPLION (NZ) (J. Eaton) - near the 250m was inconvenienced and taken wider by DR CHOCCY.

DON'T DOUBT DIVA (B. Price) - shortly after the start bucked for a number of strides and took no further part in the event. Trainer representative Ms K Belsham, was advised that the mare is required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOLAR BLAST (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Held up for clear running from the 600m until shortly after the entrance to the straight. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground until near the 200m when racing between TEQUILA SUNSET and TAN TAT BEAU.

TEQUILA SUNSET (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CARARADA (E. Boyd) - shortly after the start was inconvenienced when racing between OH SHOW and DON'T DOUBT DIVA, which had commenced to buck and shifted out. Trainer Mr J. Hyam reported that he had instructed the rider to attempt to have the filly settle in a position forward of mid-field.

RACE 3: CONTRACT ENGINEERING MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

PIERRE DE LUNE (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and inconvenienced RUSSKI HUSSEY.

FINAL JEDI (P. Gatt) - hung in throughout the event.

KATINA JOY (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PUNCHIN (J. Eaton) – approaching the finish raced in restricted room between FREEDOM DAY, which hung in and PINCHBECK. Rider reported the gelding hung out from shortly after the entrance to the straight.

HUMEA (F. Atkinson) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

FREEDOM DAY (E. Wong) - hung in under pressure in the straight and was unable to be ridden out fully to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Co-Trainer Mr. G Searle was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its racing manners.

RACE 3: CONTRACT ENGINEERING MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

RUSSKI HUSSEY (T. Voorham) – on jumping away was inconvenienced as PIERRE DE LUNE shifted in. Near the 700m dipped. Near the 100m rider dropped her whip.

RACE 4: GAWLER & BAROSSA JOCKEY CLUB LABOUR DAY CUP BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1719 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

GETOUTTHEWAY (K. Crowther) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance near the 200m and was obliged to shift out and from that point on was inclined to lay in under pressure.

HAVADUEL (NZ) (A. Livesey) – on arrival on course underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since 20 February 2021 and was deemed suitable to race. When racing keenly near the 1500m and when being restrained, the saddle slipped forward and to the off side on the gelding and as a result, the rider was placed at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event and took no competitive part. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was galloped on, on the near hind leg. First aid administered.

MUFFLA (J. Toeroek) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery and heat stress. First aid administered.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (J. Doyle) - on arrival at the barriers was required to be re-shod as it had lost its near fore plate en route to the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

INKA DINKA (C. Murray) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 5: BARASTOC GBJC 21-22 TRAINER OF THE YEAR - RYAN BALFOUR CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

COURAGEOUS HEARTS (J. Holder) – rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it travelled well during the event however, when asked for an effort prior to rounding the turn commenced to lay in and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LINAS MAGIC (B. Vorster) - rider explained in relation to the mare's performance that it hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHOSEN BLONDE (F. Atkinson) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

JUSTAKIDD (T. Pannell) - approaching the 400m was awkward on the heels of VEXATIOUS BOY, which had commenced to weaken and was obliged to shift out. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

SPACE FORCE (J. Eaton) - shortly after the start was inconvenienced as VEXATIOUS BOY rolled in and was tightened onto COURAGEOUS HEARTS.

DAZZLING HARMONY (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly.

SELF SUFFICIENT (B. Wong) - approaching the 800m raced in restricted room and was obliged to be restrained when awkwardly placed to the inside of VEXATIOUS BOY.

VEXATIOUS BOY (S. Fawke) - Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg.

RACE 6: HYLAND SPORTSWEAR 21-22 GBJC JOCKEY OF THE YEAR BAREND VORSTER BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 2121 Metres

MAKE IT A DOUBLE (D. Caboche) - on jumping away shifted in onto FIAMETTE.

SPACE EQUITY (J. Opperman) - hung out from the 500m for the remainder of the event.



RACE 6: HYLAND SPORTSWEAR 21-22 GBJC JOCKEY OF THE YEAR BAREND VORSTER BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 2121 Metres (Cont'd)

ARMAMENT (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages however, was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor respiratory recovery.

FIAMETTE (E. Boyd) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened between CHENIAH as MAKE IT A DOUBLE shifted in.

HAPPY ATOM (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 400m was held up for a short distance.

RACE 7: IN MEMORY OF LIFE MEMBER DULCIE COBB RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of the event was delayed approximately two minutes.

REALITY CHECK (J. Toeroek) - proved difficult to load. Trainer Mr B. Bogarts was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its loading manners.

BETTA EDDIE (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Rounding the home turn bumped with ROCK HARD, which rolled out. Laid in under pressure in the straight and approaching the 100m brushed with ROCK HARD.

MAGIC PHANTOM (B. Wong) - slow to begin.

OLIVE GROVE (T. Voorham) - on jumping away lost its position as RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE shifted in. Near the 400m was held up for a number of strides.

ALPINE FUN (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly.

BALLROOM DANCER (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (B. Price) – on jumping away shifted in onto OLIVE GROVE. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare was lame (2/5) in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr R. Campbell was advised that a Veterinary Clearance is required prior to a future jump out, trial or race.

POSSUM BORN (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

YOUNG LARS (P. Gatt) - slow to begin and slow to muster speed in the early stages.

ROCK HARD (E. Annells) – rounding the home turn rolled out and bumped BETTA EDDIE. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. Approaching the 100m brushed with BETTA EDDIE.

RACE 8: HAPPY 60TH MARK GEVERS RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1516 Metres

GOOD APPROACH (K. Crowther) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

VALLEY RATTLER (R. Hurdle) - form update: finished eleventh of thirteen at Morphettville Parks on Saturday, 1 October 2022 in a BM60 handicap, beaten 11.8L. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

BRIABELLA (L. Neindorf) - laid in under pressure in the straight.
