

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Jamestown
Racecourse by the Jamestown Racing Club on
Saturday, 1 October 2022



STEWARDS: E. Scott (A/Chairman), M. Zarb (HT) (Steward), B Jarman (F) & K. Rayson (Cadet Stewards), Dr D. Anderson (Veterinary Surgeon)

TRACK: Good 4

(Track with some give in it)

RAIL: True

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1:HARVEST AND HAULMAX TYRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

BLUE PAWSOM (A. Lindsay) - near 800m had to be steadied to avoid heels of DASH IT, which shifted in.

CONSISTENT CHOICE (M. Collett) - on arrival at the barriers underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

INOTELL (D. Tootell) - shortly after jumping away shifted out abruptly onto VOODOO MOON.

VOODOO MOON (J. Doyle) - shortly after the start was hampered when tightened onto HAYZEE FANTAYZEE by INOTELL, which had shifted out.

DASH IT (F. Atkinson) - near 800m shifted in onto BLUE PAWSOM when racing tight to the inside of INOTELL.

RACE 2: EK-WI-TEE CAFE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

LORD VARYS (F. Atkinson) - when questioned regarding the improved performance of the gelding, Trainer, Mr M. McClean explained that although the gelding was disappointing when resuming last start, LORD VARYS had improved fitness and raced as expected in today's event.

IT'S HUMPHREY (B. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and as result was slow to begin.

LITTLE MISS RICH (M. Collett) - raced keenly in the early stages. Hung in from 500m and proved difficult to ride in the straight. Stable representative Miss K. Halliday was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

RACE 3: FESTIVAL HIRE MAIDEN PLATE - 1340 Metres

DR CHOCCY (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TOMMY TOMATO (D. Tootell) - slow to begin.

RACE 4: JAMESTOWN CONTAINER DEPOT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1340 Metres

GLACIER GREY (F. Atkinson) - when questioned in relation to the disappointing performance of the gelding, rider explained that she had intended to lead in today's event but after jumping away awkwardly, settled further back than anticipated and in her opinion, the gelding did not handle the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRINCESS SALLY (J. Hampson) - proved difficult en route and on arrival at the start, Trainer, Mr G. Lynch was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its pre-race behaviour. Slow into stride. Shortly after that start got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

RACE 5: COOPERS RAILWAY HOTEL JAMESTOWN CUP - 1800 Metres

PRINCE JOFRA (A. Livesey) - on jumping away was taken out onto O'MIZZNA when bumped by AL RANCHERO. Near the 1600m had to be steadied, when MISS ELEGANCE shifted in. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

AL RANCHERO (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped PRINCE JOFRA.

FIABLE (NZ) (J. Doyle) - inconvenienced on jumping away when O'MIZZNA was taken out..

MISS ELEGANCE (F. Atkinson) - near the 1600m shifted in onto PRINCE JOFRA, which had to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to ensure she is sufficiently clear when shifting ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have thumps. Co-Trainer, Mr G Searle, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump out, trial or race start.

O'MIZZNA (A. Lindsay) - on jumping away was taken out onto FIABLE by PRINCE JOFRA.

RACE 6: MICHAEL NOONAN MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TAJAVEDO (B. Wong) - approaching the 100m was disappointed for a run to the inside of ZAKYBREE and as result, was unable to be fully tested to the winning post.

TUFF CAT (D. Tootell) - slow to begin.

UP (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

REPRIMANDS FOR WHIP USE
