RACE 1: MED ELECTRICAL MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

ONYA PAL (C. Murray) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

L'ENFANT (C. Puls) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since the 22 September 2021 and was deemed suitable to race. Hung out in the straight and was difficult for the rider to ride out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DR CHOCCY (M. Collett) - slow into stride

RACE 2: E.E MUIR & SONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 Metres

ARASSEM (B. Price) - on jumping away bumped with BLUFFED.

DELCOFF (C. Murray) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ONE MORE THRILL (D. Caboche) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RAVNIKAR (J. Maund) - began well. Near the 600m attempted to shift out and bumped ERSKINE FALLS (NZ). Laid in under pressure in the straight.



RACE 2: E.E MUIR & SONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 Metres (Cont'd)

BLUFFED (K. Sardelic) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped ARASSEM. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ERSKINE FALLS (NZ) (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 600m bumped with RAVNIKAR, which was attempting to shift out. Laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: COOL MOOSE REFRIGERATION & AIRCONDITIONING CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

VEGAS DESTINY (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - slow to begin.

LAST DREAM (NZ) (K. Walters) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MANDJAR (E. Boyd) - on arrival at the barriers underwent a veterinary examination and deemed suitable to start.

SCOTCH ON THE ROCK (J. Eaton) - raced fiercely in the early stages of the event when being restrained.

RACE 4: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

GIGGLON (B. Wong) - approaching the 1100m raced in restricted room to the inside of SMART ELISSIM. When questioned in relation to not allowing the gelding to lead in the event and attempting to maintain her position on the rail, rider stated her instructions were to allow GIGGLON to settle where comfortable. She added from shortly after the start she raced in restricted room to the inside of SMART ELISSIM, elected to restrain GIGGLON and in doing so, she was tightened by SMART ELISSIM approaching the turn near the 1100m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ENZED BEER (NZ) (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 5: THE MIDFIELD GROUP BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

DRONE STRIKE (J. Eaton) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported the mare may not have appreciated the track conditions.

GYPSY CROWN (K. Crowther) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (K. Walters) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TARASQUE (C. Puls) - slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

HEY MICHAEL (L. Neindorf) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: COOPERS KALANGADOO CUP BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

BLACK SYRAH (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SHOCK ALERT (NZ) (B. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto ALI ORPHAN (NZ). A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE FIRE TRAP (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.



RACE 6: COOPERS KALANGADOO CUP BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres (Cont'd)

KEYSOR (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto ALI ORPHAN (NZ). Held up from rounding the home turn until inside the 200m. Rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action from near the 500m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALI ORPHAN (NZ) (K. Walters) - on jumping away lost its position as SHOCK ALERT (NZ), which jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and KEYSOR, which jumped away awkwardly, shifted out. Near the 300m was awkwardly placed for a number of strides between KEYSOR and BLACK SYRAH. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance at the entrance to the straight.

RANGER CEE JAY (K. Crowther) - rider reported the gelding travelled well during the event however, when asked to improve from shortly prior to entering the straight, did not feel comfortable in its action and for this reason did not ride RANGER CEE JAY out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: RICHARD RAY INSURANCE BROKERS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

LOVE TO LOVE (M. Collett) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FRIENDLY GHOST (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KIKUYU KING (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto LOVE TO LOVE. Shifted about under pressure in the straight.

TRANSFERENCE (E. Boyd) - slow into stride.

FONTAINE DEL ROSSO (J. Eaton) - jumped away very awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

MOSS THE BOSS (F. Atkinson) - near the 150m was awkwardly placed on the heels of KIKUYU KING and obliged to shift in, in an attempt to gain clear ground.
