Report on Race Meeting held at Murray Bridge Racecourse by the Murray Bridge Jockey Club on Friday, 14 October 2022

RACE 1: RURAL CITY OF MURRAY BRIDGE - MAKE IT YOURS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres

ASTAIRES (T. Voorham) - fractious in the barriers. Trainer, Mr J. O'Connor was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Slow to begin. Near the 700m when racing greenly had to be checked away from MISS HOT 'N' SPICY, which lost ground quickly forward of it.

DUBENENKO (C. Murray) – fractious in the barriers. Trainer, Mr C. Bieg was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners. Slow to begin. Near the 700m had to be checked away from ASTAIRES, which shifted out abruptly away from the heels of MISS HOT 'N' SPICY. At the entrance to the straight shifted out and carried OFF THE CUFF wider on the track.

HARLEEN (F. Atkinson) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MISS HOT 'N' SPICY (E. Annells) – rider explained that the filly raced greenly and near the 700m was reluctant to race on the inside of SANDUAL, shied and lost ground quickly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OFF THE CUFF (M. Collett) - at the entrance to the straight was carried out wider on the track by DUBENENKO, on its inside.

RACE 2: NEW BEGINNINGS AT NEWBRIDGE MAIDEN PLATE (1) - 1000 Metres

BUTTS (J. Maund) - slow to begin. Held up from near the 350m until the 250m and had to shift wider to improve.

FLYING BARTY (K. Crowther) - rider reported she was unable to offer any excuse for the disappointing performance of the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOOKED ON WEALTH (J. Toeroek) - near the 150m was bumped and hampered on the inside of OPPORTUNE CHANCE, which shifted in when racing greenly.

MELANIE'S JOY (A. Kelly) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in over 12 months and was deemed suitable to race.

STREET HUSTLER (D. Tourneur) - fractious in the barriers. Jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

TICKETY BOOM (T. Voorham) - laid in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

OPPORTUNE CHANCE (D. Caboche) - near the 600m raced in restricted room between BIG FEELINGS and HOOKED ON WEALTH, when both runners shifted ground slightly. Near the 150m shifted in when racing greenly and bumped HOOKED ON WEALTH.

RACE 3: ADELAIDE EVENT CATERING MAIDEN PLATE (2) - 1000 Metres

FAMOUS PRINCE (J. Potter) - rider reported that the gelding raced keenly with the blinkers on for the first time.

PORTATION (S. Logan) - near the 50m shifted in when insufficiently clear of POMPEII EMPIRE resulting in that horse having to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

LILLIS (T. Pannell) - when questioned in relation to the mare's performance, the rider was unable to offer any explanation.

POMPEII EMPIRE (J. Toeroek) - near the 50m had to be steadied away from the heels of PORTATION, which shifted in.

SIR ILLYRIAN (A. Jordsjo) – slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event with its head up. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event and shortened its stride in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: BRIDGE CARPET COURT MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

A FEW GOOD MEN (P. Gatt) - bumped a gate when leaving the parade ring and underwent a pre-race veterinary examination upon arrival at the barriers and was deemed suitable to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CALLED TO ACCOUNT (NZ) (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped WANALOAN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the thumps.

MARDENE (L. Neindorf) – near the 400m was bumped by HOLMES, which shifted out to improve and thereafter brushed with that runner on several occasions in the straight. Weakened over the concluding stages of the event and was hampered by A FEW GOOD MEN, which shifted in slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr B. Smart advised post-race day that the gelding's near hind leg had been galloped on and required treatment.

HOLMES (J. Benbow) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 400m shifted out and bumped MARDENE and thereafter brushed that runner several times.

AESCULUS (F. Atkinson) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped CARARADA.

CARARADA (E. Boyd) - tightened and buffeted on jumping away between I AM HERA SINGH and AESCULUS, which shifted in.

WANALOAN (K. Crowther) - bumped on jumping away by CALLED TO ACCOUNT (NZ).

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Trainer M Hickmott (CALLED TO ACCOUNT), second place, to view the photo finish.

RACE 5: NORTHPOINT MURRAYLANDS CLASS ONE PLATE - 2000 Metres

ITHACAN (T. Pannell) - held up and unable to improve from the 500m until the 400m behind CHARTIN (NZ) and to the inside MARGIN OF ERROR.

KENTUCKY RULER (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

RED SEQUOIA (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

SALUTE THE STARS (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide for the majority of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TUFF CAT (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin. Near the 200m shifted out across the heels of SALUTE THE STARS to improve.

FIZIQUE (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROBE RAIDER (P. Gatt) - slow to begin. Held up and unable to improve from the 500m behind ECLAIR RHYTHM (NZ) and ITHACAN and thereafter became held up for the majority of the straight behind ITHACAN and MARGIN OF ERROR and was never tested to the line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOARLIKEANEAGLE (J. Holder) - hung in, in the straight.

RACE 6: SPRY CIVIL CONSTRUCTION BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TRYGVE (A. Kelly) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MR METRICS (J. Toeroek) - rider reported that the gelding was under pressure from the 600m and failed to run on. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AKTOLGALI (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly.

AMMO AMOR (M. Collett) - held up for clear running from near the 400m until the 200m behind MR METRICS and to the inside of JUSTAKIDD. Raced in restricted room from the 200m and was not fully tested to the line.

KINGSON (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Raced in restricted room over the final 100m and was not fully tested to the line.

JUSTAKIDD (R. Hurdle) - held up for clear racing room from near the 400m until the 200m behind AMMO AMOR and to the inside of LORD LUKER.

RACE 7: FMG ENGINEERING BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

JUST KAPPY (J. Potter) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in over 12 months and was deemed suitable to race. Near the 700m became awkwardly placed on the heels of JIMMYS EDGE, which was taken out by AQUAMOSS. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LANCELOTTO (B. Wong) - near the 650m when racing greenly became awkwardly placed on the heels of SUGAR GLIDER and shifted in abruptly resulting in SEE YOU LATER NOW, which was following, having to be checked.

RODNEY (A. Lindsay) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear racing room at the entrance to the straight. Held up between the 350m and the 250m and shifted wider to improve. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

AQUAMOSS (J. Opperman) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in over 12 months and was deemed suitable to race. Hung out for the majority of the event.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 650m had to be checked when awkwardly placed on the heels of LANCELOTTO, which shifted in abruptly. Had difficulty obtaining clear racing room at the entrance to the straight. Inclined to lay in over the concluding stages of the event.

ROCK HARD (E. Annells) - approaching the 400m shifted in across the heels of AQUAMOSS to obtain a clear run.

RACE 8: BEYOND INK BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

HAVADUEL (NZ) (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

VENUSIAN (A. Kelly) - approaching the 1200m when racing keenly had to be steadied away from the heels of SMART CHARGE, which was being restrained.

MAID IN MILAN (A. Lindsay) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: BEYOND INK BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

YE HELLA (K. Crowther) - rider advised that she was concerned with the gelding's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WHISKEY 'N' WOMEN (J. Benbow) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

REBEL LEE (J. Holder) - approaching the 1200m shifted in when insufficiently clear of SMART CHARGE, resulting in that runner being tightened and having to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

SMART CHARGE (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 1200m when racing keenly had to be steadied on the inside of REBEL LEE which shifted in.

PERFECT PANDA (B. Vorster) - raced tight on the inside of REBEL LEE in the back straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JAMCRA (NZ) (S. Logan) - passing the 200m shifted out across the heels of PERFECT PANDA to improve.

RACE 9: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP - 1600 Metres

LORD VLADIVOSTOK (NZ) (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

FAROOQ (J. Opperman) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the early part of the straight bumped with OH MO on several occasions.

AGREEABLE (K. Crowther) - rider was found guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) in that she shifted out near the 400m when insufficiently clear of MONTIGN, carrying that runner out onto ZOULAH, which had to be checked and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 22 October 2022 and to conclude midnight Tuesday, 1 November 2022, a period of five meetings.

ZOULAH (B. Price) - approaching the 400m raced in restricted room between MONTIGN and PERFECT WORLD. Near the 400m had to be checked when tightened between PERFECT WORLD and MONTIGN, which was taken out by AGREEABLE.

MONTIGN (S. Logan) - near the 400m was carried out by AGREEABLE on its inside, which shifted out.

OH MO (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 450m improved onto the heels of PERFECT WORLD and had to be steadied. In the early part of the straight bumped with FAROOQ on several occasions.

UNLACED (NZ) (J. Eaton) - shifted out on jumping away and tightened WINGS OF PASTRAMI onto MOSCOW RED (NZ).

WINGS OF PASTRAMI (P. Gatt) - tightened on jumping away between MOSCOW RED (NZ) and UNLACED (NZ), which shifted out. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MOSCOW RED (NZ) (W. Price) - near the 1000m when racing keenly had to be steadied away from the heels of OH MO.

PERFECT WORLD (J. Holder) - raced wide for the majority of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 9: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

CROWN MINT (B. Vorster) - late scratching by order of the Stewards at 12.25 pm acting on confirmation from Co-trainer, Mr G. Richards that they had experienced transport difficulties.

RACE 10: BGC INDUSTRIAL CLEANING SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

LOMAX (E. Wong) – raced in restricted room for the majority of the straight. Near the 100m shifted in and away from WOLF PRINCE and contacted JACK'S A CRACKER, which was tightened in onto the heels of QUEBECOIS and had to be checked. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

ALLUSION (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped QUEBECOIS. Held up for clear racing room between the 400m until the 150m and shifted wider on the track to improve.

PITRAIN (M. Collett) - raced wide throughout the event.

QUEBECOIS (J. Eaton) - bumped on jumping away by ALLUSION, which shifted in.

INKA DINKA (C. Murray) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

JACK'S A CRACKER (A. Livesey) - near the 100m was bumped by LOMAX on its outside, became awkward and had to be checked away from the heels of QUEBECOIS on its inside.

SISSECK (NZ) (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.


