RACE 1: KINGSFORD HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

CHAR (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 800m raced in restricted room for a short distance between IRUNTHISCITY and BICKERING, which rolled in marginally.

GOD IT'S ME (D. Caboche) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OH SHOW (B. Price) - shifted in and contacted OUTPOUR on jumping away. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 1: KINGSFORD HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

OUTPOUR (B. Vorster) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted OH SHOW. Inclined to lay in, in the straight. Rider explained that the gelding never travelled throughout the event, hung out until the straight where it was inclined to lay in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TESTA DEXTA (J. Maund) - slow to begin.

BICKERING (S. Logan) - hung out from the 500m for the remainder of the event.

RACE 2: BAROSSA VALLEY CIDER CO. MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 Metres

CALL ME VEXATIOUS (A. Lindsay) - laid in, in the straight.

MARDENE (D. Tourneur) - due to the transfer of meeting Trainer, Mr B. Smart made a gear application to remove winkers and add blinkers to the gelding's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request. At the entrance to the straight was disappointed for a run for a short distance between CAMBERWOOD and ZOUNORMOUS. Shortly after when attempting to improve into a run, shifted out and bumped ZOUNORMOUS.

DIVINE JOURNEY (J. Potter) - laid out in the straight.

LET'S PRANCE (J. Eaton) - in the vicinity of the 150m shifted to the outside of MR NAFPLION (NZ) to obtain clear running.

ZOUNORMOUS (A. Livesey) - laid out from the 500m for the remainder of the event. At the entrance to the straight was bumped by MARDENE.

IMBIBE (B. Vorster) - rider explained that the filly never travelled throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: SANDERS FODDER FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

A MIDNIGHT SHADOW (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and hampered SEPORIA. Held up from the 500m until the entrance to the straight.

KATE'S REBEL (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped AESCULUS. Inconvenienced approaching the finish by AESCULUS, which shifted out and away from MELANIE'S JOY.

MELANIE'S JOY (D. Caboche) - bumped on jumping away by MISS CARSON, which shifted in. Approaching the finish shifted out abruptly and took AESCULUS wider on the track.

MISS CARSON (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped MELANIE'S JOY. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWEET ROCK CANDY (J. Eaton) - shortly after the start rolled in and was obliged to take hold to avoid the heels of MISS CARSON and lost its position. Held up rounding the home turn.

AESCULUS (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped KATE'S REBEL. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 1000m became awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS NOSY ROSIE and was obliged to shift out. Approaching the finish shifted out and away from MELANIE'S JOY and inconvenienced KATE'S REBEL.

HUMEA (J. Holder) - lost its near hind plate en route to the barriers which had to be re-fitted upon arrival at the barriers. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

MISS NOSY ROSIE (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 1000m became awkwardly placed on the heels of MELANIE'S JOY and was obliged to be steadied and shift out.

SEPORIA (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and lost its position when hampered by A MIDNIGHT SHADOW.



RACE 3: SANDERS FODDER FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

WANALOAN (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WANDJINA GAL (M. Collett) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: JOHN EDWARDS 80TH BIRTHDAY BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

MAGIC PHANTOM (M. Collett) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DEEVINE (A. Livesey) - laid out in the straight. Approaching the finish shifted out and tightened the running line of LOPE DE WOLF. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care and to straighten her mounts when shifting ground, in future.

LOPE DE WOLF (B. Vorster) - approaching the finish raced in restricted room between TEQUILA SUNSET and DEEVINE, which laid out and was unable to be tested to the line.

TEQUILA SUNSET (J. Holder) - laid out from the 600m for the remainder of the event.

RACE 5: LJ HOOKER BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

BETTA EDDIE (K. Crowther) - laid in, in the straight.

STARSONGARI (F. Atkinson) - lost its near hind plate during the event. In the vicinity of the 500m was inconvenienced by RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE, which shifted in and was taken in onto BOILING POINT.

BOILING POINT (P. Gatt) - in the vicinity of the 500m lost its position when hampered by STARSONGARI, which was taken in.

SOPHINA DIVA (J. Maund) - in the vicinity of the 1000m shifted in and contacted BROMELIA (NZ). Laid in, in the straight. Inside the 200m rolled in marginally and tightened the running SQUADRON LEADER.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (D. Tournour) - in the vicinity of the 500m shifted in and inconvenienced STARSONGARI. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

ZEDUKI (B. Vorster) - held up for clear running from the 400m until the 250m, then shifted out and contacted SQUADRON LEADER. Inside the 200m shifted out and away marginally from BROMELIA (NZ) and tightened the running line of SQUADRON LEADER.

CHEH CHEH CHARLEE (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers which revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5). Acting on this advice CHEH CHEH CHARLEE was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 3.39 pm. Co-trainers, Mr R. Daniel & Ms T. Stanbury were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

BROMELIA (NZ) (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 1000m was contacted by SOPHINA DIVA, which shifted in. Inside the 200m rolled out.

SQUADRON LEADER (S. Fawke) - Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg. Jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. In the vicinity of the 250m was contacted by ZEDUKI. Inside the 200m raced in restricted room between SOPHINA DIVA and ZEDUKI and was obliged to be steadied when both runners shifted ground.

RACE 6: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

ZIGGI ROCKS (K. Sardelic) - approaching the 400m was momentarily inconvenienced when DON'T DISMISS shifted out.



RACE 6: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres (cont'd)

DON'T DISMISS (J. Hampson) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from the vicinity of the 500m until inside the 200m. Approaching the 400 shifted out and inconvenienced ZIGGI ROCKS. In the vicinity of the 150m was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

WELL KNOWN (NZ) (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

D'ISLES (M. Collett) - laid out in the straight.

RACE 7: CONTRACT ENGINEERING BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

PITRAIN (M. Collett) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

PRINCE TIKEA (J. Hampson) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Inside the 1200m whilst being restrained, shifted out and bumped MORE SHOTS. In the vicinity of the 300m shifted out to obtain clear running and hampered MORE SHOTS. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to only shift ground when entitled to do so. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

KING OF AVALON (NZ) (B. Vorster) - stood flat footed as the start was effected and was slow to begin (two lengths). Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

MORE SHOTS (J. Maund) - inside the 1200m was bumped by PRINCE TIKEA, which shifted out. In the vicinity of the 300m was hampered by PRINCE TIKEA, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SANDPIPER (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the filly never travelled and was disappointing throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIRMAZE (A. Jordsjo) - held up from the 400m until the 300m.

RACE 1: LEADER DISTRIBUTORS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

THUNDERANLIGHTNING - Trainer, Mr M Cornell, advised Stewards on Friday, 4 November 2022 that on inspection the gelding was extremely shin sore in both fronts and will now be spelled prior to completing an Official Barrier Trial as required.
