RACE 1: CUMMINS MILL BUTTERFIELD FARM DISTRICT MAIDEN PLATE - 1750 Metres

ALMARHOE (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 100m was inconvenienced when taken in onto CLUB RAIDER by RIGHT TURN.

CLUB RAIDER (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 100m had to be steadied when ALMARHOE was taken into its running line by RIGHT TURN.

I'M A MILLENNIAL (E. Wong) - near the 300m was inconvenienced when taken wider by SUBUKI, which had been taken out.

MR NAFPLION (NZ) (K. Crowther) - approaching the 300m became held up when racing behind ALMARHOE and inside RIGHT TURN, and in being eased shifted out abruptly across and clipping the heels of RIGHT TURN, knuckling and then shifting out onto SUBUKI. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RIGHT TURN (D. Caboche) - shifted in abruptly approaching the 100m taking ALMARHOE in onto CLUB RAIDER.



RACE 1: CUMMINS MILL BUTTERFIELD FARM DISTRICT MAIDEN PLATE - 1750 Metres (cont'd)

THE LOCKSMITH (T. Voorham) - got its head down just prior to the start being effected, and as a result jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

AXESTOCK GIRL (NZ) (A. Livesey) - was kicked by another runner on arrival at the barrier. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported that the mare never travelled and failed to let down when asked for an effort. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUBUKI (A. Jordsjo) - near the 300m was hampered when tightened onto I'M A MILLENNIAL by MR NAFPLION (NZ), which clipped heels and shifted out.

SKRIMSHANKER (C. Murray) - on pulling up shifted out abruptly dislodging its rider. C. Murray was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 2: VETS ON EYRE MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

JUSTICA'S BONUS (T. Voorham) - fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Trainer, Mr B. Clarke, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Dipped on jumping away. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

SHIPWRECK (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MIS GUIDED CHOICE (D. Caboche) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

ZIGGING AROUND (E. Wong) - laid in between the 500m and 400m shifting in slightly onto AYLLA'S PRIDE.

AYLLA'S PRIDE (A. Jordsjo) - inconvenienced between the 500m and 400m when ZIGGING AROUND laid in slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery rate.

RACE 3: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

RED DYNAMO (NZ) (B.Wong) - rider explained that it was her intention to settle further forward in today's event; however, the pace of the race was must stronger over the shorter distance of today's event and she was unable to do so. She added that in her opinion the gelding races better when settling closer to the speed. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED TRAVELLER (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting RIVERSIDE ROCK.

MESSERSCHMITT (A. Livesey) - lost its position shortly after the start when tightened onto RED DYNAMO (NZ) by CALL ME HERBIE.

RIVERSIDE ROCK (B. Price) - contacted on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TAJAVEDO (E. Boyd) - slow to begin.

CALL ME HERBIE (D. Caboche) - shifted in on jumping away onto MESSERSCHMITT. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: SCHWEPPE'S BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

AHSO (E. Wong) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

FEARLESS AL (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding was inclined to lay in throughout the event.





RACE 4: SCHWEPPE BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres (cont'd)

FORAOISE (A. Livesey) - in the vicinity of the 200m shifted in and contacted ROAR. Shortly after was taken back in onto ROAR by NEAR MAGIC, which was taken in slightly by VANCOUVER VELVET.

SHINSEKI (B. Price) - near the 150m was forced to take hold and lose its position, resulting in the rider becoming severely unbalanced in the saddle, when ROAR was taken in across its running line.

VANCOUVER VELVET (B. Wong) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Inside the 200m shifted in onto NEAR MAGIC before being corrected and straightened.

NEAR MAGIC (S. Fawke) - near the 200m was taken in slightly onto FORAOISE by VANCOUVER VELVET.

ROAR (J. Doyle) - inside the 200m had its hindquarters turned in and became unbalanced when FORAOISE shifted in. Was then forced to race in restricted room for several strides prior to being taken across the running line of SHINSEKI.

RACE 5: IMPACT SIGNS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP (1) - 1350 Metres

GOODARCHIE (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 1000m had to be steadied momentarily when SCOUT'S HONOUR shifted in.

ORIEDOS (D. Caboche) - came together and brushed with HE'S ABEL between the 200m and the 100m.

CHONCAPE (E. Boyd) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding was reluctant to stretch out during the event and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PROUD MARY (A. Livesey) - kicked out in its raceday stall prior to the event. Was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon reported that the mare was lame in the near hind leg (4/5) and was unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared PROUD MARY a late scratching at 5.08 pm. Co-trainer, Mr J. Dunn and Miss K. Bishop, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (C. Murray) - approaching the 1000m shifted in onto GOODARCHIE, which was obliged to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground. Rider reported that it was not his intention to lead the event; however, after begin positive early he found himself in a position wide without cover, and rather than remain there he had used his initiative to roll forward to obtain the lead.

OUR JOURNEYMAN (E. Wong) - commenced to buck near the 1250m and was eventually eased out of the event near the 800m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Co-trainer, Mr J. Dunn, was advised that the gelding would be required to complete an Official Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to accepting for a future race.

HE'S ABEL (B. Price) - came together and brushed with ORIEDOS on a number of occasions between the 200m and the 100m, and then raced in restricted room to the finish.

RACE 6: GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP (2) - 1350 Metres

GOTTABITON (T. Voorham) - inside the 200m had to momentarily steady when HARDASHIAN shifted in.

ANGEL'S WISH (A. Livesey) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

RELAXED (E. Boyd) - approaching the 200m was initially unable to obtain clear ground and then became held up for the remainder of the event and was untested to the finish.





RACE 6: GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP (2) - 1350 Metres
(cont'd)

MISS PARMIGIANA (K. Crowther) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 150m had to steady momentarily when HARDASHIAN shifted in.

HARDASHIAN (B. Price) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight and near the 200m shifted in onto GOTTABITON, which had to momentarily steady, and then continued in onto MISS PARMIGIANA, which had to be momentarily steadied. Rider was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground. Rider reported that the gelding was inclined to lay in throughout the event.

RACE 7: PORT LINCOLN FOOTBALL LEAGUE RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

FRENCH ROCK (A. Livesey) - slow to begin. Laid out rounding the turn near the 400m and again rounding the home turn, resulting in it shifting out onto ATTACK THE PIN, which was hampered when tightened onto STORM VOYAGER.

ATTACK THE PIN (K. Sardelic) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rounding the home turn was hampered and had to be steadied when tightened onto STORM VOYAGER by FRENCH ROCK.

ISA SECRET (K. Crowther) - shifted out on jumping away onto STAR PARFAIT.

STAR PARFAIT (E. Wong) - lost its position on jumping away when tightened between ISA SECRET, which shifted out, and CRIMSON ROSE, which shifted in.

STORM VOYAGER (A. Jordsjo) - inconvenienced at the entrance to the straight when its hindquarters were turned out when contacted by ATTACK THE PIN, which had been taken out. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

CRIMSON ROSE (F. Atkinson) - shifted in on jumping away onto STAR PARFAIT. Rider reported that the mare hung out over the concluding 800m of the event.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (D. Caboche) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 8: LAWRENCE & HANSON BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

CROWNED KING (E. Wong) - kicked out in the parade ring and struck a perimeter fence. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the start and was deemed suitable to race. Jumped away awkwardly. Inconvenienced in the straight when taken wider by PERFECT ZED, which laid out.

KINGSON (A. Livesey) - contacted on jumping away.

MR WHITACRE (K. Crowther) - kicked by another runner on arrival at the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

STRAWBERRY SWING (F. Atkinson) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped KINGSON. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRESCIENT (R. Hurdle) - slow to begin.

TALLU (K. Sardelic) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DANTELA (NZ) (B. Price) - shortly after the start lost its position when tightened between CROWNED KING, which shifted out slightly, and KINGSON, which shifted in.

PERFECT ZED (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight taking CROWNED KING wider on the track.
