RACE 1: PURE WINE CO. BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1717 Metres

CARRY THE MUSKET (E. Wong) - lost its off fore plate en route to the barrier and required to be re-plated. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

WARMINSTER (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: HOLDFAST INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN PLATE - 1717 Metres

FAMOUS PRINCE (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 1000m shifted in onto SIR KINGSFORD. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

HOTFOOTIT (R. Milnes) - shifted out on jumping away onto PORTO RAFTI.

SPANISH COURAGE (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIR KINGSFORD (E. Wong) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 1000m had to momentarily steady when FAMOUS PRINCE shifted in, and as a result shifted out inconveniencing PERPETUAL GRACE. Shortly after shifted in abruptly for no apparent reason unbalancing its rider. Laid in under pressure in the early stages of the straight and near the 200m shifted in and momentarily became awkwardly placed on the heels of FAMOUS PRINCE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Co-trainer, Mrs N. Searle, was advised that warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

FOXY EAGLE (A. Livesey) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 3: COOPERS BREWERY CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 2119 Metres

LEADER'S PRIDE (A. Lindsay) - inside the 1000m commenced to race keenly for a number of strides prior to shifting out to race three wide without cover when the pace of the event eased.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (J. Doyle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: GATEWAY TO CHRISTMAS SATURDAY 17TH DECEMBER COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

BUTTS (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CHARLIE'S BRO (E. Boyd) - on arrival on course was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg (2/5) and unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared CHARLIE'S BRO a late scratching at 1.32 pm. Trainer, Mrs S. Nolan, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

NATION HERO (R. Milnes) - on jumping away shifted out and away from CHARLESFORT onto STAR KILLER.

PATANDMICK (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out abruptly. Raced greenly under pressure in the straight.

STAR KILLER (B. Price) - taken out on jumping away onto RUBINI by NATION HERO. Rider explained that the gelding hung out throughout the event, from the vicinity of the 800m commenced to give ground and after being placed under pressure early in the straight it did not respond to his riding and for this reason he had not persisted over the concluding 200m. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR114(2)(a) in reporting any matter that may have affected his mount in the race as soon as practicable. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHARLESFORT (D. Tourneur) - shifted out on jumping away onto NATION HERO. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Held up from approaching the 400m until the entrance to the straight.

FORTIS IN ARMIS (T. Pannell) - slow to begin, and shortly after was inconvenienced when RUBINI was taken out into its running line.

MAGIC AND MORE (T. Voorham) - contacted on jumping away. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RUBINI (J. Doyle) - taken out on jumping away into the running line of FORTIS IN ARMIS by STAR KILLER.

RACE 5: CONTRACT ENGINEERING CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TAN TAT BEAU (E. Wong) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

FIELD OF STEEL (T. Voorham) - approaching the 200m shifted out slightly onto AQUABOY.

AQUABOY (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 200m was forced to race in restricted room between FIELD OF STEEL, which shifted out slightly, and NORTHERN SUPERSTAR, which shifted in slightly, and as a result was unable to obtain clear ground until approaching the 100m when able to ease across the heels of NORTHERN SUPERSTAR.

FOXY FEMME (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SEGAL (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was reported to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5) and unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared SEGAL a late scratching at 3.38 pm. Trainer, Mr T. Montgomerie, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

NORTHERN SUPERSTAR (D. Caboche) - approaching the 200m shifted in slightly onto AQUABOY.

RACE 6: KINGSFORD HOTEL BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BETTER EDDIE (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

NOT A SINGLE BID (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

OLIVE GROVE (E. Wong) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was deemed suitable to race. Jumped away awkwardly.

SHOWUSYOURMOTOR (T. Voorham) - held up for a short distance approaching 200m and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

RACE 7: LJ HOOKER RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1513 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

CHAR (D. Tourneur) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

EAGLELOU (J. Potter) - lost its off fore plate en route to the barrier and required to be re-plated. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

AMMO AMOR (T. Pannell) - laid out rounding the home turn.

JUST JAZZ (S. Logan) - slow to begin. Near the 800m commenced to race keenly when racing behind AMMO AMOR, which had crossed to the lead.

SIRMAZE (A. Jordsjo) - near the 150m was momentarily steadied when CHAR shifted in slightly.
