# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

# Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 10 December 2022

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RACE 1: G.H. MUMM PLATE - 1050 Metres

KALASEC (J. Toeroek) - lost its off hind plate during the event.

ANGELIQUE (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out rounding the home turn.

SPLISH SPLASH (K. Crowther) – laid out rounding the home turn. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than normal post-race recovery. Co-trainers Mr R. Jolly and Ms C. Jolly stated that the filly will now be spelled.

TE PANI (J. Holder) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

# RACE 2: TWILIGHT RACES AT MORPHETTVILLE - FRIDAY DECEMBER 16TH HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

MORTY (B. Vorster) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

LAKE'S FOLLY (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WILD WILLY (J. Opperman) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WILD IMAGINATION (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - laid out under pressure in the straight.



# RACE 3: HT CAPITAL HANDICAP - 2500 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

SOUS LES NUAGES (IRE) (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

DARLAMAX (J. Holder) – contacted the barrier structure with its chest when being loaded, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

BUSKER'S BALLAD (A. Livesey) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROBE RAIDER (L. Neindorf) – stood flat footed and was slow to begin. Rider explained that in the middle stages of the event the mare commenced to race a touch keenly due to the pace and for that reason near the 1400m he elected to use some initiative and roll forward to obtain a position closer to the speed as in his opinion it is one paced. He added that near the 600m when placed under pressure ROBE RAIDER did not respond to his riding and commenced to weaken from the event earlier than he anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Mr M. Huxtable was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

UP THE STAIRS (S. Logan) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

STAYING STRONG (D. Caboche) – fractious in the wash bay. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to its nose and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice STAYING STRONG was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 11.43 am. Trainer, Ms J. Taylor, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

# RACE 4: WESTONIANS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

FALAISE (S. Logan) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inconvenienced when taken wider by VALIDATED near the 150m. Laid out under pressure over the concluding 150m.


LA DEFENSE (B. Price) – had to be steadied approaching the finish when tightened onto ICE SYMPHONY by VALIDATED. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the colt to be lame in the near foreleg (4/5). Trainer, Mr W. Clarken was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

SIR LEAPALOT (R. Hurdle) - held up for a short distance inside the 300m.

SOLID ROCK (L. Neindorf) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the near hind leg (3/5) and deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice SOLID ROCK was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 1.59 pm. Co-trainers, Mr G Richard and Mr D.Moyle were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

VALIDATED (B. Vorster) – shortly after the start lost its position when tightened between ICE SYMPHONY, which was taken in by LA DEFENSE and SIR LEAPALOT, which shifted out slightly. Held up from approaching the 400m until near the 150m when it was able to shift out to obtain clear ground and in doing so took FALAISE wider on the track. Approaching the finish shifted in under riding onto LA DEFENSE, which had to be steadied when tightened onto ICE SYMPHONY. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

BONNIE GANGSTER (J. Potter) -had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance inside the 300m.



THROEVA (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced greenly in the straight.



#### RACE 5: TOM SCHNAARS BUCKS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes owing to SPANISH STROLL becoming fractious and cast in its barrier.

PONTEDERA (NZ) (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was contacted by SPANISH STROLL when that gelding became fractious in its barrier and was deemed suitable to race. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

FLYWAY (E. Boyd) – jumped away extremely awkwardly and was slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FLY THE LINE (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WHO'S CLANG (J. Toeroek) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it was contacted by SPANISH STROLL when that gelding became fractious in its barrier and was deemed suitable to race.

WINNING REVOLUTION (S. Callow) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SIPSMITH (J. Holder) - fractious in the barrier and was backed out. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Trainer, Mr B. Bogarts was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners and in relation to it proving difficult to load.

FOXY FEMME (B. Vorster) - inconvenienced when contacted on jumping away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung out under pressure in the straight. Co-trainers, Mr P. Blanch and Ms B. Blanch were advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its racing manners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NOT A SINGLE BID (R. Hurdle) – attempted to buck for a short distance approaching the 1000m and lost ground. Trainer, Mr G. Young was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

BRAZEN EAGLE (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MISS MIDUKI (E. Wong) - rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(b) to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

SPANISH STROLL (K. Crowther) - fractious in the barrier, reared over and became cast. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice SPANISH STROLL was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 2:45 pm. Trainer, Mr M. Seyers was advised that the gelding was now required to prove tractable in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump-out prior to a future race. Mr Seyers was further advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

LUCKY FORTUNA (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out on jumping away onto FOXY FEMME.

RACE 6: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

RESIDUE (L. Neindorf) - laid out under pressure over the concluding 100m of the event.

BALLROOM DANCER (B. Price) – at the entrance to the straight was hampered by AUSSIE SOJOURN, which shifted out. Laid in under pressure over the concluding 500m of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ENTITLED PRINCESS (K. Crowther) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOX GEM (E. Wong) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event whilst being restrained.

AUSSIE SOJOURN (D. Tourneur) – at the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve and in doing so made contacted with BALLROOM DANCER.

WHEELS OF COURAGE (J. Opperman) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

# RACE 6: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (cont'd)

ALPINE BEAU (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 7: BRENTON COSTELLO'S 80TH HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to ANJOPIN, HALLOWED GROUND & TANJA'S DREAM requiring a pre-race veterinary examination and to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

HALLOWED GROUND (E. Wong) – reared, struck its head on the barrier and got down behind. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice HALLOWED GROUND was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 4:03 pm. Trainer, Mr D. Jolly was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race. Stewards will investigate into the reason that the gelding was loaded without a blind fold contrary to its approved race day gear.

INSPIRED SUN (S. Logan) – near the 200m was forced to race in restricted room for a short distance to the inside of WONDERWOMEN, which had been taken in.

ANJOPIN (M. Collett) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination en route to the barriers and was found to be lame in the off hind leg (4/5) and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice ANJOPIN was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 3:58 pm. Co-trainers, Ms S. Jaensch and Mr J. Jaensch were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

TANJA'S DREAM (D. Tourneur) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was deemed suitable to race. Inside the 300m, was taken in on WONDERWOMEN, then had to be steadied and alter course to the outside of LOHN RANGER, which shifted in.

SABERMETRIC (L. Neindorf) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 700m had to be steadied momentarily when LOHN RANGER shifted in. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

WONDERWOMEN (B. Vorster) – inside the 300m was forced to race in restricted room and then became held up until near the 200m when awkwardly placed to the inside of TANJA'S DREAM, which had been taken in.

MY RUBY (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

LOHN RANGER (A. Jordsjo) - near the 700m shifted in onto SABERMETRIC. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a). Inside the 300m shifted in onto TANJA'S DREAM, which was taken in slightly and then had to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

#### RACE 8: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES CHRISTMAS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

STREETCAR STRANGER (K. Crowther) – slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S A BALTER (B. Vorster) – jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was severely hampered when CHAMPAGNE DREAMS shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SECOND SLIP (NZ) (B. Price) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early stages of the event; however, when asked to improve when rounding the home turn SECOND SLIP (NZ) dipped on a number of occasions. He added that the gelding commenced to weaken quickly and therefore he did not ride SECOND SLIP (NZ) out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



#### RACE 8: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES CHRISTMAS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

STRUCK BY (L. Neindorf) – laid out under pressure over the concluding 200m. In the vicinity of 150m shifted out under riding when insufficiently clear onto SCREWED DOWN, which was force to take hold. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 17 December 2022 and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 28 December 2022, a period of six meetings.

BOLD STAR (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

COUNTOFMONTECRISTO (E. Wong) – laid in under pressure in the straight. When questioned into the reasons he had shifted out wide rounding the home turn and into the straight, rider explained that they were the instructions provided. Trainer Mr. T Doudle confirmed that the instructions were to shift out rounding the home turn and make sure he was the widest runner in the straight as in his opinion the gelding is better suited when making its run to the outside of the field.

CHAMPAGNE DREAMS (E. Finnegan) - shifted out abruptly on jumping away onto HE'S A BALTER.

SCREWED DOWN (C. Puls) - had its tongue tie replaced upon arrival at the barriers. Raced three wide without cover throughout the event. Near the 150 was forced to take hold to avoid the heels of STRUCK BY, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (4/5). Trainer, Mr P. Preusker was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

#### RACE 9: HAPPY 40TH ADAM DENTE HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

DYNAMIC THINKER (A. Lindsay) – approaching the 100m had to be steadied when LOVE MAGIC was taken into its running line by BAMYAN BUDDHA. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KONG (C. Rawiller) – inconvenienced on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour advised that KONG would now be spelled.

MR MARATHON MAN (GB) (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

OUTPOST (A. Livesey) - shifted in on jumping away onto KONG. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BAMYAN BUDDHA (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly. Inside the 200m shifted in slightly onto LOVE MAGIC, which was taken in onto DYNAMIC THINKER. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground. Near the 50m had to be momentarily steadied when it shifted out and became awkwardly placed on the heels of TEST THE LAW, which shifted in slightly.

SMOKIN' VAL (S. Callow) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

LOVE MAGIC (B. Vorster) - approaching the 100m was taken in slightly into the running line of DYNAMIC THINKER by BAMYAN BUDDHA.

WHEELS (NZ) (T. Voorham) – slow to begin. Held up from inside the 300m when racing behind DYNAMIC THINKER and inside LOVE MAGIC and was unable to obtain clear ground until near the 150m.

TAHNEE TRADITION (L. Neindorf) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Had to be momentarily steadied near the 200m when KONG was taken out slightly into its running line by LIANNE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.





LIANNE (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

#### <u>GENERAL</u>

Stewards undertook an inspection of the male and female jockey's room for the presence of mobile phones. At subsequent separate inquiries:

- 1. A. Jordsjo pleaded guilty to a charge under AR218(4)(b) in that after the running of Race 7 she had in her possession in the jockey's room a mobile phone and was fined \$500. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account that she had handed her mobile phone in at the earliest opportunity, her previous record, forthrightness, guilty plea and that they were able to confirm that she had not used her mobile phone from the time that she arrived on course and the time that the Stewards took possession.
- 2. C. Puls pleaded guilty to a charge under AR218(4)(b) in that after the running of Race 7 she had in her possession in the jockey's room a mobile phone and was fined \$400. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account that she had handed her mobile phone in at the earliest opportunity, her extremely good record, forthrightness, guilty plea and that they were able to confirm that she had not used her mobile phone from the time that she arrived on course and the time that the Stewards took possession.
- 3. L. Neindorf pleaded guilty to a charge under AR218(4)(b) in that after the running of Race 7 he had in his possession in the jockey's room a mobile phone and was fined \$500. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account that he had handed his mobile phone in at the earliest opportunity, his previous records, forthrightness, guilty plea and that they were able to confirm that he had not used his mobile phone from the time that he arrived on course and the time that the Stewards took possession.
- 4. A. Lindsay pleaded guilty to a charge under AR218(4)(b) in that after the running of Race 7 she had in her possession in the jockey's room a mobile phone and was fined \$500. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account that she had handed her mobile phone in at the earliest opportunity, her previous record, forthrightness, guilty plea and that they were able to confirm that she had not used her mobile phone from the time that she arrived on course and the time that the Stewards took possession.

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#### RIDER SAMPLES:

All twenty-six (26) riders were breathalysed and provided saliva samples for drug screening prior to their first engagement and all results were negative.

Nine (9) riders provided urine samples: D. Tournuer, J. Potter, J. Maund, D. Caboche, E. Boyd, A. Livesey, J. Holder, S. Logan & K. Crowther
