## RACE 1: THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

ASTON RAPOVA (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

## RACE 2: THE FOTOBASE GROUP HANDICAP - 2022 Metres


CRYPTO CURRENCY (J. Opperman) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

## RACE 3: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES THREE-YEAR-OLD COLTS & GELDINGS MAIDENPLATE - 1100 Metres

Stewards started this event at 3.22 pm as that was the time listed on Racing Australia, TAB and scheduled on Sky Channel, despite some publications listing the starting time as 3.27 pm.

AMBELLO (T. Pannell) - trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to obtain cover in the event if possible. Obtained cover. Jumped away awkwardly and shortly after had to be eased when tightened between ANDREW'S MEMORY and BANIDCOOT, which both shifted ground slightly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

ANDREW'S MEMORY (D. Caboche) - laid out under pressure in the straight.



RACE 3: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES THREE-YEAR-OLD COLTS & GELDINGS  
MAIDENPLATE - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

CHIPSON (S. Logan) - slow to begin.

DUNMAGHLAS (A. Lindsay) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

ICE SYMPHONY (J. Toeroek) - laid out rounding the home turn.

ZAC'S BACK (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to review the start in relation to CHIPSON.

RACE 4: G.H. MUMM HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

ARTRESE (NZ) (B. Vorster) - rider explained that the gelding had travelled well during the event and had let down fairly; however, had pulled up quickly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IKNOWWHATYOU'RE DOING (J. Toeroek) - hampered on jumping away when contacted by MY BOY JETT and taken out onto POINTLESS PRAISE. Hung out under pressure in the straight.

MONSEAGLE (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

CHARLESFORT (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider was reminded of his obligations in riding his mounts out to the finish in accordance with AR131(b).

MY BOY JETT (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting IKNOWWHATYOU'RE DOING. Lost its off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

POINTLESS PRAISE (B. Price) - hampered on jumping away when tightened onto CHARLESFORT by IKNOWWHATYOU'RE DOING.

RACE 5: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately four minutes.

EXALTED MAXINE (S. Metcalfe) - rider was cautioned in relation to using her whip with an action that raises her arm above shoulder height.

RIALTOR (B. Price) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HONGBAO (B. Vorster) - contacted by ZARACE near the 50m and again approaching the finish.

ZARACE (A. Livesey) - lost its off fore plate en route to the barriers and had to be replated on arrival at the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Shifted out on jumping away and contacted WINNING REVOLUTION. Laid out over the concluding 100m and shifted out near the 50m and again approaching the finish, contacting HONGBAO.

TRYGVE (T. Voorham) - held up from the entrance to the straight until inside the 250m.

WINNING REVOLUTION (J. Holder) - shifted out on jumping away contacting ZARACE. Held up from the entrance to the straight until inside the 250m.





RACE 6: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 1519 Metres

YULONG PATROL (IRE) (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly.

STEALTHY LUCAS (C. Murray) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BRANDERS RULE (S. Metcalfe) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

TOORAK WARRIOR (T. Voorham) - held up from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m.

FLEURIEU FLIPPER (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOX GEM (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WARRANTYTE ROAD (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7: CROSER HANDICAP - 1519 Metres

DIXIE WHISTLER (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out rounding the home turn.

LACRIMA (T. Pannell) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

WHEELS (NZ) (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

KACIGA (D. Tootell (Snr)) - near the 700m had to be steadied for a number of strides when it improved onto the heels of NORDIC LASS, which had commenced to give ground.

MORE SHOTS (J. Potter) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NORDIC LASS (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

BLOOD SWEAT TEARS (J. Opperman) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 250m. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

AITCH D'AMICO (T. Pannell) - was inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened onto MUFFLA by MUG'S GAME. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

DISAGREEABLE MISS (B. Price) - slow to begin.

AMMO AMOR (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in abruptly onto MUFFLA. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

MUFFLA (B. Vorster) - rider had to take hold on jumping away when tightened onto AITCH D'AMICO by AMMO AMOR. Rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, had not let down when placed under pressure and did not feel comfortable in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PERMUTATION (J. Holder) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure was one-paced to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MUG'S GAME (C. Murray) - shifted out on jumping away onto AITCH D'AMICO.



RACE 9: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

DESTINY'S REPUBLIC (S. Callow) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained that it was her instructions to lead; however, the gelding had raced keenly with the addition of blinkers again and had led by more than she had intended. Trainer, Mr P. Hardacre, confirmed the instructions and advised that the gelding had led by more than he had anticipated.

STRATESSA (B. Price) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the mare never travelled and was not comfortable in its action over the concluding 200m of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOUR WINDS (B. Vorster) - brushed by HONEY GO LIGHTLY approaching the finish.

SPANISH STROLL (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

HONEY GO LIGHTLY (E. Boyd) - shifted out approaching the finish and brushed FOUR WINDS.
