Report on Race Meeting held at Lock Racecourse by the Lock Racing Club on Friday, 13 January 2023

RACE 1: MGA CUMMINS BENCHMARK 52 TROPHY - 1000 Metres

REGAL ROCKET (C. Murray) - slow into stride.

MELWAY (B. Wong) - hung out rounding the home turn.

RACE 2: THE MARINA HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

ALMARHOE (S. Fawke) - rider was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip consecutive strides.

DR CHOCCY (E. Annells) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed abnormal respiratory noise and the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

FUNNY LEGS (J. Doyle) - inside the 100m elected to shift out to maintain clear running as LEMON TART shifted out.

PRIMED MELODY (C. Munro) - laid out in the straight and proved difficult to ride.

BIG GIRL HELGA (C. Murray) - crossing the finish the line the mare appeared to jump a shadow and dislodged its rider. C. Murray was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and was passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.



LEMON TART (B. Wong) - shifted out inside the 100m.

RACE 3: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

SANDSATION (S. Fawke) – lost its off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg (4/5). Trainer, Mr M. White, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

TELEPORTATION (C. Murray) – rider explained in relation to the mare's disappointing performance that it never travelled commenced to weaken from the 600m, and for that reason he had elected not to ride the mare out in his usual manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg (2/5). Co-trainer, Ms J. Branford, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 4: LINCOLN LINGERIE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

GOODARCHIE (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly.

CRAZY CULPRIT (S. Fawke) - rider explained in relation to the gelding's disappointing performance that it travelled well in the early stages of the event; however, as it was first up it lacked fitness to maintain contact with the other runners and would benefit from the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: BOSTON BAY VILLAGE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

ONWARD (B. Wong) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was deemed suitable to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS HENDRIX (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

RACE 6: GLEN-FOREST TOURIST PARK BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

WHITCHETY GRUB (C. Murray) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the off foreleg (3/5) and therefore was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared WHITCHETY GRUB a late scratching at 1.15 pm. Stewards ordered that all monies invested on WHITCHETY GRUB prior to the time of its withdrawal be subject to the deductions of 20 cents in the dollar for the win and 19 cents in the dollar for the place. Trainer, Mr M. White, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

GIVEPEACE A CHANCE (F. Atkinson) – rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort over the concluding stages failed to respond to her riding.

JAMCRA (NZ) (H. Yuen) - held up over the concluding stages of the event behind NEAR MAGIC and as a result was untested to the finish.

NEAR MAGIC (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

SHOWBAG (J. Doyle) – near the 200m raced in restricted room for a short distance between NEAR MAGIC and LEAN THY ARMS (NZ).
