Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 5 February 2023

RACE 1: CREASER CONSTRUCTIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

BIG OPTION (J. Lorensini) - bumped near the 850m by FAMOUS STRIKE.

KIRJO'S STYLE (J. Potter) - slow to begin.

ONYA SHAMUS (S. Logan) - began awkwardly and lost ground.

FAMOUS STRIKE (A. Livesey) - near the 850m shifted out and bumped BIG OPTION.

LADY OF SPLENDOUR (J. Eaton) - had to be steadied near the 950m away from the heels of PADSTOW POLLY, which when racing keen shifted out.

MISS NIPPY (A. Jordsjo) - near the 800m had to be checked on the inside of PADSTOW POLLY, which when racing keen shifted in. Rider reported that the mare raced greenly throughout the event.

PADSTOW POLLY (N. Yuen) - raced very keen in the early and middle stages and near the 950m shifted out, clipped the heels of BARTY AYA and had to be checked. Continued to race keen for some distance thereafter and near the 800m shifted in and crowded MISS NIPPY, which had to be checked.

RACE 1: CREASER CONSTRUCTIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

I'VE GOT THAT (E. Wong) - began awkwardly and lost ground. Raced wide for the majority of the event.

QUICK FINGERS (J. Opperman) - slow to begin. Rider reported the filly hung out rounding the home turn.

DELTA RIVER (T. Voorham) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced in over twelve months and was deemed suitable to start. Hung in rounding the home turn and in the straight and proved difficult to ride.

RACE 2: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

AIR TIME (B. Wong) - raced keen in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in, in the straight.

SWANKYTOFF (J. Lorensini) - when questioned, rider explained that he was caught wide in the early stages of the race and therefore he allowed his horse to stride forward to the lead to obtain a position closer to the fence. He added as a result his horse raced further forward than anticipated.

ROGER'S DAY (J. Opperman) - raced keen in the early stages and near the 1200m shifted out to the three wide line and raced in that position for the remainder of the event without cover.

RACE 3: WOOLSHED INN BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

HAMSLETTE (J. Lorensini) – upon arrival on course co-trainers, Mr J & Mrs L Dodgson, advised that the mare had sprung a plate en route to the track. Subsequently the mare underwent a prerace veterinary examination and was found to be lame in the off foreleg (3/5) and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared HAMSLETTE a late scratching at 1.14pm. Co-trainers, Mr J & Mrs L Dodgson, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

NERRIVIK (S. Fawke) - when questioned in regards to the apparent disappointing performance rider stated the mare raced flat throughout, was under pressure from the 600m and failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Stewards questioned the stable representative for trainer A. Coffey, however he was unable to give any explanation in regards to the disappointing performance. Stewards advised Mr Coffey that he is required to inform the Stewards of the future plans of the mare or any condition that may appear in the next few days.

SESAR (E. Wong) - raced keen in the middle stages of the event when the pace of the race eased.

NASEEB (T. Voorham) - raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event.

I'LL BE GONE (C. Murray) – slow into stride. When questioned in regard to the riding tactics rider explained that he was instructed by the trainer that although the horse has been racing back in its most recent starts it can race perform well when racing on the pace, so therefore, if the pace eases, don't be afraid to go forward. Rider said that after being slow into stride the pace slackened from the 1200m and therefore he took the opportunity to work to the lead without doing much work.

TWICE FORGOTTEN (J. Eaton) - rider reported the mare made respiratory noises throughout the race and on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 4: BORDERTOWN PUMPS & REFRIGERATION BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Eaton (NORSE MYTHOLOGY) to view the vision of the start. After doing so J. Eaton made a submission to the Stewards that she was denied a fair start. Stewards also gave consideration to whether ALLGO, was denied a fair start After taking evidence and viewing the film, Stewards were of the opinion that under AR204 both horses were not denied a fair start, and as such were declared runners.

NORSE MYTHOLOGY (J. Eaton) - began awkwardly and lost ground. Raced wide throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KASAMI (J. Lorensini) - began awkwardly.

ALLGO (E. Wong) - as the start was effected the gelding put its head down and lost considerable ground.

UNICORNY (C. Tootell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

GIALLO (S. Logan) - began awkwardly and lost ground.

RACE 5: BRANDT RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes due to delaying for an interstate race, and further due to a power shortage prior to the start.

SPY COLONEL (J. Doyle) - raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SOUTHFIELD (N. Yuen) - hung out throughout and raced very wide rounding the home turn and in the straight, proving difficulty to ride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr J. Barry, said the mare had her teeth done between last start and this start and felt there may have been something there that aggravated the horse. He added, however, that it is his intention to spell the mare for a couple of months prior to starting again. Mr Barry was advised that a warning had been placed against the mare for her racing manners.

BASSONS (S. Metcalfe) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was deemed suitable to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: HARPERS PARCEL FREIGHT RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

RICHED (S. Fawke) – near the 1000m had to be steadied when racing keenly to avoid the heels of DECISIVE HEART, which shifted in when not quite clear. Shortly after entering the straight was bumped on its inside by BENOVSKY, which was improving into a narrow run. As a result RICHED's hindquarters were turned out resulting in the horse becoming momentarily unbalanced. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed RICHED would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000m in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a trial or race start.

CLAUDIA SHIVER (NZ) (J. Opperman) - held up from the 350m to the 200m behind RICHED and BENOVSKY.

RODNEY (B. Wong) - slow to begin. Held up in the early stages of the straight behind DECISIVE HEART and JOURNEY IN TIME.

FIFTY FOUR SQUARES (T. Voorham) - rider reported the mare hung out rounding the home turn and in the straight.

DECISIVE HEART (S. Logan) - shifted in near the 1000m when insufficiently clear of RICHED, which had to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

RACE 6: HARPERS PARCEL FREIGHT RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

BENOVSKY (E. Wong) - near the 250m was momentarily held up and then bumped the hind quarters of RICHED when attempting to improve into a narrow run between that horse and HIGHWAY TO SUCCESS. Rider was advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances.

RACE 7: O'CONNORS CASE IH BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately six minutes due to numerous late scratchings.

KYTELER (J. Lorensini) - after being loaded in the barriers, became fractious, reared and got its leg caught in the side partitions. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared KYTELER a late scratching at 5.17pm. Trainer, Mr H. Dwyer, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding's pre-race manners.

BOADICEA (J. Eaton) - whilst attempting to load the mare in the barriers the mare reared over.and struck its head. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared BOADICEA a late scratching at 5.18pm. Trainer, Mr A. Bobbin, was advised that the mare would now be required to load to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump-out prior to a future race start.

WONAEAMIRRI (T. Voorham) - hung in, in the straight and proved difficult to ride.

MISS HARMONIUM (S. Logan) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced in over twelve months and was deemed suitable to start. Acting on a report from the Starter that the mare refused to be loaded in the barrier Stewards ordered the late scratching of MISS HARMONIUM at 5.19pm. Trainer, Mr J. Lynch, was advised that due to the mare's previous history MISS HARMONIUM would now be required to complete three consecutive Official Barrier Trials to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to a future race start.

YANACOCHA (S. Metcalfe) - whilst parading behind the barriers, the gelding was kicked by MISS HARMONIUM. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Acting on a report from the Starter that the gelding refused to be loaded in the barriers YANACOCHA was declared a late scratching by order of the Stewards at 5.21pm. After considering all the circumstances leading up to the gelding refusing to be loaded and also its previous clean history, Trainer, Mr D. Page, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding's pre-race manners.
