RACE 1: TRIMBOLI SERVICES MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 Metres

ALWAYS SOMETIMES (S. Fawke) - co-trainer, Mr D. Magro, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to gain cover in today's event. Settled back of midfield. Reared as the start was effected and as a result lost considerable ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOOSE RIVER (S. Tomlinson) – gave ground quickly over the concluding stages of the event and was disappointing. Rider could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance, and added that MOOSE RIVER had pulled up in a normal manner.

ROCKONOVA (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Near the 400m was bumped by WAKE ME UP WINSTON, which had been taken out by BUGATTI GOLD, and became unbalanced.

WAKE ME UP WINSTON (S. Metcalfe) - laid out rounding the home turn and near the 400m was inconvenienced when bumped by BUGATTI GOLD, which had shifted out.

FLYING TIVACI (NZ) (J. Maund) - near the 400m was steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of ALWAYS SOMETIMES.

FRUSCIANTE (J. Potter) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and found to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5) and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared FRUSCIANTE a late scratching at 1.38 pm. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 1: TRIMBOLI SERVICES MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 Metres (cont'd)

PRANCING IBIS (E. Wong) - rider reported that when placed under pressure near the 1000m the mare failed to respond to his riding, and near the 800m commenced to give ground changing stride on several occasions. As a result, in the straight he did not ride the mare out as he had become concerned with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BUGATTI GOLD (B. Wong) -near the 400m shifted out and contacted PRANCING IBIS. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: MATRIX SOLAR SOLUTIONS COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

BYWATERS ROAD (J. Maund) - was eased out in the straight by its rider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have cardiac arrhythmia. Co-trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, was advised that the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

FANTASTIC HOST (S. Payne) - laid out near the 100m before being straightened by its rider and as a result became unbalanced.

MIAMI STAR (L. Neindorf) - began awkwardly and was then hampered by PINCHBECK, which began awkwardly and shifted out. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

STOKEDOWN (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

JACOBS GATE (J. Doyle) - slow to begin. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

PINCHBECK (S. Metcalfe) - began awkwardly and shifted out abruptly. Raced wide in the early stages of the event.

RACE 3: KINGSFORD HOTEL FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

CYGNUS ATRATUS (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that the mare laid out under pressure in the straight.

EXALTED DAME (J. Holder) - hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

FUNOFTHEFAIR (E. Wong) - co-trainer, Mr G. Searle, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to gain cover in today's event. Settled midfield with cover.

INAGURATE (S. Fawke) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Near the 200m had to be eased when racing in restricted room between FUNOFTHEFAIR, which shifted out marginally, and ATHANOR, which shifted in slightly.

REBEL MISTRESS (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ROC THE WOLF (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ATHANOR (F. Atkinson) - hampered near the 300m when brushed by SERBIAN GIRL, which shifted in slightly.

ELECTRIC MAYHEM (J. Potter) – began awkwardly. Rider reported that he had become concerned with the filly's action over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS REMSKI (C. Murray) - began awkwardly and then hampered when tightened for room between BARBRA'S WISH, which shifted out, and SERBIAN GIRL, which shifted in. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: KINGSFORD HOTEL FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

SERBIAN GIRL (B. Wong) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Near the 300m shifted in and brushed ATHANOR.

RACE 4: ELLIOT SCOTT 60TH BIRTHDAY CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

VAMPIRE SLAYER (E. Wong) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained that in his opinion being caught wide was detrimental to the mare's chances today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MYSTIC STORM (S. Callow) - near the 600m and again near the 400m raced tight to the inside of NORTHERN SUPERSTAR when that gelding shifted in before being straightened by its rider.

NORTHERN SUPERSTAR (S. Fawke) - shifted in before being straightened by its rider near the 600m and again near the 400m. Rider was reprimanded and advised to ensure he leaves comfortable room to his inside in future.

MISS MCGREGOR (S. Logan) - near the 350m, when improving, was obliged to shift to the outside of MYSTIC STORM to obtain clear running.

PRINCESS SALLY (S. Metcalfe) - slow to begin.

RACE 5: LJ HOOKER GAWLER/BAROSSA CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

QUIETLY SPOKEN (NZ) (S. Fawke) - slow to begin and slow to muster early speed. As a result lost considerable ground. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

TALES OF CONFLICT (J. Doyle) - near the 350m was hampered when brushed by HOUSE SPOUSE (NZ), which shifted out when attempting to improve. Lost its off hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOUSE SPOUSE (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - co-trainer, Mr R. Jolly, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to settle more forward in today's event. Settle forward of midfield. Near the 350m shifted out to improve and brushed TALES OF CONFLICT, which was hampered. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEAFARING (NZ) (S. Logan) - rider dropped her whip near the 300m.

INKA DINKA (J. Potter) - raced wide throughout the event and laid out rounding the home turn.

SHE'S FULL OF IT (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early stages. Raced wide for the majority of the event.

RACE 6: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2100 Metres

ACE ATTACK (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

WEST CLIFF (J. Opperman) - hampered at the start by PARSONAGE LANE, which shifted out, and as a result lost ground. Near the 200m was eased when racing tight between MYSTIC KNOT and PARSONAGE LANE, which shifted out.

CARRY THE MUSKET (E. Wong) - raced wide without cover in the early stages and had to be eased to obtain cover. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg (3/5). First aid administered. Co-trainers, Mr G. and Mrs N. Searle and Mrs B. Callanan, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

ANOTHER FREE GLASS (B. Vorster) - raced wide throughout the event.

ALPINE BEAU (J. Maund) - slow to begin.



RACE 6: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2100 Metres (cont'd)

PLAISIR (B. Wong) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$200. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by B. Wong and noted that she used it on ten occasions over the final 100m of the event and also took into account her record in relation to this rule.

MYSTIC KNOT (S. Logan) - hampered near the 300m when brushed by WEST CLIFF, which was taken out by PARSONAGE LANE.

PARSONAGE LANE (T. Voorham) - began awkwardly and shifted out. Near the 200m shifted out and tighten WEST CLIFF, which had to be eased. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding and was advised that in similar circumstances she must stop riding and straighten her mounts sooner than she did on this occasion.

RACE 7: IRONGATE AUSTRALIA BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

ARCHERY BUTTS (F. Atkinson) – rider reported that she felt there was something amiss with the gelding's action over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg (2/5). First aid administered. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

SWAMP VIXEN (S. Tomlinson) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

FIABLE (NZ) (R. Milnes) - slow to begin.

WARMINSTER (B. Price) - near the 100m was taken in by LIANNE, which shifted in under pressure.

LIANNE (B. Vorster) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Near the 100m shifted in taking WARMINSTER in onto MISS MIDUKI. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding and advised in future he would be required to make a far greater effort to keep his mounts straight in similar circumstances.

MISS MIDUKI (E. Wong) - held up for clear running from the 400m until the 300m. Near the 100m raced in restricted room between POSSUM BORN and WARMINSTER, which was taken in by LIANNE, which shifted in when laying in.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (D. Tootell (Snr)) – contacted a running rail en route to the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on the barriers and was deemed suitable to start. Rider reported that near the 600m his saddle shifted backwards placing him at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.

CUT TO PIECES (T. Voorham) - held up for clear running from near the 400m until near the 200m.


