

# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

RACE 1: PIRATE LIFE MAIDEN PLATE - 1360 Metres

ALWAYS SOMETIMES (S. Fawke) - slow into stride.

SWISS TIME (H. Yuen) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

COOL THE JETS (D. Tourneur) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure from the entrance to the straight did not quicken as anticipated. He added he had become concerned with COOL THE JETS action over the final 100m and for that reason he did not ride the gelding out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have cardiac arrhythmia. Co-trainers, Mr P. & Mrs B. Blanch were advised that the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.



RACE 1: PIRATE LIFE MAIDEN PLATE - 1360 Metres (cont'd)

MOOSE RIVER (S. Callow) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and found to have a laceration to its near side eye lid and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared MOOSE RIVER a late scratching at 10.53 am. Trainer, Mr S. Ratsch was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

CATO LAKE (C. Murray) - raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight.

RACE 2: MILLIE MAE'S MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

CHOGGY'S MY MATE (J. Lorensini) - in the vicinity of the 200m became disappointed for a run to between SHOSANNA and SHAKE MY BEAUTY, and was obliged to alter course to the inside of those runners to obtain clear running.

SOLEMN PROMISE (D. Tourneur) - inside the 500m was taken wider by MISS ELLAROSE. Rider explained that the filly hung out in the early and middle stages of the event and laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHOSANNA (E. Boyd) - hung out throughout the event. Rider reported that in her opinion the mare did not handle the tight track. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ISLAND PLEA (S. Callow) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

MISS ELLAROSE (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event. Inside the 500m was inconvenienced and taken wider by PADSTOW POLLY onto SOLEMN PROMISE.

BICKERING (S. Metcalfe) - approaching the finish was unable to be tested as it became held up on the heels of SHAKE MY BEAUTY.

GREY FOLLY (F. Atkinson) - slow into stride.

PADSTOW POLLY (H. Yuen) - Stewards permitted H. Yuen to replace B. Price as there was no other rider available at the weight. Near the 800m jumped a patch in the track for no apparent reason. Inside the 500m shifted out inconveniencing MISS ELLAROSE taking that filly wider on the track. Rider was reprimanded and advised, in future, to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

RACE 3: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

ULTIMATE VICTORY (D. Tourneur) - hung in throughout the event.

LITTLE TOWN BLUES (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped UTAH JOE.

I'M KENNY (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.


UTAH JOE (S. Metcalfe) - bumped on jumping away by LITTLE TOWN BLUES.

RODNEY (B. Wong) - slow to begin.

SMARTKAP (E. Boyd) - lost its position on jumping away when tightened between I'M KENNY and ZEGRESTO, which shifted out.

ZEGRESTO (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and tightened SMARTKAP.

RACE 4: DUDLEY WINES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres



STEALTHY LUCAS (J. Potter) - held up from near the 400m until inside the 300m when obliged to shift in to obtain clear running. Approaching the finish raced in restricted room to the inside of HAVAUEL (NZ), which laid in.



RACE 4: DUDLEY WINES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres (cont'd)

STRADARI (R. Milnes) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Mr K. Healy, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

HAVADUEL (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - laid in, in the straight.

CALL ME VEXATIOUS (C. Murray) - hung out rounding the turn out of the home straight on the first occasion. Rider reported that the gelding never travelled throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGNOSSIVA (C. Munro) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

I'LL BE GONE (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out abruptly placing its rider at a disadvantage in the early stages of the event. Trainer, Mr S. Lenehan, was advised that a warning had placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

RACE 5: G & J EAST STRATHALBYN BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1880 Metres

EPAULETTE PRINCE (S. Callow) - laid out in the straight and inside the 300m shifted out and inconvenienced ÉCLAIR RHYTHM (NZ). Rider was reprimanded and advised to stop riding and straighten her mounts sooner when they commence to shift ground.

FINNEY (D. Tourneur) - Trainer, Mr T. Doudle was fined \$100 under AR65(1) for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Laid in, in the straight. Inside the 200m shifted in and bumped ÉCLAIR RHYTHM (NZ).

I'M BULLETPROOF (S. Metcalfe) - near the 800m improved onto the heels of BELLATOR and was obliged to be restrained.

PAINTED ON (B. Wong) - hung in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider reported that PAINTED ON never travelled throughout the event.

LITTLEBITFUNNY (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly.

ÉCLAIR RHYTHM (NZ) (J. Potter) - inside the 300m was inconvenienced by EPAULETTE PRINCE, which shifted out. Inside the 200m was bumped by FINNEY, which shifted in.

RACE 6: KANGAROO ISLAND FREIGHT SERVICES BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1360 Metres

COWLEY'S CREEK (F. Atkinson) - inside the 50m attempted a run into restricted room to the inside of THE LADIES MAN, had to be checked and lost its position. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to only improve into a run where there is sufficient room.

THE LADIES MAN (S. Callow) - approaching the finish had its hind quarters bumped by COWLEY'S CREEK.

SELF SUFFICIENT (S. Metcalfe) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OLIVE GROVE (S. Fawke) - rounding the home turn became awkwardly placed between the heels of GREY VITALITY and SELF SUFFICIENT and had to be steadied. Near the 300m had to be momentarily steadied away from the heels of SELF SUFFICIENT.

SOUTHERN MAGNOLIA (NZ) (D. Tourneur) - rider reported that the mare raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GREY VITALITY (E. Boyd) - near the 150m was momentarily inconvenienced when SELF SUFFICIENT shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Stewards to view the vision of the start.



RACE 7: WOLF BLASS PATRONS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1215 Metres

IMPORTANT PRODUCT (E. Boyd) - hung out under pressure rounding the home turn.

ALPHAEUUS (S. Fawke) - in the vicinity of the 200m rolled in under pressure.

BAY OF ANGELS (F. Atkinson) - inside the 200m was obliged to shift out to avoid the heels of ALPHAEUUS, which rolled in. From the 100m raced in restricted room between REAL VALENTIA and ALPHAEUUS. Approaching the finish had to be checked when both runners shifted marginally.

LUVUTEO (C. Murray) - rider explained that his instructions were to settle behind the pace in the early stages of the event. He added that he was able to follow those instructions given the early pace of the event and travelled well in the middle stages; however, was reluctant to improve when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
