INTERIM REPORT

RACE 1: CROSER HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

BOOLCUNDA KING (D. Tourneur) – stood flat-footed and missed the start several lengths. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Co-trainers, Mr P. & Mrs B. Blanch, were advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its starting manner.



RACE 1: CROSER HANDICAP - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

MONTEPULCIANO (K. Crowther) - near the 300m was inconvenienced when its hindquarters were turned by IMPOSING SYSPECT (NZ).

AITCH D'AMICO (J. Bowditch) - slow to begin.

STARTS WITH HELLO (J. Toeroek) - rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(b) to ride his mounts out to the end of the race.

IMPOSING SUSPECT (NZ) (C. Murray) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 300m shifted out slightly to improve and in doing so contacted the hindquarters of MONTEPULCIANO.

RACE 2: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

PRAIRIE FLOWER (W. Price) - slow to begin.

PRESS DOWN (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding raced fiercely in the early and middle stages and, in his opinion, for that reason did not finish its race off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5). Trainer, Mr P. Hardacre, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

KILLIAKO (K. Crowther) - held up over the concluding 400m of the event when awkwardly placed between the heels of KLABEL (NZ) and TAPINFORPAR.

TAPINFORPAR (L. Neindorf) - shifted out on jumping away and brushed KLABEL (NZ).

RACE 3: WHITE CLAW HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

MR ROGER (NZ) (B. Price) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Ms K. Mooney, was advised that as this was the gelding's second bled it was now ineligible to start in a race in accordance with AR79(6).

DRAFT DAY (NZ) (J. Allen) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

EXTRA MILE (S. Tomlinson) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

VERSETTO (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WICKED ADDICTION (C. Jones) - held up from near the 400m until inside the 200m.

LORD MORTON (L. Neindorf) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: THOMAS FARMS CINDERELLA STAKES - 1050 Metres

TIZ ENUF (B. Melham) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto I AM IMMACULATE. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Commenced to hang out from the vicinity of the 700m. Near the 300m, continued to hang out, and shifted out onto SHESALLSHENANIGANS. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight when they commence to shift ground. Continued to lay out near the 100m and then commence to lay in to the finish. Rider reported that the filly raced keenly, wanted to shift about and may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be shin sore in the off foreleg.

SHOW ROYALE (J. Bowditch) - near the 300m was inconvenienced when taken wider by SHESALLSHENANIGANS.

SHESALLSHENANIGANS (B. McDougall) - near the 300m was inconvenienced when taken out onto SHOW ROYALE by TIZ ENUF.

RACE 4: THOMAS FARMS CINDERELLA STAKES - 1050 Metres (cont'd)

CHEROKEE MISS (J. Toeroek) - inside the 300m had to be steadied when BOSSY NIC shifted out. Rider could offer no explanation for the filly's performance today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild abrasions to the off hind leg.

KRISTOBEL (K. Crowther) - near the 300m was inconvenienced when taken wider by ZELTA.

BOSSY NIC (D. Holland) - slow to begin. Inside the 300m shifted in onto CHEROKEE MISS, which had to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

DIAMONDS CHOICE (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

I AM IMMACULATE (J. McNeil) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Slow to begin and shortly after was inconvenienced by TIZ ENUF. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZELTA (J. Childs) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 300m was inconvenienced when SHOW ROYALE was taken out into its running line.

RACE 5: C S HAYES MEMORIAL CUP - 1600 Metres

DALASAN (J. Holder) – laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the horse did not quicken as he had expected and laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IRONCLAD (GB) (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported that the gelding raced in a flat manner today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

NOT USUAL GLORIOUS (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly.

HASTA LA WAR (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BELTORO (T. Nugent) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

LACRIMA (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

DISAGREEABLE MISS (J. Eaton) - slow to begin.

EN FRANCAIS (L. Neindorf) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: SKYCITY MATRICE STAKES - 1200 Metres

KEMALPASA (J. Toeroek) - awkward to begin. Inside the 100m shifted out and away from LORD VLADIVOSTOK (NZ) onto MORVADA.

CALYPSO REIGN (K. Crowther) - rider reported the gelding made an abnormal respiratory noise during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

OUTLAWS REVENGE (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

MORVADA (C. Murray) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inside the 100m was inconvenienced when taken out of its running line by KEMALPASA.

AGREEABLE (J. McNeil) - slow to begin.



RACE 7: TAB ADELAIDE CUP - 3200 Metres

GRAND PROMENADE (GB) (J. Allen) – jumped away awkwardly. At the finish had to be steadied when tightened between STARS OF CARRUM, which was taken out slightly by TEAM CAPTAIN (IRE), and WAGON WHEEL (NZ), which shifted in and away from PERSAN.

CHALK STREAM (GB) (J. McNeil) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained that the gelding over-raced in the early and middle stages, which was detrimental to its chances today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TEAM CAPTAIN (IRE) (D. Holland) - near the 3000m shifted in and bumped BUSKER'S BALLAD. Rider reprimanded under AR131(a). Near the 700m became awkwardly placed on the heels of WOLF PRINCE for a number of strides when that gelding commenced to give ground.

TRUE MARVEL (FR) (D. Thornton) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

WHEELS (NZ) (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WOLF PRINCE (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Commenced to weaken from the vicinity of the 1000m. Rider was questioned in relation to the use of her whip in the straight. She explained that as the regular rider of the gelding she is aware that WOLF PRINCE always has a flat spot from near the 700m until straightening and for this reason had elected to use the whip to encourage the gelding. She added that after she received no response she put the whip away for the remainder of the event. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR132(6)(c) and AR132(6)(d) in relation to use of the whip when her mount was out of contention and showing no response.

REBEL RACER (C. Newitt) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BUSKER'S BALLAD (A. Livesey) - near the 3000m was inconvenienced when contacted by TEAM CAPTAIN (IRE).

RACE 8: THE FOTOBASE GROUP MORPHETTVILLE GUINEAS - 1600 Metres

DASHING (B. Melham) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened onto ANDREW'S MEMORY by LORD GEORGE, which shifted out, resulting in the gelding losing its position.

FOX DUNNETT (B. McDougall) - slow to begin.

ANDREW'S MEMORY (J. Maund) - contacted on jumping away.

LORD GEORGE (L. Neindorf) - shifted out on jumping away onto DASHING.

FIELD THE MOMENT (Z. Spain) - trainer, Mr P. Stokes, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to settle further back with cover in today's event. Settled forward of midfield without cover. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ANDREW'S MEMORY. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

EASTERLY (J. Toeroek) - inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that he was concerned with the filly's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

MUZUKASHII (C. Newitt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

DUAL FUEL (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

CASHIN' CHEX (NZ) (J. Allen) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Rider reported that his right foot had slipped back in the iron on jumping away and he was required to readjust his foot near the 800m.

GREAT LEVELLER (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1050 Metres (cont'd)

AIGUILETTE (D. Tourneur) - rider accidentally dropped his whip approaching the 100m.

QUEMAN (J. Potter) - lost its off fore plate approaching the finish.

POINT BLAZE (K. Crowther) - laid out rounding the home turn. Inside the 300m was inconvenienced when MAGIC MAX shifted out and beat it into a run to the inside of GREAT LEVELLER.

SIYATA (GB) (T. Nugent) - slow to begin. Rider explained that when placed under pressure the mare did not respond to his riding as anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
