Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse by the Penola Racing Club on Sunday, 9 April 2023

RACE 1: PRINCE OF WALES HOTEL PENOLA MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

The scheduled start time of this event was delayed approximately three minutes due to a delay with an interstate race and delays behind the barriers.

TWO KAY KLICK (T. Voorham) – proved fractious and difficult to load. Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 500m.

EASE OFFA (S. Metcalfe) – raced greenly and shifted in near the 1000m tightening UNCHAINED LAD onto MR FERRARI, which had to be steadied. Continued to race green thereafter, and near the 900m stumbled. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MR FERRARI (A. Jordsjo) – tightened at the start between GOLDEN AKEED and MIZZ BEEBEEF, which began awkwardly and shifted in. Tightened and steadied near the 1000m on the inside of UNCHAINED LAD and as a result raced further back than intended.

IMPERIAL SEAL (A. Livesey) - rider reported that the gelding hung out from the 800m.

BONANSKI (J. Maund) - raced wide for the majority of the race.

MIZZ BEEBEEFF (Z. Lloyd) - began awkwardly, shifted in and tightened MR FERRARI onto GOLDEN AKEED.



BELL'S SECRET (H. Yuen) - raced green in the straight and near the 100m shifted in and had to be steadied away from the heels of MR FERRARI.

RACE 1: PRINCE OF WALES HOTEL PENOLA MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

UNCHAINED LAD (S. Fawke) – Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the gelding 0.5kgs over its allocated weight of 54.0kgs. Tongue-tie had to be re-fitted prior to being placed in its barrier. Tightened near the 1000m between MR FERRARI and EASE OFFA, which shifted in when racing greenly.

GOLDEN AKEED (D. Caboche) - tightened at the start between BELL'S SECRET and MR FERRARI, which was taken in by MIZZ BEEBEEFF.

MELANIE'S JOY (J. Doyle) - rider reported that the mare hung out, raced greenly and proved difficult to ride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: ADRIAN THOMAS INDUSTRIAL MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

HE DID IT (K. Walters) - rider reported that the gelding was not comfortable with the track conditions.

SHOCK REACTION (NZ) (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover from the 800m.

DELCREDERE (H. Grace) - shortly after the start had to be checked away from the heels of MERRY CHOICE, which shifted in abruptly. When questioned rider explained the gelding hung in in the straight and he was not happy with the geldings action when he placed it under pressure. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(b) in that he failed to ride his mount out fully to the end of the race, which may of resulted in him losing fourth place. He was also advised that in future he should report matters that may affect the horse's performance to Stewards at the scales. A postrace veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities

MERRY CHOICE (S. Payne) – attempted to buck shortly after the start, shifted in abruptly and hampered DELCREDERE, which was checked. Trainer, Mr S. Fisher, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare's racing manners.

SIP OF SODA (D. Caboche) – near the 1100m had to be checked away from the heels of MERRY CHOICE, which was losing ground.

TAVERN MUSIC (A. Jordsjo) – rider reported that the mare was not comfortable with the track conditions, particularly when placed under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: THE MIDFIELD GROUP CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

REALTIN (C. Tootell) - hung in when placed under pressure in the straight.

RED ROOF (S. Metcalfe) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

FAVASHEM (J. Doyle) - raced keen in the early stages of the event.


JOURNEY IN TIME (C. Murray) – rider reported that the mare was not comfortably with the track conditions and performed below expectations.

COMIENDO (T. Voorham) - raced wide in the middle stages of the event.

PRINCESS SALLY (S. Fawke) - Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the mare 0.5kgs over its allocated weight of 54.0kgs.

RACE 4: TDC LIVESTOCK AND PROPERTY RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

TEEMENZED (NZ) (K. Walters) - slow to begin and then lost further ground when tightened between KEETTOM and IN THE SUN, both of which shifted ground.



IN THE SUN (J. Doyle) - began awkwardly, shifted out and hampered TEEMENZED (NZ).



RACE 4: TDC LIVESTOCK AND PROPERTY RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

REAL ROY (A. Jordsjo) - slipped near the 300m, became unbalanced and lost ground. A postrace veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Following this event, Stewards and a delegation of jockeys inspected the track near the 300m and deemed it safe to continue racing.

RACE 5: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

JAGUARY (NZ) (H. Ingram) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

LOAD AND GO (J. Eaton) - rider accidentally dropped her whip near the 300m.

TONY MONTANA (C. Tootell) - rider reported that the gelding was not comfortable with the track conditions.

RACE 6: OMNIZAR BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

CONFIDANT (D. Tourneur) – near the 800m had to be eased when awkwardly placed close to the heels of LANCASTER SOUND, which shifted out slightly. Near the 250m shifted in across the heels of UNLIMITED ABILITY to obtain a clear run.

LANCASTER SOUND (J. Opperman) - laid in in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES PENOLA CUP - 1700 Metres

DOMINUS (NZ) (H. Grace) – was taken wider rounding the home turn and in the straight by RIALTOR on its inside.

ALSVIOR (J. Maund) - stood flat-footed and lost ground at the start.

MUNTHAM MISSILE (A. Livesey) - slow to begin. Raced keen in the early and middle stages of the event.

RIALTOR (S. Tomlinson) - shifted out rounding the home turn and in the straight and forced DOMINUS (NZ) wider.

BLACK SYRAH (J. Eaton) – raced keen in the early stages and near the 1400m had to be steadied when tightened between WILD WILLY and HASTA LA FIORENT, which when racing keenly, got its head up and shifted out.

AMMO AMOR (S. Metcalfe) – shifted out near the 800m when insufficiently clear of HASTA LA FIORENTE, resulting in that horse having to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

HASTA LA FIORENTE (D. Tourneur) – raced keen in the early stages and near the 1400m shifted out tightening BLACK SYRAH onto WILD WILLY. Near the 500m had to be steadied away from the heels of AMMO AMOR, which shifted out.

SESAR (C. Murray) – Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the gelding 0.5kgs over its allocated weight of 54.0kgs. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow H. Grace and trainer S Cahill (DOMINUS (NZ)), placed second, to view the vision in the straight. After doing so H. Grace lodged an objection against RIALTOR (S. Tomlinson), being declared the winner of the race on the grounds of alleged interference between the 300m and 100m. After considering the evidence, viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards dismissed the objection.



RACE 8: WATTLE RANGE COUNCIL BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

GARBO (J. Eaton) - slow to begin.

RACE 8: WATTLE RANGE COUNCIL BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

TALES OF CONFLICT (J. Doyle) – approaching the 100m had to be steadied when tightened by WYNTER LADY, which was taken out by BUNUMBURT.

BUNUMBURT (A. Livesey) - shifted out in the straight and near the 100m tightened WYNTER LADY onto TALES OF CONFILCT, resulting in both horses having to be eased. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

SWISS TIME (H. Yuen) - slow to begin.

WYNTER LADY (C. Murray) - near the 100m was taken out by BUNUMBURT and was obliged to alter course.
