RACE 1: CREASER CONSTRUCTIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

DANTE ALEXANDER (E. Finnegan) - near the 900m was bumped by TAYLA'S MOMENT on its outside, which was hampered by MADDISON MISS.

MADDISON MISS (C. Tootell) - began awkwardly, shifted in and checked AJNA CHAKRA. Near the 900m shifted in slightly and bumped TAYLA'S MOMENT, which was taken in onto DANTE ALEXANDER.

TAYLA'S MOMENT (D. Tourneur) - near the 900m was bumped and buffeted between MADDISON MISS and DANTE ALEXANDER.

AJNA CHAKRA (D. Caboche) - at the start had to be checked when tightened by MADDISON MISS, which shifted in.

RACE 2: BRANDT MAIDEN PLATE - 2000 Metres

ARASSEM (C. Puls) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Rider reported that the gelding is better suited when racing over more ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SON OF VADAMOS (NZ) (D. Caboche) - raced keen in the early stages of the event.



RACE 2: BRANDT MAIDEN PLATE - 2000 Metres (cont'd)

WEEKEND WARRIOR (R. Milnes) – held up from the 400m until approaching the 150m behind PARVANI and to the inside of SON OF VADAMOS (NZ).

PUNCHIN (S. Payne) – forced wider near the 950m by SIR KINGSFORD on its inside. Rider was advised to be mindful of his elbow action when attempting to hold his position.

SIR KINGSFORD (K. Crowther) – shifted out near the 950m and forced PUNCHIN wider on the track.

JUST JOKING (T. Voorham) – rider reported the filly was slow to begin and as a result raced further back than anticipated. Hung in when placed under pressure in the straight.

VIC REEL (A. Jordsjo) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: HARPERS PARCEL FREIGHT MAIDEN PLATE - 1550 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes owing to YEAH WHATEVER requiring to be reshod on arrival at the barriers.

BODMIN BOY (Z. Lloyd) – raced in restricted room over the concluding stages of the event and as a result was not fully tested to the line.

PARSONAGE LANE (J. Potter) – raced wide rounding the first turn near the 1200m.

YEAH WHATEVER (R. Hurdle) – required to be reshod on arrival at the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

DANTASIA (C. Puls) – began awkwardly, shifted in and tightened IVA DREAM.

DUNALOCE (K. Crowther) – a representative from Trainer, Mr P. Stokes's stable advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to settle further forward in the event due to blinkers being placed on the filly. Settled mid to back in the field. Began awkwardly, shifted out and tightened IVA DREAM. Raced wide from the 400m. Rider reported that the filly only began average and was unable to muster early speed. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IVA DREAM (T. Voorham) – tightened at the start between DUNALOCE and BLACK MARMALADE (NZ), when both runners shifted ground. Rider reported as a result of the start the filly raced further back than intended.

PALE LAGER (J. Opperman) – rider reported the gelding raced awkwardly rounding the first turn near the 1200m and got its head up.

RACE 4: WOOLSHED INN BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

CAPELLANI (NZ) (J. Doyle) – had to be steadied near the 100m when tightened by LOOKING SUAVE (NZ), which shifted in. Shortly after CAPELLANI shifted out across LOOKING SUAVE (NZ)'s heels to maintain clear racing room. Rider dropped her whip just prior to the winning post.

COMFORT GIRL (C. Tootell) – held up in the early stages of the straight behind TOYETIC and DANRENA. Approaching the winning post had to be steadied when hampered by AL RANCHERO, which shifted out late under pressure.

LOOKING SUAVE (NZ) (K. Walters) – shifted in near the 100m when weakening and tightened CAPELLANI (NZ), which had to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

AL RANCHERO (A. Jordsjo) – shifted out late under pressure approaching the winning post and hampered COMFORT GIRL. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

QUEBECOIS (B. Price) – began awkwardly and lost ground. Raced wide in the early stages until near the 1300m. Raced wide without cover from the 700m.

DANRENA (Z. Lloyd) – laid in, in the straight.



RACE 5: BORDERTOWN PUMPS & REFRIGERATION BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

TERRITORY TITAN (C. Tootell) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

PEWTER (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin.

DIVINA SHOW (NZ) (C. Jones) - rider explained the mare travelled well in the early and middle stages; however, when placed under pressure near 500m failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RED ROOF (T. Voorham) - near the 250m brushed the rail when improving to the inside of DISCO TILMORN. Shied at the winning post and unbalanced its rider.

DISCO TILMORN (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: O'CONNORS CASE IH RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP (1) - 1200 Metres

RIPPA EAGLE (NZ) (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

LYNDA'S LEGACY (J. Doyle) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

OBELOS (GB) (A. Jordsjo) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it raced on Wednesday, 10 May 2023 and was deemed suitable to race. Began awkwardly, shifted in and bumped MONTRE.

MONTRE (D. Caboche) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Began awkwardly, was bumped by OBELOS (GB) and lost ground. Held up from the 300m to near the 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP (2) - 1200 Metres

REAL ROY (R. Hurdle) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it raced on Sunday, 7 May 2023 and was deemed suitable to race. Shifted out when entering the straight and carried LAST ZERPRISE out onto COMIENDO, which was momentarily tightened. Rider was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CHARM SLINGA (NZ) (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Near the 100m was bumped by LOOK FOR OPTIONS.

LOOK FOR OPTIONS (E. Finnegan) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Near the 100m was bumped by CHARM SLINGA (NZ).

OAMARU POPPY (J. Maund) - began awkwardly and shifted out.

LAST DREAM (NZ) (K. Walters) - on straightening was momentarily tightened when taken out by LAST ZERPRISE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COMIENDO (J. Opperman) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VEGAS DESTINY (NZ) (A. Livesey) - slow to begin. Held up from the 150m until approaching the 50m.

LAST ZERPRISE (B. Price) - on entering the straight was taken out by REAL ROY.

PRINCESS SALLY (S. Fawke) - Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the mare 0.5kg over its declared weight of 54.0kg.

SPENCER GULF (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Held up and was unable to be tested from near the 100m, behind IS THAT SO, which was weakening.



RACE 8: BORDERTOWN STONE SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP – 1550 Metres

POCKET RAIDER (K. Crowther) – raced keen in the early stages of the event.

JUST JAZZ (E. Finnegan) – raced keen in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOCIALITE MISS (B. Price) – fractious in its float en route to course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course which revealed a laceration to the mare's off hind leg and was also found to be lame in its off hind leg (2/5) and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice SOCIALITE MISS was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 2.28pm. Trainer, Ms R. Winnell was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

REGAL ROCKET (A. Jordsjo) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it raced on Sunday, 7 May 2023 and was deemed suitable to race.

SWISS TIME (H. Yuen) – slow to begin. Held up for clear racing room from the 300m behind REGAL ROCKET and DROMEAS and was not tested to the line.

KEEN IDEA (S. Fawke) - Stewards permitted S. Fawke to ride the gelding 0.5kg over its declared weight of 54.0kg.
