RACE 1: DUTTON'S EASY TO DO BUSINESS WITH!! MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

AIKHAL (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) -had to be steadied prior to entering the straight, away from the heels of WIRREALPA and shifted out to improve. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race sample was ordered however, the gelding was showing signs of distress and required immediate veterinary treatment. Consequently, no post-race swab was obtained. Trainer, Ms E. Hubbard, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

WIRREALPA (J. Toeroek) - rider reported that the gelding raced green throughout the event and hung out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery rate.

AJNA CHAKRA (D. Caboche) - bumped at the start.

DARE TO BE FREE (B. Wong) - rider reported that the mare raced green and hung out in the straight. Began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped AJNA CHAKRA.

LEGGY PEGGY (S. Logan) - rider reported that the mare hung out throughout the event.

RACE 2: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP - 7TH OCTOBER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

MAJESTIC MOSHE (R. Milnes) - held up for clear running between the 500m and 250m behind TREELINE (NZ). Over the concluding stages was tightened and buffeted between THAT'S UNFORTUNATE, which shifted out under pressure, and SHARMA PRINCESS (NZ).

THAT'S UNFORTUNATE (E. Finnegan) - shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages and bumped MAJESTIC MOSHE.

SHARMA PRINCESS (NZ) (D. Caboche) - bumped over the concluding stages.



RACE 2: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP - 7TH OCTOBER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

VALENTINA CHARM (K. Crowther) - when questioned regarding the tactics adopted on the filly rider explained that she had no specific instructions; however, after the filly began average and horses on her inside showed more pace she elected to restrain and take cover.

RACE 3: MOODS & SADS @ CUP LAUNCH -1 SEPT BOOK NOW MAIDEN PLATE - 1800 Metres

ITALIAN REDWOOD (NZ) (R. Hurdle) - when questioned regarding the gelding's performance rider explained that during the race he thought the gelding had choked down; however, it's breathing returned to normal when pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RITZ (E. Finnegan) – momentarily held up entering the straight. Inside the 50m rider had her whip accidentally knocked out of her hand by the rider of BLACK MARMALADE (NZ).

BLACK MARMALADE (NZ) (B. Price) - raced keen in the early stages of the race and raced wide without cover from the 1100m.

CRYSTAL GAZE (C. Jones) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

FINAL REIGN (R. Milnes) - raced keen in the back straight and got its head up when being restrained.

RACE 4: HAPPY RETIREMENT LEON MACDONALD THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

SEVEN SHOTS (T. Pannell) - held up from the 600m to the 250m behind GO ARTIE and DUTHY STREET.

THE BACK PAGE (K. Crowther) - when questioned in regards to the performance of the gelding rider explained that THE BACK PAGE raced very green, shifted in and out, and was field shy, resulting in her electing to race wide after entering the straight.

THE ICE CUTTER (J. Potter) - raced green and hung in when placed under pressure over the final 200m.

DARK'N'STORMY (A. Jordsjo) – near the 200m improved onto the heels of DUTHY STREET and was checked approaching the 150m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. RacingSA Veterinary Officer will follow up with the stable in relation to the filly's action.

RACE 5: FUNCTIONS @ BRIDGES EVENT CENTRE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

BADONKIDONK (A. Livesey) - raced keen in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: FRED VELLA TYRE & CRASH REPAIR CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

TICKETY BOOM (C. Jordan) - bumped at the start.

LEFT TURN CLYDE (J. Holder) - hung out from the 600m.

CROWN MOSHE (D. Caboche) - shifted out under pressure over the final 200m and tightened JIMMY DA DOZER onto ZOULANE. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding.

SEND IT (E. Finnegan) - shifted in over the concluding stages and tightened ZOULANE in onto JIMMY DA DOZER. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding.

ZOULANE (R. Milnes) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Over the concluding stages had to be steadied when tightened by SEND IT, and as a result shifted in and bumped JIMMY DA DOZER. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: FRED VELLA TYRE & CRASH REPAIR CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

THE ARITHMETICIAN (D. Tourneur) - shifted in at the start and bumped TICKETY BOOM.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (S. Logan) - began awkwardly and lost ground.

RACE 7: NORTHPOINT MURRAYLANDS RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

VENUSIAN (R. Hurdle) - held up from the 200m to the 100m behind HONEY GO LIGHTLY. Rider reported that the gelding was uncomfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (3/5). Co-trainers, Mr R. Daniel and Ms T. Stanbury, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

SO YOU CAN (T. Voorham) - began awkwardly.

PIVOTAL FORCE (J. Potter) - shifted in near the 350m to obtain a clear run.

SMART ALICK (T. Pannell) - raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages of the event.

TAVIKAT (NZ) (D. Caboche) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

BRAZEN EAGLE (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the middle stages. Raced in restricted room late.

MISCHIEVOUS TYCOON (D. Tourneur) - began awkwardly and lost ground.

LOOK FOR OPTIONS (R. Milnes) – a post-race veterinary exam revealed the gelding to have a poor post-race recovery, first aid administered. Trainer Mr. J. Macmillan was advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to a future jump out, trial or race.
