INTERIM REPORT

RACE 1: SKYCITY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

ESSENTRIC NATURE (NZ) (D. Bates) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained that the colt raced keenly in the early and middle stages, and raced greenly throughout the event. He added that ESSENTRIC NATURE (NZ) laid out in the early and middle stages of the event and laid in under pressure in the straight, and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery rate.

SURPRISE COMING (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

BORDER VISAGE (J. Noonan) – rider reported that the gelding raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS RUBICK (H. Grace) – knuckled on jumping away. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: PETALUMA HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

ICHIBANSAN (C. Jordan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

OUR BOY BRYAN (C. Gaudray) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

JACK THE LAD (J. Potter) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: PETALUMA HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

COLD CASE (J. Toeroek) – slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight when attempting the same run as MOUNTAIN RANGE resulting in these runners making contact on a number of occasions and was only able to obtain clear ground approaching the 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VIDUKA (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SAVILLE (L. Neindorf) - dipped on jumping away. Held up from near the 400m until approaching the 200m.

CABINHO (NZ) (J. Opperman) - slow to begin.

MOUNTAIN RANGE (T. Pannell) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight when attempting the same run as COLD CASE resulting in these runners making contact on a number of occasions and was only able to obtain clear ground inside the 200m.

RACE 3: HAPPY 60TH LEIGH JENNINGS HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BONNIE GANGSTER (J. Potter) – lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto WHENTHEDEELINGSDUN by LADY SIMONE, which shifted out.

LADY SIMONE (J. Toeroek) - shifted out onto BONNIE GANGSTER on jumping away.

QUEEN OF THE GREEN (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DUPIE DOLL (S. Payne) – jumped away awkwardly. Commenced to weaken from the event of its own accord near the 300m. Rider reported that the mare commenced to lose ground when placed under pressure and was uncomfortable in its action over the final 100m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Stewards will contact Trainer, Mr M. Stephenson, in the coming days to ascertain if anything had arisen that may have affected the mare's performance in today's event.

WHENTHEDEELINGSDUN (S. Logan) – hampered on jumping away when tightened between SHEZ BETTY, which shifted in, and BONNIE GANGSTER, which had been taken out. Rider explained after being inconvenienced on jumping away she had not been able to obtain the lead as she had anticipated. She added that the mare was reluctant to race when between other runners and did not finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

SHEZ BETTY (J. Holder) – shifted in on jumping away onto WHENTHEDEELINGSDUN. Near the 300m was momentarily held up when it became awkwardly placed on the heels of DUPIE DOLL, which had commenced to give ground.

STORM VOYAGER (S. Tomlinson) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: VALE MATE JURJEVIC HANDICAP - 2009 Metres

JAGUARY (NZ) (A. Livesey) - rider explained that she had settled where she had intended and the gelding had had a good run throughout; however, when placed under pressure near the 500m failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MEINER LEGACY (JPN) (D. Bates) – rider explained that the gelding raced keenly in the early stages of the event, which was detrimental to its chances. He added that in his opinion the gelding would gain benefit from its first up run today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



EXALTED RUTH (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting ORBITAL EXPRESS.

RACE 4: VALE MATE JURJEVIC HANDICAP - 2009 Metres (cont'd)

BADISS (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly. Commenced to weaken in the vicinity of the 600m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SANTELMO FUEGO (R. Hurdle) - shifted in on jumping away and contacted CAMPOBASSO (NZ).

CAMPOBASSO (NZ) (T. Pannell) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted SANTELMO FUEGO. Laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

ORBITAL EXPRESS (J. Toeroek) - contacted on jumping away.

VICTORY BANDIT (H. Grace) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. At the entrance to the straight became held up for a short distance when awkwardly placed between the heels of JAGUARY (NZ) and ORBITAL EXPRESS.

MISS VAUGHN (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Logan (EXALTED RUTH), placed second, and co-trainer, Mr R. Daniel, to view the vision in the straight.

RACE 5: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately four minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

DIAMOND MODEL (S. Tomlinson) - lost its off hind plate during the event. Laid out rounding the home turn.

PEEL THE STICKERS (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

ZILZIE LAD (NZ) (J. Noonan) – rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages; however, when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding and then became short in its action and weakened from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr P. Gelagotis, was advised that the gelding would now be required to prove competitive in either an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump-out prior to a future race start.

DELIGHTFUL SHECKY (J. Holder) - rider reported that the horse had presented itself at the entrance to the straight; however, when asked for an effort had only responded for a short distance and then commenced to give ground and became awkward in its action, and for this reason he had not continued to put the gelding under pressure approaching the 100m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZAC'S BACK (J. Toeroek) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SAVVY BEE (NZ) (L. Riordan) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Rider explained that the filly had never travelled during the event and when placed under pressure commenced to weaken from the event, and he had become concerned with it in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr H.Dwyer, was advised that the gelding would now be required to prove competitive in either an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump-out prior to a future race start.

SEPORIA (K. Crowther) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: THE FOTOBASE GROUP HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

DENERO (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ATOMIC GOLD (L. Williams) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting CHICAGO BEAR (IRE).

CHICAGO BEAR (IRE) (J. Holder) - contacted on jumping away.



RACE 6: THE FOTOBASE GROUP HANDICAP - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

RIALTOR (S. Tomlinson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SILENT SURRENTE (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ELECTRIC BELLE (NZ) (J. Noonan) - held up from near the 500m until approaching the 200m.

JUCCONI (J. Toeroek) - slow to begin. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

PEACEMAKER (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

MONTIGN (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOPON HARRY (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOWL (H. Grace) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

ALL ABOUT EVE (L. Riordan) – rider explained that the mare over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and was not suited by the slow tempo. He added that when placed under pressure ALL ABOUT EVE did not respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZARACE (W. Price) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

PRINCESS SALLY (C. Jordan) - slow to begin and shortly after got its head up and lost ground.

RACE 8: LIGHTNING STAKES - 1050 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

SOCIAL CONSCIENCE (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 800m was inconvenienced when its hindquarters were turned out after being contacted by SWEETENED.

ICE SYMPHONY (J. Toeroek) – jumped away awkwardly.

BUBBLE PALACE (M. Julius) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SWEETENED (T. Pannell) - near the 900m shifted in and away from SOCIAL CONSCIENCE onto BOOGNISH. Shortly after shifted back out and contacted SOCIAL CONSCIENCE.

ROCKSTAR MEGGSY (R. Hurdle) – near the 900m was inconvenienced when contacted by BOOGNISH, and had to be momentarily steadied.

BOOGNISH (J. Opperman) – near the 900m was taken in by SWEETENED onto BOCKSTAR MEGGSY.

SIXTEEN REASONS (B. Price) - slow to begin.

EXPLORING (C. Gaudray) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the off foreleg and was therefore deemed unsuitable to start. Acting on this advice Stewards declared EXPLROING a late scratching at 4.11pm. Trainer, Mr J. Cummings, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.



MINTULEE (A. Livesey) - laid out rounding the home turn and then laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately three minutes.

KALASHANI LAD (S. Payne) - near the 200m was awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS EUROZONE for a short distance.

CLAMARC (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

CRAFT STAR (W. Price) - jumped away awkwardly.

OBSESSIVE NATURE (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly.

OLD TIME ROCK (A. Jordsjo) – just prior to the start being affected lunged forward and made contact with the gates resulting in them opening marginally prior to the remaining gates. As a consequence OLD TIME ROCK was awkward and slow into stride. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 100m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an abrasion above the left eye.

SABERMETRIC (L. Neindorf) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 400m was inconvenienced when taken out into the running line of THEBIGSOSSO by RISING LEGEND.

CHAMBERS BAY (J. Noonan) - jumped away awkwardly.

MERCHANT BOSS (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RISING LEGEND (J. Holder) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Near the 400m shifted out onto SABERMETRIC, which was taken out onto THEBIGSOSSO, which had to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground. At the entrance to the straight was awkwardly placed on the heels of SAHARA SONG until near the 300m.

SAHARA SONG (J. Opperman) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

THEBIGSOSSO (T. Pannell) – near the 400m had to be momentarily steadied when SABERMETRIC was taken out into its running line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOX DUNNETT (S. Tomlinson) - slow to begin.

GRANDMA GAIL - late scratching at 7.45am - explanation accepted.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to review vision of the start in relation to OLD TIME ROCK.
