RACE 1: BEELINE CAR AND TRUCK WASH MAIDEN PLATE - 2000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes owing to JACOBS GATE being re-shod on arrival at the barriers.

CAMBERWOOD (S. Payne) - hung out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JACOBS GATE (D. Tourneur) - lost its near fore plate en route to the barriers and was required to be re-shod. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Rider explained that it was his instructions to lead from the wide barrier in the event. He added that the gelding travelled fairly; however, when asked for an effort did not respond to his riding as he had anticipated and was disappointing in the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MILITARY ACTION (S. Tomlinson) - raced keenly in the early and middle stage. Inside the 100m when attempting to improve into a run between NAMADJI and MR GEORGE became awkwardly placed on the heels of NAMADJI as MR GEORGE rolled in and as a result was obliged to be steadied. Thereafter continued to be steadied when awkwardly placed between the heels of NAMADJI and MR GEORGE and was not fully tested to the line.

MR GEORGE (R. Milnes) - inside the 100m rolled in onto MILITARY ACTION, which was obliged to be steadied and became awkwardly placed on the heels of NAMADJI. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

NAMADJI (J. Potter) - kicked by another runner on arrival at the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

RAINBOW DOLPHIN (H. Yuen) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

REBEL MISTRESS (B. Wong) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg (3/5). Stable representative, Mr J. Gluyas was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

HASTA LA PEACE (E. Finnegan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow, S. Tomlinson (MILITARY ACTION), placed fifth, to view the vision in the straight. After doing so S. Tomlinson lodged a protest against MR GEORGE (R. Milnes) being declared the the second placegetter on the grounds of alleged interference over the final 100m. After considering the evidence, on viewing the vision and acting on their own observations, the Stewards *dismissed* the protest.

RACE 2: LOCAL TRAINERS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to HASTA LA WIZARD being required to be re-saddled.

AL NAZARI (J. Maund) - raced greenly in the straight.

BUDGE GOES BANG (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

TALL LETTER (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ASTRID'S COMET (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages and was inclined to lay out.

REVOLUTION BELLE (H. Edgley) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA WIZARD (E. Finnegan) - re-saddled on arrival at the barriers.

LEGGY PEGGY (A. Lindsay) - laid out in the straight.





RACE 3: HANSEN PRINT RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

HARRY HOT PANTS (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Rider reported after beginning slowly the gelding did not stretch out in the early stages. She added that HARRY HOT PANTS hung out throughout the event and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HA SHE (R. Hurdle) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

JUST ATOMIC (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

DRONE STRIKE (D. Caboche) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SNAPTOF (S. Metcalfe) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

O'MIZZNA (R. Milnes) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages whilst in the lead.

RACE 4: HAGE TRACTORS RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

HASTA LA PRINCE (T. Pannell) - held up for clear running from the 400m until near the 300m.

AESCULUS (T. Voorham) - inside the 600m shifted out and bumped BENZ BARON, which was taken wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the mare had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr C. Bieg was advised that as this was the mare's first bi-lateral bleed and AESCULUS would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000m in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

LOVE FROM LUCY (J. Potter) - on jumping away knuckled.

BENZ BARON (R. Hurdle) - inside the 600m bumped with AESCULUS, which shifted out and was taken wider. Rider explained that the gelding was obliged to work hard in the early stages after being wide. He added after receiving a bump near the 600m BENZ BARON commenced to flounder in its action, was not comfortable in the track conditions and was very disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LANGWORTHY (NZ) (S. Fawke) - shortly after the start, from its wide barrier, was restrained and shifted in, in an attempt to gain cover.

VEGAS DESTINY (NZ) (C. Tootell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SMART STYLE (C. Munro) - shortly after the start was effected, got its head up and was reluctant to proceed further despite the efforts of its rider. SMART STYLE was pulled up near the 1900m and took no further part in the event. Trainer, Mr T. Day was advised that the mare would be required to jump away with the field and prove competitive in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race.

RACE 5: SOUTH EAST MARINE AND MOTORCYCLES BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

FRANKEL STAR (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover and keenly in the early stages.

AIGUILLETTE (A. Lindsay) - near the 200m was awkwardly placed and lost its position between MR RODMAN (NZ) and CHIPSON, which shifted in abruptly.

MIDNIGHT MASS (NZ) (D. Tourneur) - held up for clear running for a short distance shortly after the entrance to the straight.

CHIPSON (T. Voorham) - raced wide from the 600m. Near the 200m shifted in abruptly onto AIGUILLETTE, which was taken in.

ENTERPRISE JEWEL (J. Potter) - as the start was effected was reluctant to jump and when it did jump away, slipped behind and as a result was slow to begin (approximately three lengths).

RACE 6: ZOBEL FINANCE NARACOORTE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TAN TAT BEAU (H. Yuen) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's poor performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. On Monday 23 October 2023, Co-Trainer Mr. A. Bain, advised Stewards TAN TAT BEAU showed no visible abnormalities on return to his stable. He added the stables intention is to have TAN TAT BEAU examined by the stable veterinary and also blood samples taken for analysis in the coming days. Mr. Bain undertook to report any abnormalities to the Stewards.

LOVE MAGIC (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow T. Voorham (THANASI) placed second and it's Trainer, Mr J. Opperman to view the vision of the straight.

RACE 7: NARACOORTE RADIATORS RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

PINCHBECK (S. Metcalfe) - rider explained in relation to the gelding's poor performance, that it travelled below fair during the event. She added that from the 400m she elected to take PINCHBECK to the middle of the track, which in her opinion was the best part of the track and less chopped out than closer to the rail. She stated that when asked for an effort shortly after straightening PINCHBECK failed to let down as she had expected and was very disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. On Monday, 23 October 2023, Trainer Mr. D Aldridge, advised Stewards that on return to his stable PINCHBECK showed no visible abnormalities. He added the gelding had ate up over-night and it was the stables intention to have blood samples taken for analysis in the coming days. Mr. Aldridge undertook to report any abnormalities to the Stewards.

AUNTY DOLL (A. Lindsay) - slow to begin.

UTAH JOE (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (S. Fawke) - laid in over the concluding stages.

FINAL CHANCE (N. Yuen) - near the 150m rider dropped her offside rein and was regathered shortly after.

SPENCER GULF (R. Milnes) - slow to begin.

FRENCH BISHOP (C. Tootell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event
