RACE 1: MYALL PLUMBING BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

PORTATION (T. Pannell) - knuckled on jumping away and shifted out unbalancing its rider who was dislodged. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROHLON DRUNK (J. Opperman) - laid in from the 300m.

STAR JAN (T. Voorham) - rider accidentally dropped her whip approaching the finish.

ANRUSHKA (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

NUDGE 'EM ALONG (K. Walters) - hung out from the 500m.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to view the vision of the start.

RACE 2: WILLIAM MACINTOSH MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 Metres

HASTA LA WIZARD (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LUDO (NZ) (T. Pannell) - slow to begin.



RACE 2: WILLIAM MACINTOSH MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 Metres (cont'd)

HENRY'S FAITH (T. Voorham) – became fractious as the start was effected and as a result was slow to begin. Held up from the 500m until the entrance to the straight. Rider reported that after jumping away awkwardly she was unable to take up a forward position as anticipated and was obliged to settle to the rear of the field. She added that HENRY'S FAITH did not obtain clear running until approaching the 200m and finished the race off well.

RACE 3: VALE DON WRAY MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

DON'T MATTA ME (A. Jordsjo) – in the vicinity of the 300m rider was obliged to take hold when disappointed for a run between TIPPA, which shifted out marginally, and IMPENDING STAR, which shifted in. In the vicinity of the 150m was inconvenienced and taken in by IMPENDING STAR as that horse shifted in.

WADAANA (D. Tourneur) – slow to begin.

IMPENDING STAR (J. Doyle) – raced greenly throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 300m shifted in tightening the running of DON'T MATTA ME. In the vicinity of the 150m shifted in and hampered DON'T MATTA ME. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(a) and advised to stop riding and straighten her mounts when they shift ground sooner than she had on this occasion.

RACE 4: COOPERS AUSTRALIAN LARGER BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

DANRENA (S. Metcalfe) – laid in, in the straight.

ANOTHER WHINE (D. Caboche) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: ZOBEL FINANCE NARACOORTE BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

COOL MAGNUM (J. Doyle) – rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure from the vicinity of the 400m did not respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (1/5) and had atrial fibrillation (1st occurrence). Co-trainers, Mr J. Hickmott and Ms C. Riggs, were advised that they were required to comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice in order for the gelding to be reinstated to race in relation to the atrial fibrillation, and that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start regarding the lameness.

DALE'S ROCKET (D. Tourneur) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and found to have a laceration to its off side neck and therefore was deemed unsuitable to start. Acting on this advice Stewards declared DALE'S ROCKET a late scratching at 1.20pm. First aid was administered.

WEST CLIFF (J. Opperman) – jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 100m became momentarily tightened between PEACEMAKER, which shifted in and away from POINT BLAZE, and CORAGGIO, which rolled out marginally.

POINT BLAZE (C. Tootell) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

JOHNNY CIGAR (S. Fawke) – slow to begin.

RACE 6: ELDERS INSURANCE NARACOORTE RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1430 Metres

VERDI (T. Voorham) – accidentally dropped her whip in the vicinity of the 150m.

SNAPTOF (S. Metcalfe) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARTOCRACY (S. Logan) - inside the 400m changed lead legs on a number of occasions. Rider explained that rounding the home turn into the straight ARTOCRACY changed lead legs on a number of occasions and did not improve into the race thereafter. Trainer, Mr P. Lafferty, reported on Monday, 13 November 2023, that the mare showed no abnormalities on return to its stable; however, he would recommend to the owners that ARTOCRACY now be retired.

ORPHELINE (B. Wong) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SPENCER GULF (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

RACE 7: ENVIROTEC SE RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

OFCOURSE I WILL (J. Opperman) - on arrival at the start took control of its rider and cantered to the 800m before the rider was able to regain control and returned to the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Slow to begin.

TARASQUE (A. Jordsjo) - hampered and lost its position on jumping away between REALTIN and ZALINI, which shifted out.

ZALINI (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and hampered TARASQUE. Near the 800m raced in restricted room for a short distance to the inside of IN THE SUN, which rolled in.

BENOVSKY (K. Walters) - raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

IN THE SUN (B. Wong) - in the vicinity of the 800m rolled in tightening the running of ZALINI for a short distance.

VALLEY OF DARKNESS (S. Metcalfe) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

AUTUMN ROSE (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.
