Report on Race Meeting held at Glenburnie Racecourse by the Mount Gambier Racing Club on Wednesday, 31 January 2024

Owing to a delay with the flight carrying riders and officials to the meeting all races were put back one time slot and the last race was rescheduled to 5.40pm.

RACE 1: SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

BAY WATER (B. Wong) - shifted in on jumping away and contacted REDNECK WOMAN. Became awkwardly placed on the heels of REDNECK WOMAN for a short distance in the vicinity of the 100m.

CLOVER PATCH (C. Murtagh) - bucked for a number of strides shortly after the start and lost ground. Trainer, Mr R. Foster, was advised that the gelding would now be required to prove tractable in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump-out prior to accepting for a future race.

AJNA CHAKRA (D. Caboche) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

CAERAU GIRL (C. Puls) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5), and was therefore deemed unsuitable to start. Acting on this advice Stewards declared CAERAU GIRL a late scratching at 2.15pm. Trainer, Ms S. Croxford, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 1: SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres (cont'd)

CHESSPIECE (NZ) (R. Houston) - slow to begin. Approaching the 600m shifted out abruptly losing ground. Continue to lay out for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr P. Preusker, was advised that the mare would now be required to prove tractable and be competitive in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump-out prior to accepting for a future race.

MUNTHAM MISS (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

REDNECK WOMAN (A. Livesey) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted BAY WATER. Rider reported that the mare raced greenly during the event.

RACE 2: NUTRIEN MOUNT GAMBIER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately six minutes.

AL NAZARI (J. Maund) - refused to load, despite several efforts by the barrier staff, and was a late scratching at 2.55pm. Trainer, Mr R. Nicholson, was advised that the gelding would now be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump-out, prior to a future race start.

CAPE BOY (C. Atkinson) - slow into stride. Rider was questioned in relation to his riding of the gelding from the vicinity of the 300m to inside the 200m. After considering his explanation Stewards advised C. Atkinson to ride his mounts out to the finish of the race regardless of their position in running.

EASE OFFA (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

MR FERRARI (A. Livesey) - rider reported that the gelding only travelled fairly and did not let down as she had anticipated.

WAYED'S HONOUR (S. Metcalfe) - inclined to lay out over the concluding 400m, and in the vicinity of the 100m became awkwardly placed on the heels of LEO DAVINCI for a short distance. Rider reported that the gelding never travelled, raced greenly and made excess respiratory noise during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROXY QUEEN (T. Madden) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LEO DAVINCI (E. Walsh) - rolled out slightly approaching the 100m into the running line of WAVED'S HONOUR.

BONANSKI (J. Weatherley) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 3: SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 2050 Metres

ANARYA (H. Grace) - became awkward on the heels of FIFTH HUSBAND (NZ) for a short distance approaching the 200m when both runners shifted ground slightly.

FIFTH HUSBAND (NZ) (C. Puls) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

SESAR (A. Livesey) - inclined to hang out throughout the event, and near the 1700m jumped the crossing.

SANDMAN (D. Caboche) - Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the gelding 0.5kg over its allocated weight of 54.0kg.

RACE 4: SPORTSBET BET WITH MATES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

DALE'S ROCKET (B. Treloar) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto PRIVATE DETECTIVE.

LORD GOLDBERG (J. Weatherley) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRIVATE DETECTIVE (E. Walsh) - inconvenienced on jumping away when DALE'S ROCKET shifted out.

REGAL EFFORT (C. Murtagh) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ALI ORPHAN (NZ) (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

RACE 5: CLEANAWAY BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 900 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

HI SMOKEY (S. Payne) - reared simultaneously with the start being effected resulting in the gelding missing the start a considerable distance.

WONAEAMIRRI (S. Fawke) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LIBERTY POWER (C. Murtagh) - rider was cautioned in relation to using his whip with an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.

ARDANZA (C. Puls) - held up over the concluding 100m when awkwardly placed between the heels of WARMINSTER and ARACHNATTACK.

OAMARU POPPY (J. Maund) - Stewards permitted J. Maund to ride the mare 0.5kg over its allocated weight of 54.0kg.

GIALLO (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to view the vision of the start in relation to HI SMOKEY.

RACE 6: THE MOUNT PLUMBING SERVICE RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

BULL DUST (H. Grace) - near the 1300m shifted out onto HASTA LA MISSILE.

HONOUR THE SKILLS (L. Williams) - in the vicinity of the 300m was inconvenienced for a number of strides when racing in restricted room between ORPHELINE and BUNUMBURT, which commenced to shift about as it was giving ground.

FOREVER WAITING (T. Madden) - rider reported that the gelding laid out under pressure in the straight.

HASTA LA MISSILE (J. Weatherley) - hampered inside the 1300m when tightened between BENOVSKY, which shifted in slightly at the same time as BULL DUST shifted out. As a consequence the gelding raced fiercely for a number of strides until the rider was able to shift to a position wide without cover to allow it to stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS TAPESTRY (A. Livesey) - contacted on jumping away. Rider reported that her saddle shifted back slightly in the vicinity of the 600m placing her at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.

BENOVSKY (S. Metcalfe) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted MISS TAPESTRY. Near the 1300m shifted in slightly onto HONOUR THE SKILLS.

BUNUMBURT (D. Tourneur) - commenced to shifted about when giving ground near the 300m and made contact with HONOUR THE SKILLS on a few occasions.

RACE 7: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

ROHLON DRUNK (B. Treloar) - held up from near the 300m until approaching the 100m when awkwardly placed behind and then inside NUDGE 'EM ALONG.

RAVNIKAR (J. Maund) – near the 300m improved into a tight run between CRANC and DUKE OF ANJOU, which rolled out slightly, resulting in it making contact with CRANC for a short distance. Was then forced to race in restricted room until approaching the 100m.

QUIK RHAPID (J. Opperman) - held up from the vicinity of the 400m until inside the 200m.

NUDGE 'EM ALONG (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LOAD AND GO (H. Grace) - change of tactics - attempt to settle further back with cover - settled back with cover. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALL CLUBS (S. Payne) - inside the 1000m was inconvenienced when its hindquarters were contacted by DUKE OF ANJOU. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHOCKING HABIT (NZ) (E. Walsh) - slow to begin.

DUKE OF ANJOU (S. Fawke) - inside the 1000m shifted in and contacted the hindquarters of ALL CLUBS. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event.

FUGACITY (C. Murtagh) - near the 1000m got its head up when being restrained to allow NUDGE 'EM ALONG to cross. Held up from the vicinity of the 400m until near the 200m.

MANDJAR (B. Wong) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.
