RACE 1: THE PORT LINCOLN HOTEL MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

REAL HUMOUR (R. Milnes) - inside the 200m was momentarily steadied when laying in and became awkwardly placed on the heels of DANIEL MY BROTHER.

SEVEN RAYS (C. Murray) - slow into stride.

DIAMENTE TAGLIATO (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto TOORAK BLAZE.

TOORAK BLAZE (D. Caboche) - on jumping away was taken out onto JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S by DIAMENTE TAGLIATO, which shifted out. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

A FEW GOOD MEN (M. Henderson) - shortly after jumping away the saddle shifted back and placed its rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.



RACE 1: THE PORT LINCOLN HOTEL MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S (S. Metcalfe) - became awkward in its action approaching the winning post. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROLLING DUCK (J. Doyle) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened between A FEW GOOD MEN and SHEEZAHIPLYA and as a result lost its position. Laid out in the straight.

SHEEZAHIPLYA (T. Voorham) - on jumping away was taken out onto ROLLING DUCK by JACKS 'N' DANIEL'S. Rounding the home turn dipped causing its rider to become unbalanced momentarily.

RACE 2: BOOK YOUR CUP PACKAGE MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 Metres

I'M A MILLENNIAL (R. Milnes) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

INTO THE WOOD (NZ) (S. Metcalfe) - contacted on jumping away by THE LOCKSMITH, which shifted in.

NOUVEAU MARCHE (NZ) (S. Fawke) - near the 500m when placed under pressure rider became concerned with the gelding's action and for that reason did not ride his mount out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

SON OF SHAMUS (C. Munro) - raced ungenerously in the early stages. Near the 1300m was steadied away from the heels of SHIPWRECK, which shifted in.

THE LOCKSMITH (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted INTO THE WOOD (NZ).

DOT TO DOT (A. Lai) - jumped away awkwardly.

ISUSPECTJEU (NZ) (D. Caboche) - on jumping away rider restrained his mount to obtain a position to the back of the field with cover. Held up from inside the 600m until near the 250m behind DOT TO DOT.

BIG MERCH (M. Henderson) - slow into stride.

RACE 3: AVIS PORT LINCOLN CLASS ONE PLATE - 1750 Metres

FUNNY LEGS (S. Fawke) - laid in, in the straight.

THE COMMANDANT (D. Caboche) - hampered on jumping away by CALL OUT FEE, which shifted out. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

HIGHLAND ANGEL (R. Milnes) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Held up from the 500m until the 400m behind THIS ONE DAD, which was weakening. Had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the 300m until the 200m and was obliged to shift out across the heels of TUFF OPERATOR to obtain clear running.


TUFF OPERATOR (C. Murray) - laid in, in the straight.

CALL OUT FEE (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto THE COMMANDANT.

RACE 4: BOSTON BAY WINES RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP (1) - 1250 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes owing to the late scratching of MIZZ BEEBEEFF and First Care examining rider, A Lai.





RACE 4: BOSTON BAY WINES RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP (1) - 1250 Metres (cont'd)

MIZZ BEEBEEFF (A. Lai) - shortly after being loaded became fractious in its barrier stall, reared and dislodged its rider. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice MIZZ BEEBEEFF was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 3.08pm. Trainer, Mr D. Courtney was advised the mare must perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race and that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race. A. Lai was examined by First Care Medical personnel and required further assessment before being cleared to ride.

MANDRAGORIAN (D. Caboche) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

JUSTAKIDD (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly.

Following the running of this event, rider A. Lai was examined by First Care Medical personnel and was passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 5: SPORTSBET BET WITH MATES RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP (2) - 1250 Metres

TANE TOA (NZ) (C. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto PROUD MARY. Laid out in the straight.

PRESCIENT (Z. Lloyd) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

CHEF DE MISSION (M. Henderson) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SWIFT TERCEL (S. Metcalfe) - raced in restricted room over the concluding stages between PRESCIENT, which rolled in and GALLANTRY GIRL.

GALLANTRY GIRL (D. Caboche) - laid in, in the early part of the straight.

PROUD MARY (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly and was taken in onto RIVERSIDE ROCK by TANE TOA (NZ), which shifted in.

RIVERSIDE ROCK (S. Fawke) - hampered on jumping by PROUD MARY, which was taken in by TANE TOA (NZ).

RACE 6: SWETTENHAM STUD RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP (3) - 1250 Metres

HOUSE SPOUSE (NZ) (Z. Lloyd) - shortly after jumping away shifted in and contacted VON GEORGE. Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LAGGAN (NZ) (M. Henderson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TALLU (S. Fawke) - shifted in on jumping away and contacted THE MASTER. Hung in, in the straight and proved difficult to ride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (3/5). Co-trainer, Mr W. Horndhart was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

THE MASTER (C. Tootell) - on jumping away was contacted by TALLU.

VON GEORGE (D. Caboche) - shortly after jumping shifted out and contacted HOUSE SPOUSE (NZ).

ZOFFERELLA (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.



RACE 7: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

DANTELA (NZ) (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly. Held up rounding the home turn until near the 200m and shifted out across the heels of GRINZINGER BISHOP (NZ) to obtain clear running. Inside the 100m was momentarily steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of CLASSY BANNER.

CLASSY BANNER (T. Voorham) - held up momentarily rounding the home turn.

GRINZINGER BISHOP (NZ) (S. Fawke) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

DIAMONDS ARE (S. Metcalfe) - slow to begin.

OBLIGATORY (S. Logan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers which revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5) and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice OBLIGATORY was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 3:57pm. Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

MISTA RAZZLEDAZZLE (D. Caboche) - laid in, in the straight.

EDGY ERA (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 8: MCDONALD'S PENINSULA CUP - 1750 Metres

THE ART OF FLYING (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BADISS (Z. Lloyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOUNT MADEIRA (NZ) (C. Tootell) - laid out in the straight.

ENBARR (M. Henderson) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

AHSO (D. Caboche) - near the 400m was steadied and lost its position when tightened onto TIGRE ROYALE (NZ) by DJANGO EXPRESS, which shifted out at the same time TIGRE ROYALE (NZ) rolled out marginally.

DJANGO EXPRESS (T. Voorham) - near the 400m shifted in and tightened AHSO onto TIGRE ROYALE (NZ).

VANCOUVER VELVET (S. Fawke) - laid in, in the straight.

ORIEDOS (A. Lai) - near the 100m raced in restricted room for a short distance to the inside of VANCOUVER VELVET, which laid in and to the outside of MOUNT MADEIRA (NZ), which laid out.

RACE 9: THE HALLETT GROUP/MCDONALD FAMILY KIMBA CUP 17TH MARCH BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

ARTFUL AMBITION (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

MCKEEVER (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto DUCHESS NICCI.

STRAWBERRY SWING (Z. Lloyd) - inconvenienced on jumping away by DUCHESS NICCI.

KOVA (A. Livesey) - lost its near hind plate during the event.

DUCHESS NICCI (S. Fawke) - on jumping was taken out onto STRAWBERRY SWING by MCKEEVER, which shifted out.
