# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Glenburnie Racecourse by the Mount Gambier Racing Club on Wednesday, 24 April 2024

## RACE 1: THE MICK MEDHURST LEGEND MAIDEN PLATE - 903 Metres

BONANSKI (J. Maund) - raced wide and without cover throughout the event.

EMTEED GLASS (S. Payne) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be shin sore in the near foreleg. Trainer, Ms S. Murphy was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RUNAWAY LOVE (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

DREAMZEL (J. Weatherley) - jumped away awkwardly.

FIRST RETURN (K. Walters) - on jumping away slipped behind and as a result jumped away awkwardly and unbalanced its rider. Near the 100m, when improving, shifted out to avoid the heels of AMBELLO. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STOKKE (H. Grace) - jumped away awkwardly.

## RACE 2: THE GEORGE KAY LEGEND MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1205 Metres

ELLIOTTO (M. Julius) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced TWILIGHT GLOW. Rider dropped her whip approaching the finish.

ZEB'S GLASS (K. Walters) - hung out throughout the event. Near the 900m was inconvenienced as TAURI shifted out, and as a result shifted out taking MERCHANT MISS and ELSIE GIRL wider. Near the 600m, when hanging out, shifted out taking MERCHANT MISS and ELSIE GIRL wider. Rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event and may have been shin sore. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (1/5). Trainer, Ms S. Murphy was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

## RACE 2: THE GEORGE KAY LEGEND MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1205 Metres (cont'd)

SEE DE NIGHT (H. Grace) - rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TANCREDI (A. Livesey) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out taking ELSIE GIRL wider. Commenced to weaken from the 500m and near the 400m shifted in abruptly when weakening taking TWILIGHT GLOW in onto TAURI, which was obliged to be steadied when contacted and turned the hindquarters of COLDENKIM. In assessing the incident Stewards were of the opinion that A. Livesey corrected her mount in a timely manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ELSIE GIRL (D. Tourneur) - on jumping away was taken out by TANCREDI onto COLDENKIM. Near the 900m was taken wider by MERCHANT MISS. Approaching the 600m was inconvenienced as MERCHANT MISS was taken wider.

MERCHANT MISS (T. Madden) - near the 900m was taken wider by ZEB'S GLASS, which was hanging out and shifted out onto ELSIE GIRL. Approaching the 600m was taken wider by ZEB'S GLASS, which was hanging out and shifted out onto ELSIE GIRL. Held up for clear running for some distance rounding the turn near the 200m.

TAURI (J. Weatherley) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages and when being restrained commenced to hang out and shifted out when awkwardly placed on the heels of TWILIGHT GLOW, and inconvenienced ZEB'S GLASS. Near the 400m was obliged to be steadied and bumped with COLDENKIM, which turned its hindquarters as TWILIGHT GLOW was taken in. Held up for a short distance inside the 100m when racing between FAIR LEGACY and ELLIOTTO.

COLDENKIM (C. Puls) - on jumping away was taken wider by ELSIE GIRL and shortly after was restrained when shifted in, in an attempt to gain cover. Near the 400m had its hindquarters turned as TAURI was taken in. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 200m until near the 100m where it shifted out to obtain clear running.

TWILIGHT GLOW (J. Doyle) - on jumping away was inconvenienced by ELLIOTTO, which shifted out. Near the 400m was taken in onto TAURI by TANCREDI, which had shifted in abruptly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed over-reach markings on its near hind leg. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr S. Fisher was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

FAIR LEGACY (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

## RACE 3: THE ESSY THOMPSON LEGEND RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1405 Metres

CAMBERWOOD (A. Lindsay) - on Tuesday 23 April 2024, following the declaration of acceptances Trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, made a gear application to remove ear muffs from the gelding's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request and acting under AR206(2) reprimanded Mr Macmillan. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

PRIVATE JET (K. Crowther) – rider was questioned in relation to the tactics adopted in this event. She explained that her instructions were to encourage the gelding on jumping away to ensure it commenced well as it had been missing the start in previous races. She added that after beginning well and the early formation and pace of the field she felt that she would be obliged to race wide and without cover, therefore she elected to allow PRIVATE JET to stride forward to settle outside the leader. Trainer, Mr J. Searle, confirmed the instructions provided.

LOVE FROM LUCY (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped EDNA DOREEN.

FIGHTING FUND (H. Grace) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

L'ESPERANCE ROCK (A. Livesey) - Trainer, Mrs C. Cahill, was questioned in relation to the tactics adopted in this event. She explained that her instructions to A. Livesey were to ride where comfortable; however, she was surprised to see L'ESPERANCE ROCK lead in the event. Rider confirmed the instructions provided and added that after obtaining the lead in the early stages of the event she permitted the mare to stride of its own will and this was of benefit to L'ESPERENCE ROCK.

## RACE 3: THE ESSY THOMPSON LEGEND RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1405 Metres (cont'd)

EDNA DOREEN (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped LOVE FROM LUCY.

ARDANZA (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 4: THE FRANK DEAN LEGEND BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1555 Metres

NAVILLUS EXCEL (L. Williams) - raced wide and without cover from the 800m.

A TOUCH FROSTY (F. Atkinson) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

HAATHER (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight and near the 100m rider dropped his near side rein before regathering it shortly afterwards.

OUTRIVAL (NZ) (M. Julius) - near the 150m altered course to the outside of HAATHER, which laid in.

MR FERRARI (A. Livesey) - near the 100m shifted out to avoid the heels of ANY LUCK (NZ).

WALK IN THE WOODS (NZ) (T. Madden) - raced wide and without cover in the early and middle stages. Inside the 100m was disappointed when attempting a run between A TOUCH FROSTY, which was laying, and MR FERRARI, which shifted out, and as a result was not fully tested to the finish.

MOLEY BELLE (J. Doyle) - laid in from near the 400m for the remainder of the event.

## RACE 5: SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1205 Metres

DETNAW (J. Hill) - knuckled on jumping away. Held up for clear running rounding the turn near the 200m between CAPTAIN JOOLIAN and HAY JOE for some distance.

HAY JOE (J. Weatherley) - approaching the 800m, when racing keenly, shortly after being crossed by CAPTAIN JOOLIAN, shifted out and inconvenienced MELISSA KATE.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (K. Walters) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 800m was inconvenienced as HAY JOE shifted out.

ANRUSHKA (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg (1/5). Trainer, Mr R. Nicholson, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

## RACE 6: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 2058 Metres

DR DEE DEE (K. Crowther) - slow into stride and shortly after shifted in, in an attempt to obtain cover.

EAGLES FOREVER (J. Eaton) - passing the winning post on the first occasion, when hanging in, shifted in onto MOORAK MISS, which was obliged to be momentarily steadied. Rider reported that the gelding raced fiercely in the early stages and hung in despite her efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOORAK MISS (Z. Lloyd) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was obliged to be steadied momentarily as EAGLES FOREVER, which was hanging in, shifted in despite the efforts of its rider.

ENRICO PALLAZZO (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly after shifted in, in an attempt to gain cover.

WARMINSTER (A. Livesey) - weakened from approaching the 600m. Rider reported that the gelding raced keenly in the early stages of the event and proved difficult to restrain, and therefore WARMINSTER settled outside the leader, which she had not anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 7: SPORTSBET RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1205 Metres

DUBAI NIGHTS (S. Payne) - shortly after the start was restrained and shifted in, in an attempt to gain cover. Rider reported that the gelding may not have been suited to the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

METEORITE (J. Weatherley) - held up for clear running from near the 300m until the 150m.

GETONIT (S. Metcalfe) - shortly after the start shifted in, in an attempt to gain cover.
