RACE 1: SPORTSBET JOCKEY WATCH HANDICAP - 900 Metres

NOSIE BY NATURE (R. Milnes) - near the 300m shifted in abruptly onto JAMAICAN GOLD, which was taken in.

PUTANOTHERCOININ (J. Opperman) - hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIRST MAID (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JAMAICAN GOLD (D. Tourneur) - change of tactics - attempt to gain cover if possible - settled on pace with cover. Inconvenienced near the 300m when contacted and taken in by NOSIE BY NATURE, and as a result altered course to the outside of that gelding to obtain clear ground.

DUBAI NIGHTS (A. Jordsjo) - slow into stride.



RACE 1: SPORTSBET JOCKEY WATCH HANDICAP - 900 Metres (cont'd)

MY RICH BOY (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CROWN MOSHE (J. Eaton) - slow to begin.

RACE 2: FRED VELLA TYRE & CRASH REPAIRS HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

SHINY ROCK (C. Rawiller) - rider reported that the gelding raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, and in his opinion did not handle the track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WORSFOLD (A. Livesey) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PEACEMAKER (F. Atkinson) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LAST GIRL LOVE (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Laid out under pressure over the concluding 200m of the event.

FAVOURITE CHILD (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: CONGRATS HAZEL FERTIER AUSTRALIAN HORSEMANSHIP AWARD RACING
REWARDS SA TWO-YEAR-OLD PLATE - 1200 Metres

DANCING STORM (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto HARD LEAF.

COLMAR (S. Payne) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior the 100m and was fined \$1000. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Payne and noted that he used it on thirteen occasions over the final 100m of the event.

DYER (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting HARD LEAF. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight and near the 300m shifted in contacting TRIPOD TERROR. Shortly after shifted out and then inside the 100m shifted back in contacting TRIPOD TERROR. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GREENIDGE HALL (D. Tourneur) - laid out over the concluding 200m.

HARD LEAF (R. Milnes) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened between DANCING STORM, which shifted in, and DYER, which shifted out.

TRIPOD TERROR (D. Caboche) - near the 300m was inconvenienced when contacted by DYER. Laid out over the concluding 150m, and inside the 100m shifted out contacting DYER at the same time as that gelding shifted in.

VILLA MARIA (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Had difficulty maintaining contact with the field. Rider reported that in her opinion the gelding felt shin sore. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg (3/5). Trainer, Mr J. Hyam, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

BEL HOTESSE (S. Logan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

SILENT COMMAND (A. Livesey) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RED PATROL (NZ) (K. Walters) - hung in under pressure in the straight and inside the 200m shifted in onto AMMO AMOR. Continued to hang in for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 4: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 2000 Metres (cont'd)

SMOKIN' PRINCESS (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AMMO AMOR (S. Metcalfe) - inside the 200m was inconvenienced when taken in off its running line by RED PATROL (NZ).

TEST THE LAW (J. Opperman) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

DR DEE DEE (C. Jones) - contacted on jumping away.

EUREKA'S VICTORY (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto DR DEE DEE.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Metcalfe (AMMO AMOR), placed fifth, and that gelding's trainer, Ms K. Evans, to view the official vision in the straight.

RACE 5: SPORTSBET FAST FORM HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BAMYAN BUDDHA (S. Payne) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

THREE RINGS (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed swelling in the off fore pastern. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr C. Reardon, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

TACITO (J. Holder) - rider reported that in his opinion the colt was not suited by the track condition.

TWO KAY KLINK (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly.

EVEN SHARPER (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KING MOYA (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HIT THE SLOPES (M. Collett) - rider was reminded of her obligations under AR132(6)(c) when using her whip when her mounts are out of contention.

RACE 6: SPORTSBET BET WITH MATES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BIT OF A REBEL (J. Potter) - slow to begin. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

CONTROVERSIAL MISS (A. Livesey) - in the vicinity of the 200m shifted out at the same time as RESERVOIR DOG laid in, tightening SO YOU CAN.

KOMACHI (IRE) (J. Opperman) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WALLY WEST (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

SO YOU CAN (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 200m had to be steadied and alter course when tightened between CONTROVERSIAL MISS, which shifted out at the same time as RESERVOIR DOG laid in.

HAJRA (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting RESERVOIR DOG.

RESERVOIR DOG (E. Finnegan) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by HAJRA. Laid in under pressure in the straight and near the 200m shifted in slightly onto SO YOU CAN.





RACE 7: SPRY CIVIL CONSTRUCTION HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

METRO LEGEND (J. Opperman) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BILLIE BRONX (M. Collett) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LOMAX (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

KUSHAN KHANIVALE (J. Eaton) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

OCEAN BLAST (NZ) (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

RACE 8: HAPPY 70TH BIRTHDAY DEANE PANNELL RACING REWARDS SA THREE-YEAR-OLD PLATE - 1200 Metres

HOT OFF (M. Collett) - near the 200m had to be steadied when GREAT MAXIMUS shifted in. Rider reported that the gelding raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and did not respond to her riding when placed under pressure. She added that in her opinion the gelding may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GREAT MAXIMUS (J. Opperman) - in the vicinity of the 200m shifted in onto HOT OFF, which was forced to be steadied. As a consequence INTACTO, which was racing behind HOT OFF was also required to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

KALASEC (J. Eaton) - shifted in out on jumping away onto SURPRISE COMING. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SURPRISE COMING (S. Payne) - contacted on jumping away.

WALK LIKE AN ANGEL (J. Holder) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

BOLTED IN (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

KINETIC JEWEL (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NASHO (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly.

INTACTO (J. Doyle) - in the vicinity of the 200m when racing behind HOT OFF had to be steadied off that gelding's when GREAT MAXIMUS shifted in onto HOT OFF, forcing that horse to be steadied.

LINGANI (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 9: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP 12 OCTOBER HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

ASTON RAPOVA (M. Collett) - near the 600m improved onto the heels of MY RUBY and had to be steadied, and then altered course to the outside of that mare.

CHOSEN BLONDE (F. Atkinson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIXTEEN REASONS (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

WINNING REVOLUTION (D. Tourneur) - lost its near fore plate during the event.



RACE 10: SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

BADONKIDONK (A. Livesey) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLYWAY (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHOSEN MISS (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 200m rider had to take hold off the heels of LONGER ROUTE, which shifted in and away from ANY LUCK (NZ), and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground, and in doing so shifted out contacting the hindquarters of BURNT BY BERNIE near the 150m.

BURNT BY BERNIE (J. Eaton) - near the 150m rider had to take hold when tightened between CHOSEN MISS, which shifted out, and HAYAI MESU, which shifted in under riding.

LONGER ROUTE (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 200m shifted in and away from ANY LUCK (NZ) onto CHOSEN MISS. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight.

ANY LUCK (NZ) (K. Walters) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

HAYAI MESU (M. Collett) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 200m rider was forced to take hold when awkwardly placed on the heels of LONGER ROUTE, which shifted in. Near the 150m shifted in onto BURNT BY BERNIE, which had been taken out slightly, resulting in that rider having to take hold. Rider was reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight.

UNDERSTATEMENT (D. Caboche) - acting on confirmed advice from trainer, Mr S. Gower, that the gelding had some filling in its off hind hock and would be unfit to race Stewards declared UNDERSTATEMENT a late scratching at 9.43am. Mr Gower was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

WARRANTYTE ROAD (S. Metcalfe) - rider reported that the gelding laid out from near the 800m until the entrance to the straight.
