



Abandoned Race Meeting Policy



The objective of this policy is to outline the principles for postponed and/or abandoned race meetings within the Thoroughbred industry in South Australia and define the subsidies payable

When a race meeting is postponed or abandoned at least two hours prior to the advertised start time for the first race, there will be no subsidy payable.

When a race meeting is postponed or abandoned within two hours of the advertised start time of the first race, a subsidy will be allocated to the trainers of horses entered and their engaged jockeys who were denied that opportunity at the time of the postponement or abandonment.

Horses that have raced prior to the postponement or abandonment of the race meeting will not be eligible for the subsidy

When part of a meeting is abandoned at any stage during the conduct of a race meeting, a subsidy shall be paid to the trainer of the horses and their engaged jockeys eligible to compete in remaining races at the time of the abandonment.

The following amounts will be paid as the Subsidy;

TRAINERS

- 1-2 Horses entered in abandoned races - \$250
- 3+ Horses entered in abandoned races- \$500

JOCKEYS

- 1 x Riding Fee if engaged in one or multiple abandoned races
- 1 x Riding Fee to Jockeys who have weighed out for the next race due to be run at the time of abandonment

For extra ordinary circumstances, Racing SA Management reserve the right to alter these amounts.

The Subsidy will be paid as part of the Stakes Batch that the meeting belonged to.
