RACE 1: TRIPLE M MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an overseas event.

MONTANA STATE (T. Johnstone) - shifted in on jumping away onto ALIBIS.

THE CREED (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly.

ALIBIS (R. Milnes) - inconvenienced on jumping away when MONTANA shifted in. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported that she was unable to obtain cover from a wide barrier, and the mare laid out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be showing signs of post-race colic. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr J. Hyam, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

ALPINE JOY (F. Atkinson) - shifted out approaching the 500m resulting in LADY SKYLLA having to be steadied. Rider reported that her mount was reluctant when racing between other runners in the middle stages.

ARTISSI (J. Doyle) - hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.



RACE 1: TRIPLE M MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres (cont'd)

LADY SKYLLA (J. Potter) - approaching the 500m had to be steadied to avoid the heels of ALPINE JOY, which shifted out.

LOVE SO SWEET (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

OOCHIE MAGUCCHEE (J. Toeroek) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

PRESTO DENARO (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 2: SPORTSBET HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

GOLDRUSH GURU (T. Johnstone) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

ATHANATOS (L. Neindorf) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 3: SPRING RACING CARNIVAL AT MORPHETTVILLE - (OCT. 19TH - NOV 9TH)
HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes initially to avoid a clash with an interstate event, and then due to WILD WINNER.

RABTAT (T. Pannell) - slow to begin.

SIR RANDOLPH (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ALLEGEDLY (FR) (M. Chadwick) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding attempted to anticipate the start and as a result was on the back foot when the barriers opened, resulting in him being a touch slow to begin and having to settle further back than he had hoped.

WILD WINNER (T. Johnstone) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr A. Gluyas, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

APACHE STAR (T. Johnstone) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CULLEN SKINK (R. Milnes) - held up from near the 500m and then at the entrance to the straight was disappointed when attempting the same run as STRATUM PRIDE, resulting in the gelding becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KIRKLISTON BLU for a number of strides. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground for the remainder of the event. When questioned in relation to her options during the race, in particular inside the 600m, rider explained that the gelding was travelling well and she had elected to improve into a run she felt was opening to the inside of FRANCE'S BOY, which had commenced to shift out. She added that she had improved into this position; however, at the entrance to the straight, when attempting a run between APACHE STAR and KIRKLISTON BLU, she was beaten to that run by STRATUM PRIDE, which was racing slightly forward and to her inside. She further added from that stage she was unable to obtain clear ground and was unable to fully test her mount to the finish.

LONGER ROUTE (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly.

VEE ROD (NZ) (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

STRATUM PRIDE (A. Livesey) - slow to begin.

LOMAX (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin.





RACE 5: SPORTSBET JOCKEY WATCH HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

KEEP READING (T. Johnstone) - laid out under pressure in the straight, and near the 200m became held up when awkwardly placed on the heels of RIVKIN and inside PLUS FOURS until approaching the 100m. Approaching the 100m was inconvenienced when taken out onto THE GOV by RIVKIN.

STRUCK BY (M. Chadwick) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

GRINZINGER PRINCE (L. Neindorf) - laid in under pressure in the straight and approaching the finish shifted in onto THE GOV, which had to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

RIVKIN (T. Childs) - inclined to lay out under pressure over the concluding 100m.

PLUS FOURS (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight, and near the 100m had to be momentarily steadied when KEEP READING shifted out at the same time as THE GOV shifted in and away from GRINZINGER PRINCE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE GOV (A. Livesey) - approaching the finish had to be steadied when tightened between KEEP READING, which shifted out and away from RIVKIN, and GRINZINGER PRINCE, which shifted in.

RACE 6: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

CHAKADO (L. Neindorf) - shifted out on jumping away onto FLAMBARD.

FREE BEER (S. Fawke) - held up from the 500m until inside the 200m. Near the 50m shifted in resulting in TUPOLEU having to be steadied and losing its position. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground in future.

MIST THE DEADLINE (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin.

FLAMBARD (A. Livesey) - inconvenienced on jumping away. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event, and inside the 1000m was inconvenienced when contacted and taken in by NEVER SURRENDER. Shortly after commenced to race fiercely until near the 700m. Held up from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m when able to ease across the heels of a number of runners. In doing so shifted out onto SAN LUCIDO.

NEVER SURRENDER (J. Holder) - inside the 1000m shifted in and away abruptly from LIMITED RISK onto FLAMBARD. Hung out rounding the home turn.


SAN LUCIDO (J. Opperman) - inside the 200m was hampered, had to be momentarily steadied and lost its position when tightened onto PRODIGAL LAD by FLAMBARD, which shifted out.

TUPOLEU (T. Pannell) - near the 50m had to be steadied and lost its position when FREE BEER shifted in.

NOT A SINGLE BID (T. Childs) - shortly after the start attempted to buck for a short distance and lost ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: PETALUMA WINES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

IN THE DARKNESS (NZ) (J. Eaton) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted OUR SHINING STAR.



OUR SHINING STAR (J. Toeroek) - shifted in on jumping away and contacted IN THE DARKNESS (NZ). Near the 1000m was inconvenienced when contacted by PROBATE and taken in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed swelling to the near fore fetlock. First aid administered. Co-trainers, Mr R. Jolly and Miss C. Jolly, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.



RACE 7: PETALUMA WINES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

HAMSLETTE (C. Jones) - near the 1000m shifted in towards MISS REMSKI, which shifted in and away from it.

KRISTOBEL (D. Tourneur) - near the 1000m shifted in and away from MISS REMSKI onto PROBATE. Near the 900m got its head up for a short distance whilst being restrained.

MISS REMSKI (M. Collett) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Near the 1000m shifted in and away from HAMSLETTE onto KRISTOBEL.

CARARADA (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto COURAGEOUS LASS.

COURAGEOUS LASS (J. Holder) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by CARARADA.

PROBATE (T. Voorham) - near the 1000m rider had to take hold of her mount when tightened onto OUR SHINING STAR by KRISTOBEL.

SHARENDIPITY (T. Johnstone) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

VALENTINA CHARM (B. Price) - slow to begin.

RACE 8: TWILIGHT RACING OCTOBER 11TH AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

BRISTLER (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MISLUDI. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHOOTOOSE (J. Opperman) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m.

GRAND HOST (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.


GILMORE (S. Fawke) - slow to begin and shortly after was hampered when tightened between MISLUDI, which was taken out, and MADAME MASERATI, which was taken in. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the mare felt uncomfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg (2/5). Trainer, Mr C. Reardon, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

HOOKED ON WEALTH (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up from the 500m until inside the 300m.

MADAME MASERATI (Z. Spain) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened onto GILMORE by GRAND HOST.

MISLUDI (L. Neindorf) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened onto GILMORE by BRISTLER. When questioned in relation to his riding at the entrance to the straight rider explained that initially he had looked to improve into a tight run to the outside of BRISTLER and inside of SANTASTICO; however, he formed the view that he would be better served by improving to the outside of SANTASTICO where there was significantly more room. He added that after commencing to shift to the outside the run that he was earlier considering had opened up; however, he was comfortable with the decision he had made, as it enabled him to get into clear ground earlier than if he had maintained his position.

RACE 9: SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI HANDICAP - 1800 Metres



CRIMSON VINE (NZ) (J. Opperman) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SENTIMENTAL FLAME. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$200. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by J. Opperman and noted that he used it on nine occasions over the final 100m of the event.

RACE 9: SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (cont'd)

MAGNETIC EDGE (S. Payne) - slow to begin.

DUAL FUEL (NZ) (Z. Spain) - stood flat-footed and missed the start several lengths. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CROWN MINT (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ON THE SCENT (M. Collett) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance at the entrance to the straight. Rider reported that the mare raced flat. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOTORACE (T. Pannell) - lost its off hind plate during the event.

SENTIMENTAL FLAME (K. Crowther) - slow to begin and shortly after was inconvenienced by CRIMSON VINE (NZ), which shifted out. Held up from approaching the 400m until the entrance to the straight.
