RACE 1 : LANDMARK / SWAN PHARMACIES / WEBBS TYRE SERVICE / JAMESTOWN
COUNTRY RETREAT & CARAVAN PARK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE –
1000 metres

Mr. P. Cole, the Trainer of MINNIE TIZ, which was reluctant to travel to the barriers, was advised should it perform in a similar manner in future, stronger action may be taken against it.

MINNIE TIZ (D. Tootel) was slow to begin.

Shortly after start GOOD CONDUCT (K. Bishop) shifted out brushing BON CHERIE (T. Zanker).

DON'T LOOK DOWN (L. Cribbin) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres SHE'S A COMMODITY (G. Davis) faltered for no apparent reason and lost it position.

RACE 2 : BUNDALEER WINES RATING 0 – 58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Prior to the running of this event Stewards downgraded the track to a DEAD 4 at 1.45 pm.

WHO GIVES A BISCA Y (W. Kerford) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres SNAPPY GENERAL (P. Roff) shifted in and inconvenienced TROBEN (K. Bishop), which had to be steadied. P. Roff was reminded of his obligations and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

Inside the 300 metres WILDSPITZE (J. Toeroek), which was inclined to lay out under pressure, rolled out and brushed CALEJA (D. Tootell). J. Toeroek was advised of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

RACE 2 : BUNDALEER WINES RATING 0 – 58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

Correct Weight for this event was delayed owing to D. Tootell, the rider of the third placegetter CALEJA, lodging an objection against WILDSPITZE (J. Toeroek) being declared the second placegetter on the grounds of alleged interference from the 600 metres to the winning post. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* D. Tootell's objection.

WILDSPITZE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : ELDERS LTD / KELLY TOYOTA / REDDEN BROS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1340 metres

Mr. G. Birchmore, the Trainer of CENTRE RIPPLE, which was reluctant to travel to the barriers, was advised should it perform in a similar manner in future, stronger action may be taken against it.

CENTRE RIPPLE (M. Henderson) was slow to begin.

AMBER ALL OVER (S. Rowley) reared on jumping away.

Approaching the 1000 metres DE LA SOUL (J. Toeroek) became awkwardly placed on the heels of CURRASILLA (P. Roff) when that gelding rolled in. As a result DE LA SOUL got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

DE LA SOUL (J. Toeroek), which continued to race ungenerously from the 800 metres, drifted out to avoid heels and raced wide without cover thereafter.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres DE LA SOUL (J. Toeroek) shifted in under riding making contact with CURRASILLA (P. Roff), taking that gelding in onto HYPNOTIC BLITZ (D. Tootell). J. Toeroek was advised of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

PERFECT BEAU (W. Kerford) was inclined to shift out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

RACE 4 : COMMERCIAL HOTEL JAMESTOWN RATING 0-64 HANDICAP – 1340 metres

BLUE MANNER, which made contact with the mounting yard gate, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and ruled fit to start.

BLUE MANNER (L. Cribbin) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Inside the 400 metres GOLDEN SCHNAPS (S. Rowley) became held up for a short distance between the heels of CARDHU MALT (P. Roff) and DOWDEN (NZ) (M. Henderson), which commenced to give ground.

RACE 5 : CARLTON DRAUGHT JAMESTOWN CUP – 1800 metres

Inside the 800 metres SKY RAIDER (J. Toeroek) dipped for no apparent reason, resulting in J. Toeroek losing the use his off side iron for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) (W. Kerford) became held up for a short distance on the heels YOUNG TEARAWAY (G. Davis), which commenced to give ground.

RACE 6 : RYNNE'S HOME HARDWARE & SPORTS RATING 0-72 HANDICAP –
1000 metres

STRAIGHT FORWARD (D. Tootell) was slow to begin.

Inside the 200 metres SPECULATE (M. Henderson) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of MOXIE MISS (L. Cribbin), which rolled in. L. Cribbin was advised of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.
