RACE 1: DYNAMIC STATIONERY PLUS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

ALASTAR (L. Cribbin) stood flat footed at the start and as a result was very slow to begin.

Shortly after the start, WALTZING MATILDA (D. Tourneur) shifted in bumping with SOVEREIGN DANCER (P. Roff).

CARBON HUNTER (S. Westover) was inclined to race greenly throughout the event.

GOOD CONDUCT (K. Bishop) hung out rounding the home turn inconveniencing MOONTA BAY (W. Kerford) who, as a result, was taken wider on the track. At the 100 metres WALTZING MATILDA (D. Tourneur) momentarily rolled out under pressure, resulting in CARBON HUNTER (S. Westover) having to alter course to gain clear running.

GYRO (T. Baker), which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: HAGE'S BAKEHOUSE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

BEAU RAJA (W. Kerford) and ADTELO (L. Cribbin) were slow to begin.

On jumping away FANTASTIC REIGN (K. Bishop) was inconvenienced when tightened for room between DON'T LOOK AWAY (S. Price) which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, and BEAU RAJA (W. Kerford), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

ACROSS THE BAR (J. Matthews) and DUBAI SUNRISE (L Stojakovic) brushed on jumping.

Near the 300 metres HEAVENSAKE (A. Herrmann) had to momentarily steady when tight between FANTASTIC REIGN (K. Bishop) which held its line, and AKAVARDO (S. Westover) which rolled in.

RACE 2: HAGE'S BAKEHOUSE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres (Cont'd)

Racing at the 250 metres DUBAI SUNRISE (L. Stojakovic), which was attempting a run inside ACROSS THE BAR (J. Matthews), shifted in and away from that gelding onto RAJ HARREB (J. Potter), which was forced to steady. L. Stojakovic was reminded of obligations when shifting ground.

ADTELO (L. Cribbin) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: CAREER EMPLOYMENT GROUP RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

LYRICAL CURRENCY (N. Rose) stood flat footed at the start and as a result was slow to begin.

Racing at the 400 metres TARVON (A. Herrmann) had to steady when the gelding improved onto the heels of BULLYDOZER (S. Price).

HOTDEAL and BULLYDOZER were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : DEMPSEY'S SADDLERY & FEED SUPPLIES RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

On arrival at the barriers ZIPAROO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Acting on that advice, ZIPAROO was withdrawn at 3.03pm by order of the Stewards. Mr D. Carrison, the Trainer of ZIPAROO, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

On jumping away, OUTLOOK EXPRESS (D. Tourneur) was inconvenienced when tightened for room between KURRAJONG WHISPER (N. Rose) who jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, and FINAL DYNASTY (P. Roff), who jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

In the early and middle stages of the event KURRAJONG WHISPER (N. Rose) was inclined to race ungenerously.

Racing at the 200 metres WORTH THE EFFORT (J. Potter) shifted out brushing with OUR DESTINATION (A. Patterson).

CLUB HA HA (W. Kerford) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : WIBBERLEYS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS / SABOIS F&M RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ARTFUL TERRA (N. Rose) jumped away awkwardly contacting with LOW CUT (T. Zanker) and as a result ARTFUL TERRA was slow to begin.

STELLA'S PEARL (W. Kerford) and HUNTED ANGEL (L. Stojakovic) were slow to begin.

Near the 700 metres, LOW CUT (T. Zanker) had to steady off the heels of MISS BLEVITE (S. Westover) resulting in that mare shifting out, placing CHECK ME (P. Roff) awkward on the heels of STRANGMEAD (S. Cahill). S. Westover was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

RACE 5: WIBBERLEYS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS / SABOIS F&M RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

In the straight, MISS BLEVITE (S. Westover) was inclined to lay in under pressure.

STRANGMEAD (S. Cahill) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: IMPACT SIGNS & PRINT RACING 60+ HANDICAP - 1250 metres

From the 400 metres to the entrance of the straight, YARTERBERY (A. Patterson), was held up for clear running on the heels on POLDA ROCK (L. Hopwood).

Approaching the winning post PASS THE ACE (P. Roff) had to momentarily steady when racing tight between HIGHTOM (S. Price) and YARTERBERY (A. Patterson).

RACE 7: HOTONDO / HEATH HOMES C, G&E RATING 0-59 HANDICAP C,G&E 0-59 2) - 1200 metres

DARK ASSASSIN (D. Tourneur) and BLACK WHISKEY (J. Potter) were slow to begin.

LAGO AZZURRO (T. Baker) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto DREAM THIEF (S. Westover) which was inconvenienced when tightened for room.

AZZURRO (T. Baker) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

Inside the 100 metres TROBEN (A. Patterson) was momentarily inconvenienced by AZZURRO (T. Baker) when it rolled in.
