Report on Race Meeting held at Balaklava Racecourse by the Balaklava Racing Club on Wednesday, 26 October 2011

RACE 1 : VIEWED RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2200 metres

HURRICANE THUNDER (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto HIDDEN TEARS (J. Potter) which had to be steadied and lost its position.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres HURRICAN THUNDER (S. Price) rolled out slightly onto TYPHOONGEORGE (J. Maund) which shifted out and away and had to be steadied off the heels of GOLDSINGER (D. Tootell).

MAKEATON (A. Patterson) was inclined to lay in in the straight.

GOLDSTINGER (D. Tootell) laid out under pressure over the concluding 200 metres.

TYPHOONGEORGE, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MAKEATON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : EFFICIENT / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres

DUBAI ME ROSES (M. Speers) and KLONDIKE LIL (S. Cahill) jumped away awkwardly.

PRAY TO WIN (J. Matthews) shifted out on jumping away contacting OUR COVER GIRL (S. Price) which was inconvenienced when tightened onto MCCLAREN OVERTURE (N. Rose).

MISS KERCHING (L. Hopwood) shifted in on jumping away and inconvenienced MEADOWS STORM (C. Lindop).

MEADOWS STORM (C. Lindop) made the turn in the vicinity of the 800 metres awkwardly and shifted out inconveniencing MISS KERCHING (L. Hopwood) which was taken wider on the track.

RACE 3 : FLIGHT CENTRE TWILIGHT DECEMBER 16 / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 1 minute owing to RICH GYPSY having to be resaddled on arrival at the barriers and due to WINDSOR GARDENS (J. Frew) proving difficult to load. Ms. R. Hodson, Trainer of WINDSOR GARDENS, was advised that a warning had been placed on this gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

On jumping away YOU'VE BEEN WARNED (N. Rose) and SOUNDS LIKE LEON (D. Evans) came together and brushed.

GENARKA STAR (L Hopwood) shifted in on jumping away and brushed WINDSOR GARDENS (J. Frew).

GOOD CONDUCT (K. Bishop) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

YOU'VE BEEN WARNED (N. Rose) laid in throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 500 metres and 300 metres, shifted in and made contact with the running rail unbalancing the colt.

Inside the 200 metres SOUNDS LIKE LEON (D. Evans) shifted out and brushed WINDSOR GARDENS (J. Frew).

YOU'VE BEEN WARNED was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr S. Kavanagh, representing Trainer Mr M. Kavanagh, was advised that the colt would be required to perform satisfactorily in an official trial prior to accepting for a future event.

RACE 4 : MELBOURNE CUP DAY AT MORPHETTVILLE / SABOIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE-1200 metres

On arrival at the barriers, MUGHAREEGA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported that that gelding was lame in the off fore leg and unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew MUGAHEERGA at 2.22pm.

JESTALOTTERY (J. Matthews) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out brushing ROUGH DEAL (L. Hopwood).

HENNY (A. Herrmann) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

WARATONE (D. Evans) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 700 metres improved onto the heels of FIREWEED (A. Patterson) and had to be steadied.

At the entrance to the straight LITTLE MISS BOURKE (S. Price) shifted out to improve and in doing so contacted ROUGH DEAL (L. Hopwood) which was inconvenienced when its hind quarters were turned out.

Inside the 400 metres LITTLE MISS BOURKE (S. Price) became awkwardly placed on the heels of MORSE CODE (C. Lindop) for a short distance when that gelding shifted out and away from HENNY (A. Herrmann).

Approaching the 200 metres WARATONE (D. Evans) was disappointed when attempting a tight run between the heels of HENNY (A. Herrmann) and MORSE CODE (C. Lindop) which both shifted ground slightly, resulting in WARATONE having to shift out to obtain clear ground.

GONE WITHOUT (T. Pannell) lost its near hind plate during the running of the event.

RACE 5 : DELTA BLUES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1400 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately 2 minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate race.

AROWANA (J. Matthews) jumped away awkwardly.

On jumping away SON OF NALA (L. Hopwood) shifted out tightening EXALTED FILLY (A. Patterson) onto SMARTY WELLS (J. Potter), which had been taken in slightly by SUMMER WITH ROSIE (C. Lions), which had jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, resulting in EXALTED FILLY and SMARTY WELLS being inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres SON OF NALA (L. Hopwood) had to be steadied momentarily off the heels of BUNDLE OF DREAMS (S. Price) which shifted in. S. Price was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres SON OF NALA (L. Hopwood) and BUDZEAL (D. Evans) dipped for no apparent reason.

From the vicinity of the 800 metres to the finish BUDZEAL (D. Evans) was inclined to hang out.

BUDZEAL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

NADAHKA suffered a bilateral bleeding attack during the running of this event. Trainer, Ms K. Huxtable, was advised that the gelding was now suspended from racing for a period of 3 months in accordance with ARR.53A.

RACE 6 : AMERICAN CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres FORCRYINGOUTLOUD (C. Lindop), which was inclined to race keenly, had to be eased off the heels of FRIENDSINTHEFIELD (S. Price) when the mare slowed the pace slightly.

In the middle stages of the event CALEJA (M. Hoppo) raced keenly.

RACE 7 : ARMAGH FINANCIAL SERVICES CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

On jumping away JET BEAU (J. Matthews) and ULTRAMARINE BLUE (L. Stojakovic) came together and brushed.

BEEARCH (T. Pannell) raced greenly throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 400 metres improved onto the heels of JET BEAU (J. Matthews) and in being eased, overreacted and shifted out abruptly contacting REAL FANTASY (A. Patterson). BEEARCH laid in for the remainder of the event.

RACE 8 : SHOCKING RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

QUICK GETAWAY (D. Evans) shifted out on jumping away and contacted SLACKSMITH (S. Price).

CONQUEST OF ARMS (T. Zanker) and SHAMS TIME (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 8 : SHOCKING RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

L. Stojakovic, rider of BEAUTIFUL SOUL, explained to Stewards that that mare was unable to keep contact in the early stages with the leading group despite her efforts as BEAUTIFUL SOUL is usually unable to take a forward position over this sort of distance. She added that from the vicinity of the 600 metres she had placed the mare under pressure and it had responded well to her riding.
