THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 11 December 2011

TRACK: Good 3 WEATHER: Fine

Rail: Normal

RACE 1: TATIARA TRUCK & TRAILERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

Ms. E. Hubbard, the Trainer of DAMAGE, which was reluctant to travel to the start and then raced ungenerously in the early stages, was advised that a repetition of the gelding's behaviour may lead to action being taken against it.

FLYTASTIC (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly.

TEARAWAY BELLE (K. Walters) was slow to jump.

From inside the 900 metres DAMAGE CONTROL (J. Frew) got its head up and commenced to race ungenerously and making the turn near the 100 metres hung out onto TEARWAY BELLE (K. Walters) which was inconvenienced when taken wide.

RACE 2: COCA-COLA / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1900 metres

MARY JO (NZ) (K. Walters) stood in the gates and missed the start.

CROCODILE TEARS (A. Herrmann) was slow to jump.

Approaching the winning post on the first occasion DUBLEO FIVE (P. Marks) commenced to race ungenerously and continued until the vicinity of the 1000 metres.

COUNT CAPRI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be uneven in front. Mr. K. Elford, the Trainer of COUNT CAPRI, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

SEULAMONT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: THIRSTY CAMEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres

SANDHILL MISS (P. Gatt) jumped awkwardly and shifted out onto RICH GYPSY (N. Rose) which was inconvenienced.

On jumping away PUFF (T. Zanker) and QUECHUA (J. Frew) brushed.

Approaching the finish RICH GYPSY (N. Rose) rolled out inconveniencing QUECHUA (J. Frew) as that gelding rolled in.

RACE 3: THIRSTY CAMEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres (Cont'd)

From the 100 metres FINAL FLURRY (S. Cahill) was allowed to run to the finish.

FINAL FLURRY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: MACKENZIE INTERMODAL - 1200 metres

In the straight VERCO ROAD (C. Lions) was inclined to lay in under pressure.

On jumping away BOLD LINE (A. Patterson) rolled out onto GOLDEN SNIP (J. Potter) which was obliged to ease.

RACE 5: A.W.E. RICHARDS RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1900 metres

RIKBAT (J. Toeroek) was slow to jump and shortly after was inconvenienced by BEWARE OF THESTORM (A. Herrmann) which shifted out.

From the vicinity of the 800 metres BREDLIGN (NZ) (P. Marks) lost ground when taken back through the field by NIKOLAEV (S. Harrison) as that gelding commenced to give ground.

Correct weight for the event was delayed to permit J. Toeroek, the rider of the second place getter RIKBAT, to view the official image for first.

MUSTY SPRINGS and NIKOLAEV were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: WOODSHED INN SABOIS & BORDERTOWN CUP - 1900 metres

GENERAL MACKJOSH (K. Walters) was slow to jump.

MERLOT NOW was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: MGA INSURANCE RATING 0-65 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

MOUNT MEE UP (S. Price), LATORULE (K. Walters) and SANDHILL CHIEF (A. Patterson) were slow to jump.

Shortly after LATORULE (K. Walters) shifted out abruptly from TONTO'S PRIDE (J. Potter) as that gelding rolled out.

Near the 800 metres DALEO (H. McKechnie), which hung out making that turn, shifted out taking PERSIAN PALACE (J. Maund) wider on the track.

RACE 8: XXXX GOLD RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

LIQUID NAILS (E. Brooks) and JESTA TIGER (J. Potter) were slow to jump.

Inside the 800 metres SILKY WARRIOR (P. Marks) commenced to lay out and in the vicinity of the 600 metres shifted out onto LIQUID NAILS (E. Brooks) which was inconvenienced when taken wider.

RACE 8: XXXX GOLD RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

P. Marks, the rider of SILKY WARRIOR, reported that gelding was inclined to hang out throughout the event. Stewards ordered that SILKY WARRIOR be examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon. Mr. R. Daniel, the Trainer of SILKY WARRIOR will be interviewed at a later date regarding the circumstances in which SILKY WARRIOR had left the course prior to the prescribed time.
