RACE 1 : DOLLING PRODUCE PTY LTD / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 metres

Ms. J. Potts, the Trainer of DASHA CHILLI which was difficult to load, was advised a repetition of the mare's behaviour may lead to action being taken against it.

AKERBOY (A. Patterson), MAGIC TRAGIC (J. Matthews) and GOOGRAM (K. Post) were slow to jump.

GOOGRAM (K. Post) raced greenly throughout the event.

Near the 600 metres SILVER THRUPENCE (J. Maund) was obliged to steady when tightened for room by JOINT VENTURE (K. Walters), which was inclined to lay in when racing inside AL MUNIA (P. Marks). In consequence AKERBOY (A. Patterson) was forced to steady away from SILVER THRUPENCE as that mare lost ground.

Near the 500 metres MAGIC TRAGIC (J. Matthews) was obliged to steady off the heels of GOOGRAM (K. Post), which shifted in.

JOINT VENTURE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare had sustained a laceration to its near hind leg which required first aid.

RACE 2 : ENVIRO TEC RATING 64 & OVER HANDICAP - 1430 metres

At the entrance to the straight GLENISLA CROSSING (A. Patterson) rolled out and brushed DJATALA (H. McKechnie).

Inside the 200 metres when attempting to improve, GLENISLA CROSSING (A. Patterson) rolled out and brushed DJATALA (H. McKechnie).

RACE 3 : KINCRAIG HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 metres

Shortly after the start STRATRIC (J. Maund) commenced to buck and continued to do so for some distance. Mr. G. Baker, the Trainer of STRATRIC, was advised that the filly would be required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 4 : NARACOORTE RECYCABLES RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

RACE 5 : HANSEN DESIGN & PRINT COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SNIPLOCH (K. Post) was slow to jump.

JESTA TIGER (S. Cahill) was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 6 : NARACOORTE HERALD / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES RATING 0-65 HANDICAP – 1200 metres

RACE 7 : MUNRO & GRIGG AUTO REPAIRS RATING 0-65 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

Shortly after the start ULTRA SAVINGS (A. Patterson) shifted out onto INTANGIBLE FORCE (H. McKechnie) taking that gelding out onto TAKE OUT (A. Herrmann) which was inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres, when attempting to improve, BREDLIGN (NZ) (P. Marks) shifted out onto INTANGIBLE FORCE (H. McKechnie), which was inconvenienced and taken wider on the track.

BREDLIGN (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : G J GARDNER HOMES RATING 0-65 HANDICAP - 1430 metres

AUGUR (J. Maund) was slow to jump.
