

THOROUGHBRED RACING AUTHORITY S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse
by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Friday, 20 January 2012

TRACK: Good 3

WEATHER: Fine

RAIL: Out 1 metre from 1000m to 800m, 2 metres 800m to 300m, 1 metre 300m to Winning Post, True remainder.

RACE 1 : MAGIC MILLIONS / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD HANDICAP - 1000 metres

ROAD TO DANTREE (M. Neve) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

Racing to the 350 metres HEAVENS SHOUT (S. Cahill) was inclined to lay in and brushed the running rail.

From the home turn to the winning post MR KARGER (J. Potter) laid in under pressure.

RACE 2 : LEADERS DISTRIBUTORS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

HUSHABYE (B. Hoppo) and DUBAI TONIC (K. Bishop) brushed on jumping.

CARBON HUNTER (M. Hoppo) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

Racing from the 1000 metres to the 700 metres CARBON HUNTER (M. Hoppo) had to restrain off the heels of DESTONY HAWK (T. Zanker) when that gelding began to over race.

Approaching the winning post LOVERS ROCKS (M. Pegus) had to stop riding and restrain off the heels of DESTONY HAWK (T. Zanker) when LOVERS ROCKS shifted out under pressure.

DESTONY HAWK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to have a minor laceration to the near hind pastern and it was reported it had also lost its off hind shoe.

HUSHABYE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : KEMP REAL ESTATE PTY LTD RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

TRENDEAZ (L. Stojakovic) stood flat footed and as a result was very slow to begin.

YOUKNOWTHERULES which performed below market expectations was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : SA SPECIAL OPERATIONS GROUP PTY LTD RATING 0-64 HANDICAP -
1350 metres

On arrival at the start BIG SAI WAN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon after it struck the gate when leaving the mounting yard and was ruled fit to start.

DOUBLE COVER (K. Bishop) and STELLA'S PEARL (A. Herrmann) brushed on jumping.

Racing from the 400 metres to the 300 metres OFF THE RICHTER (T. Zanker) was held up for clear running when on the heels of BIG SAI WAN (M. Neve) and when racing tight to the outside of ORCHESTRAL (L. Stojakovic).

RACE 5 : K & K COOLING SOLUTIONS RATING 60+ HANDICAP - 1750 metres

PUERTO BANUS (J. Frew) was slow to begin. In the early and middle stages DIRE WARNING (M. Hoppo) raced ungenerously.

MANAWAY which performed below market expectations was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be tying up in both shoulders.

RACE 6 : FIRE EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE GROUP RATING 0-61 HANDICAP -
1200 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately 5 minutes owing to FUSAICHI KNIGHT losing its near side front shoe and requiring attention from the Farrier. FUSAICHI KNIGHT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to start.

On jumping away LADY REYANE (S. Cahill) was inconvenienced when tightened for room between GIGGLING DOLLAR (J. Potter) which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and FUSAICHI KNIGHT (M. Pegasus) which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

RACE 7 : BALDWIN'S PLUMBING & GAS RATING 60+ HANDICAP - 1200 metres

As Stewards were able to establish the identity of BENNETT'S LANE from records held by them, the gelding was permitted to start. Mr. S. Drewitt, the Trainer of BENNETT'S LANE, was questioned regarding the Thoroughbred Identification Card not being available for that gelding. Having considered the explanation provided, Mr. S. Drewitt was fined \$50 under ARR.59A.

HASTEIN (NZ) which was kicked by another runner prior to entering the mounting yard was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off fore leg. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew HASTEIN (NZ) at 6.43 pm.

On arrival at the barriers BENNETT'S LANE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Acting on that advice BENNETT'S LANE was withdrawn at 6.50 pm by order of Stewards.

LIKE BOLT, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near fore leg. Mr. D. Carrison, the Trainer of LIKE BOLT, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 8 : YALUMBA RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

BRACKEN BLUE (B. Hoppo) was slow to begin.

ARTFUL TERRA (J. Potter) and MILLIGANS (M. Pegus) brushed on jumping.

MILLIGANS (M. Pegus) over raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres ARTFUL TERRA (J. Potter) was taken in and inconvenienced when VOLATION (S. Cahill) shifted in, resulting in MILLIGANS (M. Pegus) which was racing to the inside of ARTFUL TERRA, being taken in onto MIGHTY MOMENT (M. Neve), resulting in MIGHTY MOMENT having to be checked losing its position. S. Cahill was charged with Careless Riding under ARR.137 (a) in that he allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear. He was found guilty and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 22 January and to conclude at midnight on Sunday, 29 January 2012; a period of four (4) meetings.

Approaching the 100 metres ARTFUL TERRA (J. Potter) rolled in under pressure taking VOLATION (S. Cahill) in onto MIGHTY MOMENT (M. Neve) who as a result had to steady momentarily.

MILLIGANS which performed below expectations was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the near fore leg. Mr. D. Carrison, the Trainer of MILLIGANS was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future race or trial.
