RACE 1: PURELL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

CAPTAIN PERCY (M. Pegus) was slow to begin and raced greenly throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres BALARAT (J. Potter), which was racing keenly, had to be steadied momentarily off the heels of PICTORELLA (M. Neilson) which shifted in and away from KOODA DAWN (K. Bishop) which shifted in slightly.

BALARAT (J. Potter) was inclined to lay in, in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres, shifted in and brushed GONE WITH GRACE (S. Westover).

RACE 2: WATTERS ELECTRICAL (AUST) PTY LTD RATING 0-77 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

Mr. S. Drewitt, the Trainer of BENNETT'S LANE was questioned regarding the Thoroughbred Identification Card not being available for the gelding. As Stewards were able to establish the identity of BENNETT'S LANE from records held by them, the gelding was permitted to start. Having considered the explanation provided, Mr. S. Drewitt was fined \$50 under ARR.59A and was advised that as this was the second occasion in which the Thoroughbred Identification Card had not been produced, BENNETT'S LANE was now suspended from racing until he could produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card.

BENNETT'S LANE (M. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

MASTER PICKLES (J. Potter) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres MASTER PICKLES (J. Potter) shifted in of its own accord, brushed the running rail and became unbalanced for a short distance.

RACE 2: WATTERS ELECTRICAL (AUST) PTY LTD RATING 0-77 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

Inside the 400 metres BLUZAR (K. Bishop) had to steady momentarily off the heels of ACHENAR (S. Westover) which shifted in. S. Westover was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

RACE 3: COATES HIRE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

BEAU RAJA (W. Kerford) was slow to begin.

CARBON HUNTER (M. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting DUBAI TONIC (A. Herrmann) which was taken out onto TELLURIUM (K. Bishop), which was hampered when tightened onto REAL GLAMOUR (T. Zanker), which had jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

LOVERS ROCKS (M. Pegus) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting VINTAGE BELLE (M. Henderson).

Approaching the 1000 metres CARBON HUNTER (M. Hoppo) shifted in and away from VINTAGE BELLE (M. Henderson) and contacted WILD ALLY (T. Baker), which had shifted out slightly, resulting in the hindquarters of CARBON HUNTER being turned out and the gelding becoming unbalanced momentarily.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres LOVERS ROCKS (M. Pegus) dipped for no apparent reason.

M. Pegus, the rider of LOVERS ROCKS, which performed below expectations, explained that the gelding had travelled well in the lead in the early and middle stages of the event however when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres had failed to respond to his riding and was inclined to run about in the straight. LOVERS ROCKS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : D K QUARRIES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD RATING 0-61 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MISS HARREB (J. Potter) was slow to begin and shortly after was hampered when tightened onto DESTONY HAWK (T. Zanker) by MUMAJET (S. Westover) which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in abruptly.

DULCIE DEE (T. Baker) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and brushed EXCEL WITH PRIDE (M. Neilson) in the vicinity of the 200 metres and again near the 100 metres.

T. Zanker, the rider of DESTONY HAWK, which performed below expectations, reported to Stewards that the filly had not shown its customary speed in the early stages of the event however had travelled well until placed under pressure inside the 600 metres at which stage she had become concerned with its action. DESTONY HAWK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : EP OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSOCIATION RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

BRACKEN BLUE (B. Hoppo) stood flat footed and was slow to begin.

TARVON (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

RACE 5 : EP OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSOCIATION RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1750 metres (Cont'd)

MILLIGANS (T. Baker) and SAREM (L. Hopwood) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Passing the winning post on the first occasion, MILLIGANS (T. Baker) shifted out onto ADRIANO (M. Henderson) taking the gelding wider on the track.

RACE 6: AIT FUEL TAX SPECIALISTS RATING 60+ HANDICAP - 1350 metres

A. Patterson, the rider of RONORIK, was dislodged en route to the barrier and RONORIK galloped a short distance prior to being recaptured. RONORIK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race.

GALLIPOLI BEACH (S. Westover) knuckled on jumping away and shifted in onto WORLD RULER (NZ) (K. Bishop) which lost its position, when tightened onto RONORIK (A. Patterson).

OUT FOR LUNCH (L. Stojakovic) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out and bumped DIRE WARNING (M. Hoppo).

RONORIK (A. Patterson) over raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres DIRE WARNING (M. Hoppo) improved onto the heels of SUPER HIT (W. Kerford) which had commenced to give ground resulting in DIRE WARNING being unable to obtain clear ground until the entrance to the straight.

RACE 7: MIKE RALEIGH MOTORS PTY LTD RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1250 metres

YOUKNOWTHERULES (L. Stojakovic) slipped behind on jumping away and missed the start several lengths.

GIGGLING DOLLAR (J. Potter) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres FUSAICHI KNIGHT (M. Pegus) was disappointed for a run between the heels of KOODA SURPRISE (K. Bishop), which shifted out slightly, and ALANNAN LAD (A. Patterson), which shifted in under pressure, resulting in FUSAICHI KNIGHT having to alter course to the inside of KOODA SURPRISE to obtain clear ground.
