STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE – FRIDAY, 10 FEBRUARY 2012

Stewards have inquired into the substance 11-nor- Δ^9 -tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid being detected in a urine sample provided by licensed track work rider, Katie McManmon after riding track work at Morphettville Racecourse on Thursday, 10 November 2011.

Evidence was taken from Katie McManmon and Stewards questioned Mr. D. O'Connor, a Witness called by Katie McManmon. Stewards also considered evidence from Racing Analytical Services Limited and a report by a medical expert.

After considering the evidence, Katie McManmon was found guilty of an offence under ARR.81A(1) in that the sample provided contained 11-nor- Δ^9 -tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid, a substance banned under ARR.81B.

Katie McManmon was suspended from riding track work for a period of three months. After taking into account specific circumstances relative to the matter, Katie McManmon was advised two months of the suspension would be stayed for a period of 12 months on the proviso she is not found guilty of a similar offence during that period. As Katie McManmon had not ridden track work for a period of one month between the day she was advised of the positive result and today's inquiry, she was informed that she was free to ride track work after midnight Friday 10 February 2012.

Katie McManmon was informed of her right of appeal.
