STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Lock Racecourse
by Lock Racing Club on Sunday, 19 February 2012

RACE 1 : REYNOLDS DIESEL / WILSON SHEARING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE -
1000 metres

PALLAXY (L. Stojakovic) reared as the gates were released.

SARAPET (T. Neve) stood flat-footed as the gates were released and as a result was very slow to begin, losing several lengths. SARAPET was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr M. Dunn, the Trainer of SARAPET, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare and should it perform in a similar manner in future, action may be taken against it.

In the early stages of the straight, JENNA BELLA (J. Frew) was inclined to lay in under pressure.

RACE 2 : MURRAY PEST CONTROL / JM & JE DUNN RATING 0-59 HANDICAP -
1200 metres

As there were no other senior riders available, Stewards permitted M. Pegus to ride BITOFADREAMER two and a half kilograms over the allotted weight.

BITOFADREAMER (M. Pegus) and GIGGLING DOLLAR (J. Potter) were slow to begin.

In the early and middle stages FIRER ME (T. Neve) raced wide without cover.

BITOFADREAMER (M. Pegus) was eased out of the event from the 200 metres. M. Pegus explained that as the mare had lost contact with the field in the straight, he did not persist with his riding and elected to ease BITOFADREAMER out of the event. BITOFADREAMER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : 5CC SATURDAY SPORTS SHOW RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

JET FUSION (B. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and brushed FIGHTING FURY (M. Pegus), which was hampered.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres DEMOB (J. Potter) was held up on the heels of HOOLIGAN (P. Roff) for a short distance.

From in the vicinity of the 300 metres MASTER PICKLES (D. Evans) was unable to obtain clear ground when racing behind DEMOB (J. Potter) and inside HOOLIGAN (P. Roff) and was only able to obtain clear running over the concluding stages when HOOLIGAN rolled out slightly.

RACE 3 : 5CC SATURDAY SPORTS SHOW RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Potter, the rider of the second placegetter DEMOB, and Mrs S. Ratsch, the Trainer of the gelding, to view to the official photo for first.

ARTECHS, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slower than expected recovery.

M. Pegus, the rider of the third placegetter FIGHTING FURY, pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR.144 for failing to weigh in after the event and was fined \$50.

RACE 4 : PRINGLES AG-PLUS / WUDINNA HARDWARE RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

ADRIANO (M. Henderson) was slow to begin.

Near the 300 metres HEART OF STONE (L. Stojakovic) was obliged to steady momentarily when MEI WENTI (P. Roff) rolled in slightly.

From the 300 metres RIPASON laid in under pressure. RIPASON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

B. Hoppo, the rider of ORCHESTRAL, reported the mare had began well but in his opinion had resented the dirt kickback.

RACE 5 : IRON ROAD LIMITED LOCK CUP - 1900 metres

YARTERBERY, which lost its off fore plate in the parade ring, required Farrier attention. On arrival at the barriers YARTERBERY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to start.

HASTEIN (NZ) (L. Miller) jumped away awkwardly, threw its head up and struck its rider in the face. As a result, L. Miller was unable to fully assist the gelding and eased HASTEIN (NZ) out of the event. HASTEIN (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr D. Carrison, the trainer of HASTEIN (NZ), was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners. L. Miller was treated by the on-course Ambulance personnel.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres SAREM (B. Hoppo) and GENEROUS HUKA (NZ) (J. Potter) came together and made contact, resulting in the hindquarters of SAREM (B. Hoppo) being turned out.

Mrs N. Bruggemann, the trainer of YOUNG TEARAWAY, reported the gelding was sucking wind behind. YOUNG TEARAWAY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be slightly distressed.

RACE 6 : LOCK HOTEL – MOTEL / WEST END RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

On jumping away KONOWALCHUCK (K. Bishop) and LOW CUT (L. Stojakovic) came together and brushed.

LOW CUT (L. Stojakovic) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 6 : LOCK HOTEL – MOTEL / WEST END RATING 0-59 HANDICAP
- 1800 metres (Cont'd)

After passing the winning post on the first occasion until inside the 1400 metres LOW CUT (L. Stojakovic) hung out.
