Report on Race Meeting held at Kingscote Racecourse by Kangaroo Island Racing Club on Friday, 17 February 2012

## RACE 1 : COCA-COLA / SABOIS FILLIES \& MARES RATING 0-64 HANDICAP 1215 metres

MAD ESSJAY (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly.
From the vicinity of the 600 metres MAD ESSJAY (T. O'Donnell) was inclined to lay out under pressure.

## RACE 2 : MAXWELL COOPER MEMORIAL RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1008 metres

POWERFUL PEGASUS (A. Patterson) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.
Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Cahill, the rider of the second placegetter, FLY HALF, to view the official photo image for first.

## RACE 3 : QUEENSCLIFFE HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1215 metres

GULLY KING (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting LITTLE BUSTER (T. O'Donnell), which was inconvenienced when tightened onto BOSSED (T. Pannell).

TREJULS (K. Bishop) shifted out on jumping away and brushed MURTAGH (J. Potter).
GULLY KING (S. Price), which was racing keenly in the early and middle stages, made the turn near the 800 metres awkwardly and shifted out inconveniencing MISTY PALACE (A. Patterson) which was taken wider on the track.

GULLY KING (S. Price) raced greenly throughout the event and laid out under pressure in the straight. GULLY KING was examined by the Club's Veterinary who reported no visible abnormalities.

## RACE 4 : KANGAROO ISLAND GRAPEGROWERS \& WINEMAKERS RATING 0-78 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to TARVON losing its off fore plate en route to the barriers and requiring Farrier attention.

DUJAC (K. Bishop) and JUST A GIGGLE (T. Pannell) jumped away awkwardly.
LOTTO BLUES (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly and got its head up shortly after the start whilst being restrained.

## RACE 4 : KANGAROO ISLAND GRAPEGROWERS \& WINEMAKERS RATING 0-78 <br> HANDICAP - 1750 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 800 metres LOTTO BLUES (T. O'Donnell) shifted in onto REGANSBURG (A. Patterson) which was momentarily inconvenienced.
T. O'Donnell, the rider of LOTTO BLUES, was questioned regarding her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres. T. O'Donnell pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR.137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

## RACE 5 : SEALINK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1385 metres

BRAWNY FOX (M. Tyndall) stood flat footed and missed the start several lengths. Mr. R. Moore, the Trainer of BRAWNY FOX, was advised that a warning had been placed on this gelding and should it be slow to begin in future, stronger action may be taken against it.

LIME LIGHT GIRL (K. Bishop) and LA CRANKSTA (J. Potter) were slow to begin.
TRACY TRUE BLOOD (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly.
BIG POND (W. Kerford) shifted out on jumping away and contacted MISS FABULEUX (S. Price) which was inconvenienced.

GOTTA JEUNE (D. Tourneur) was held up from the vicinity of the 300 metres until near the 200 metres when racing behind MISS FABULEUX (S. Price) and inside CURRASILLA (A. Patterson).

Near the 200 metres KINGS AND JACKS (A. Herrmann) shifted out under pressure inconveniencing BIG POND (W. Kerford) which had to be steadied momentarily.

## RACE 6 : TECH DRY RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1385 metres

TROBEN (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.
In the vicinity of the 400 metres KELVOLI (S. Price) rolled out slightly as it commenced to weaken and brushed MIDARAS (M. Tyndall).

## RACE 7 : KANGAROO ISLAND RETRAVISION C,G \& E RATING 0-61 HANDICAP 1215 metres

ALANNAN LAD (K. Dyson) shifted out abruptly on jumping away making contact with SACHSE (M. Hoppo) which was taken out onto TAOS LIGHTNING (W. Kerford) tightening this gelding onto VENETO (A. Patterson) which was taken out onto HERBIE VEEDUB (M. Tyndall) which had been taken in slightly by ARCTIC JEWEL (J. Potter). As a result TAOS LIGHTNING lost ground and A. Patterson, the rider of VENETO had to take hold, losing its position.

Approaching the 1000 metres, M. Tyndall, the rider of HERBIE VEEDUB, had to take hold to avoid the heels of ARCTIC JEWEL (J. Potter) which shifted in. J. Potter was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was two lengths clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres HERBIE VEEDUB (M. Tyndall) became held up for a short distance when awkwardly placed on the heels of KASHINITE (T. O'Donnell).

## RACE 7 : KANGAROO ISLAND RETRAVISION C,G \& E RATING 0-61 HANDICAP 1215 metres (Cont'd)

VENETO, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

ARCTIC JEWEL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported some trauma to the off side eye. First aid was administered.
