STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse
by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Wednesday, 29 February 2012

WEATHER: Overcast

RAIL: True

RACE 1 : RETRAVISION – PORT LINCOLN RATING 60+ HANDICAP - 1750 metres

HASTEIN (NZ) (M. Pegus) and BIANIUM (P. Roff) brushed on jumping away.

LOTTO BLUES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : COMPLETE BUSINESS & ACCOUNTING SERVICES PTY LTD - 1350 metres

Racing from the 350 metres to inside the 200 metres BENNETT'S LANE (S. Cahill) was held up for clear running between ROLL ON BAI (K. Bishop) and OUT FOR LUNCH (J. Potter).

RACE 3 : MAGIC MILLIONS / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD HANDICAP - 1000 metres

On arrival on course TERRAPINNA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have a small laceration to its head. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew TERRAPINNA at 1.07 pm.

MR KARGER (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, bumping with HEAVENS SHOUT (S. Cahill), resulting in HEAVENS SHOUT knuckling.

JUST PURE FUN (L. Stojakovic) was inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

CLASSIC ELEGANCE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be shin sore in both forelegs.

RACE 4 : AUSTRAL BRICKS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

EVEN DOZEN (S. Cahill), STAR LEGION (C. Lever), SHOCKLEY (B. Hoppo) and TRACY TRUE BLOOD (M. Hoppo) were all inconvenienced at the start when LITTLE BUSTER (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and KIEVAN RUS (D. Tournour) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. As a result TRACY TRUE BLOOD was slow to begin.

On return to scale, C. Lever, the rider of STAR LEGION, reported his mount was inclined to lay out in running. STAR LEGION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : WATTERS ELECTRICAL (AUST) PTY LTD / SABOIS 3YO RATING 0-64 HANDICAP
- 1250 metres

REALLY ROCKING (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly brushing LYNSHEE (M. Hoppo).

MISS HARREB (J. Potter) was inconvenienced at the start when KOODA DAWN (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out and TWOSTEP (W. Kerford) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

KOODA DAWN (A. Patterson) was eased out of the event shortly after the 400 metres. A. Patterson reported that he believed his mount felt sore and was unable to make any ground in the early stages of the event. KOODA DAWN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be lame in the off hind leg. Mr. J. Dunn, the Trainer of KOODA DAWN, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

Racing to the 100 metres EXCEL WITH PRIDE (P. Roff) shifted out under pressure bumping MISS HARREB (J. Potter). Shortly after MIGHTY MOMENT (S. Cahill) rolled in under pressure bumping MISS HARREB.

Racing to inside the 100 metres MYKONOS SUNSET (K. Bishop), which was laying in under pressure, brushed with LYNSHEE (M. Hoppo).

MISS HARREB was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to have a laceration to the off hind leg. First aid was administered.

RACE 6 : CARLTON DRAUGHT RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately four minutes as ARTECHS lost its off side front shoe and had to be reshod.

ARTECHS and PROPHETS were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

ARTECHS (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly.

PROPHETS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in both forelegs. Mr. W. Clarken, the Trainer of PROPHETS was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

HOOLIGAN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : INDEPENDENT DISTILLERS CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

ALCOPOP LASS, which had become fractious in the mounting yard, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and ruled fit to start. Ms. K. Mckerlie, the Trainer of ALCOPOP LASS, was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

TOPS 'N' TAILS (M. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping JET FUSION (B. Hoppo).

ALCOPOP LASS (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping with DOUBLE DEALING (K. Bishop) and as a result ALCOPOP LASS lost its position.

RACE 7 : INDEPENDENT DISTILLERS CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

JET FUSION (B. Hoppo) was inclined to hang out making the turn into the straight

Racing from the 100 metres to the winning post YOUKNOWTHERULES (D. Evans) was momentarily inconvenienced when racing tight to the inside of JET FUSION (B. Hoppo) which shifted in under pressure. B. Hoppo was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

Correct weight for this race was delayed to allow D. Evans, the rider of the fourth placegetter, to view the official vision.

RACE 8 : REVOLUTION ROOFING RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

HUNTED ANGEL (B. Hoppo) was slow to begin.

DIAMOND JUDDY (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out brushing with OUR DESTINATION (K. Bishop).

JACKIE'S PAPER (L. Hopwood) stumbled on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin.

Racing from the 500 metres RIPASON (M. Neve) was held up for clear running on the heels of HEART OF STONE (S. Westover).

EPOCHAL (NZ) (D. Tourneur) laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.
