STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 21 April 2012

RACE 1 : SCHWEPPE OAKS DAY 28TH APRIL HANDICAP - 1000 metres

MEDAL CONTENDER (L. Hopwood) was slow to jump.

IMPULSE BUY (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly and brushed with SATURDAY'S CHILD (J. Lyon).

For some distance in the vicinity of the 400 metres HANK'S NEPHEW (J. Holder) was inconvenienced in attempting to maintain its position inside the hindquarters of SATURDAY'S CHILD (J. Lyon) as that gelding rolled in.

IMPULSE BUY lost its off fore plate during this event.

MISS OTTO and KING VALENTINE were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : DISTINCTIVE HOMES GOODWOOD DAY 12TH MAY HANDICAP - 2400 metres

J. Holder, the rider of RAKI, explained that he had been instructed to settle where the gelding was comfortable but certainly in the first four. He stated that in hindsight RAKI may have travelled more comfortably if he had settled a horse further back. RAKI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. T. McEvoy, the Trainer of RAKI, confirmed his instructions for both his runners, RAKI and PELICANO, and that the instructions were consistent with those provided previously.

RACE 3 : CENTREBET SA DERBY DAY 5TH MAY HANDICAP - 1250 metres

Mr. L. Macdonald, the joint Trainer of SECRET STATUS, which proved difficult to load, was advised that a repeat of the filly's behaviour may lead to action being taken against it.

EMBARRASSED (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto PROTECTOR (J. Toeroek) which was inconvenienced.

On jumping away GOLD BUNDLE (J. Potter) shifted out onto DEVILS FORCE (M. Pegus) taking that gelding out onto EXALTED THOMAS (J. Holder) which was severely hampered when tightened onto LALLA ROOKH (S. Westover) inconveniencing that mare.

RACE 3 : CENTREBET SA DERBY DAY 5TH MAY HANDICAP - 1250 metres (Cont'd)

EMBARRASSED (P. Gatt) was inclined to get its head up and race keenly in the early stages of the race.

From the 300 metres VALOROSO (Jordan Frew) was unable to obtain clear ground until altering course approaching the 100 metres.

Mr. C. Stewart, the Trainer of WEHOLDTHEACE, was questioned regarding the instructions provided to Jockey C. Lever in this race. C. Lever stated that he had been instructed to attempt to ride WEHOLDTHEACE back in the field due to the apparent pace of the race. Mr. C. Stewart was charged under Rule AR.137A in that he had not notified the Stewards of instructions which differed from those provided at the gelding's previous start. He was found guilty and fined \$250.

RACE 4 : SPORTINGBET SA SIRES' PRODUCE STAKES - 1400 metres

Mr. T. McEvoy, the Trainer of SERENA, which proved difficult to load, was advised that the filly would be required to perform to Steward's satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

CHOSEN MOMENT (D. Moor) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto BIG CHILL (A. Patterson) which was inconvenienced.

SERENA (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MONICA KATE (A. Herrmann) which was inconvenienced.

On jumping away ROAD TRIPPIN (C. Lever) was tightened for room between SENSATIONAL CARD (M. Pegasus) which rolled in marginally and SERENA (M. Neilson) which shifted out abruptly.

Making the turn in the vicinity of the 900 metres MONICA KATE (A. Herrmann) got its head up and became awkward on the heels of ROAD TRIPPIN (C. Lever) shifting out onto CHOSEN MOMENT (D. Moor) which was hampered when taken wider.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres ROAD TRIPPIN (C. Lever) was inclined to race keenly and consequently had to be steadied away from the heels of SERENA (M. Neilson). When being steadied ROAD TRIPPIN was inclined to over race.

At the entrance to the straight, when attempting to improve, HOW SWEDE IT IS (J. Hill) shifted out and brushed the hindquarters of SERENA (M. Neilson) turning that filly in resulting in HOW SWEDE IT IS becoming awkward when held up inside the heels of SERENA and behind OUT OF COOBER (L. Hopwood).

Approaching the 300 metres ROAD TRIPPIN (C. Lever) was disappointed when attempting to improve into a neat run inside SENSATIONAL CARD (M. Pegasus) by SERENA (M. Neilson) which shifted out resulting in ROAD TRIPPIN being forced to check to avoid the heels.

ROAD TRIPPIN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

OUT OF COOBER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a laceration to the tendon on the off hind leg. First Aid was administered.

RACE 5 : BOAG'S DRAUGHT HANDICAP - 1250 metres

CHILLA DEVA (J. Holder) and DUBAWI GOLD (Jordan Frew) were slow to jump.

On jumping away BOLD DAZZLER (J. Toeroek) and SARCASM (A. Patterson) brushed.

Shortly after the start LADY LIGHFOOT (R. Stewart) and DUBAWI GOLD (Jordan Frew) brushed.

Approaching the 900 metres BOLD DAZZLER (J. Toeroek) became awkward and got its head up.

From the 400 metres SHAKETHEGROUND (T. Zanker) became held up when racing inside MAKTUUB (S. Westover) and behind GLAZE (NZ) (D. Tourneur). Thereafter, SHAKETHEGROUND (T. Zanker) was unable to find clear ground until approaching the 100 metres.

R. Stewart, the rider of LADY LIGHFOOT, which had lead in its recent starts, explained that the mare had not begun as well as previously and given the pace of the race could not have been more forward on this occasion.

RACE 6 : H C NITSCHKE STAKES - 1400 metres

Mr. C. Stewart, the Trainer of KINSELMAC MANNER, advised Stewards that he would instruct rider, T. Pannell, to attempt to ride the gelding midfield with cover, if possible, in order for it to finish the race off.

On jumping away KINSELMAC MANNER (T. Pannell) rolled in and brushed BALZEUS (D. Tourneur).

From the 400 metres to the vicinity of the 300 metres BALZEUS (D. Tourneur) was unable to obtain clear ground.

Approaching the 300 metres KINSELMAC MANNER (T. Pannell) and ROUGH DEAL (A. Patterson) brushed.

From inside the 200 metres FIDDY (L. Stojakovic) was eased out of the race. L. Stojakovic stated that although the filly had lead, in her opinion it wasn't entitled to give ground in the manner it did. FIDDY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Mr. D. Clarken, the Trainer of FIDDY, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

RACE 7 : HOLDFAST INSURANCE CITY OF ADELAIDE HANDICAP - 1400 metres

As the Identification Card for SHEILA'S STAR was not available on course the Stewards were able to establish the identity of SHEILA'S STAR from records held by them and the mare was permitted to start. Having considered the explanation provided by Mr. M. Price, the Trainer of SHEILA'S STAR, as to why the Identification Card was not available as required, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$100 under ARR.59A.

Mr. G. Searle, the Trainer of MORNIN' SAM advised Stewards that from the horses outside barrier he would instruct the rider, A. Patterson, if possible, to allow the horse to drop out and race behind midfield to afford MORNIN' SAM every opportunity of running a strong 1400 metres.

APPIEL (J. Lyon), which struck the rail behind the start was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

RACE 7 : HOLDFAST INSURANCE CITY OF ADELAIDE HANDICAP

- 1400 metres (Cont'd)

On jumping away SHEILA'S STAR (C. Lindop) knuckled.

Inside the 200 metres DETOX (D. Tourneur) shifted in onto MAGIC ME (NZ) (P. Gatt) at the same time as BUDRIGUEZ (J. Potter) rolled out resulting in MAGIC ME (NZ) being hampered when tightened for room. In being tightened, MAGIC ME (NZ) became awkward for several strides.

SHEILA'S STAR and BUDRIGUEZ were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

APPIEL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a superficial laceration on the right flank.

RACE 8 : PEWSEY VALE HANDICAP - 1000 metres

Mr. G. Searle, the Trainer of GRAND TAJ, advised Stewards that following an unsuccessful attempt to ride the gelding off the pace at its previous start at Oakbank, the stable would revert to the previous instructions that GRAND TAJ be allowed to settle on pace if possible.

GRAND TAJ (J. Lyon) reared as the gates opened.

In the early stages of the race GRAND TAJ (J. Lyon) raced fiercely when being restrained.

Approaching the finish SEQUALLAN (B. Claridge) shifted out and brushed SPIRITED ADDITION (P. Gatt).

Correct weight was delayed to allow Stewards to view the official vision of the start.

AMY'S GLEN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who confirmed the mare suffered a bi-lateral bleeding attack during the event. Mr. M. Kavanagh, the Trainer of AMY'S GLEN was advised, as this was the second bleeding attack for this mare, it was banned from racing under ARR.53A.

FAB FEVOLA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
