RACE 1 : PORT AUGUSTA VET SERVICES / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE
- 1100 metres

The start of this race was delayed owing to ROAD TO DANTREE providing difficult to load. Mr. S. Drewitt, the Trainer of ROAD TO DANTREE, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding regarding its behaviour.

PROPSHAFT (J. Potter) and LIL' STORM QUEEN (W. Kerford) were slow to begin.

MARITIME LAD (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, inconveniencing ROAD TO DANTREE (P. Roff).

MONTALTO (Jordan Frew) jumped away awkwardly.

Inside the 800 metres MARITIME LAD (A. Patterson), which was inclined to race greenly, dipped, resulting in FALPOLLO (B. Claridge) and REDLEAF ROSE (K. Bishop) being inconvenienced. As a result REDLEAF ROSE lost its position.

LETHAL ROCK (T. Pannell) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

FALPOLLO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be lame in the off foreleg. First Aid was administered. Mr. D. Halliday, the Trainer of FALPOLLO, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

REDLEAF ROSE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : M J GELDART DESIGNER JEWELLERS / SABOIS 3YO RATING 0-64
HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MIME (B. Claridge) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

Racing to the 800 metres HE'S DISTINCTIVE (T. O'Donnell), which was racing ungenerously, had to be steadied away from the heels of LYNSHEE (P. Roff).

HE'S DISTINCTIVE (T. O'Donnell) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. HE'S DISTINCTIVE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. S. Oxlade, the Trainer of HE'S DISTINCTIVE, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 3 : JJ'S SKIP HIRE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

SHE'S A COMMODITY (W. Kerford) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing MS TWENTYONE (M. Tyndall).

SETATREND, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. J. Coe, the Trainer of SETATREND, was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

SHE'S A COMMODITY, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. A. Jarvis, the Trainer of SHE'S A COMMODITY, was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 4 : AUGUSTA CAN & BOTTLE RECYCLERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

LANKY'S LASS (S. Westover) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, inconveniencing FOLLOWTHEFOOTSTEPS (J. Kah).

POLLY GARTER (B. Claridge) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, brushing DAZED (P. Roff).

KOODA CHANCE (K. Bishop) was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

Jemma Frew, the rider of HAPPY PINK, reported she was of the opinion her mount had choked down during the race and as a result she did not ride her mount out to the line. HAPPY PINK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

KOODA CHANCE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : O-M-N-I PINK RATING 60 & OVER HANDICAP - 1100 metres

ICE TEE (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly was slow to begin.

MAKTUUB (J. Kah) was slow to begin.

Rounding the home turn ALMOST CHEVAL (Jordan Frew) was momentarily held up for clear running on the heels of BENNETT'S LANE (P. Roff).

RACE 6 : THETRAININGDUO2 RATING 0-61 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

Racing to the 900 metres LORD OF THE CASTLE (D. Evans) shifted in and as a result inconvenienced MONFILS (W. Kerford), which had to shift in and away to avoid the heels of LORD OF THE CASTLE. D. Evans was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Racing to the 250 metres EDGE OFF (D. Tootell) shifted out to improve its position from behind TAOS LIGHTNING (J. Potter) and as a result contacted LORD OF THE CASTLE (D. Evans) who was momentarily inconvenienced.

RACE 7 : TERRY GARDINERS MEATS & SMALL GOODS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

PRETTY DANZ (D. Evans) stood flat-footed and was slow to begin.

KING RODNEY (J. Potter) raced greenly in the early stages.

Racing to the 250 metres PRETTY DANZ (D. Evans), when shifting wider on the track to improve its position, contacted ALICE LONGING (T. Zanker) who was momentarily inconvenienced.

RACE 8 : PORT AUGUSTA STEEL CENTRE RATING 0-61 HANDICAP - 1850 metres

PENN STATION (NZ) (J. Kah) was slow to begin.

In the early and middle stages TEAM LAGO (T. Zanker), when being restrained, was inclined to over-race and race ungenerously.

Racing from the 400 metres to the 250 metres STAR LEGION (D. Evans) was held up for clear ground on the heels of SOVEREIGN CONQUEST (A. Patterson).

TONI'S CONNECTION (E. Boyd) was inclined to lay out throughout the event and when entering the straight was inclined to lay in. TONI'S CONNECTION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
