Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday. 27 June 2012

RACE 1 : CRITERION TAVERN / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1211 metres

GRIGIO NOW (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

KING'S GIFT (J. Bowditch) was slow to begin.

Racing to the 900 metres KING'S GIFT (J. Bowditch) was inconvenienced when SLASH (J. Toeroek), which was racing greenly, rolled out.

Racing to the 800 metres SLASH (J. Toeroek) was inconvenienced when SHEHARA (C. Lever) rolled in.

Approaching the 200 metres A. Herrmann, the rider of FERRARI RED accidentally drop her whip. A. Herrmann was reprimanded under ARR.137(a) for carelessness.

J. Bowditch, the rider of KING'S GIFT, explained the gelding began awkwardly, showed no early speed and raced greenly throughout. As a result he decided to settle back further in the field to allow the gelding to find its feet KING'S GIFT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2122 metres

MS TWENTYONE (M. Tyndall) jumped away awkwardly.

THE WILD THING (J. Holder) was slow to begin.

MS TWENTYONE (M. Tyndall) was inclined to pull hard and raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

RACE 2 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2122 metres (Cont'd)

Racing to the 1700 metres MS TWENTYONE (M. Tyndall), which was racing ungenerously, was obliged to be restrained off the heels of MARLBOROUGH (NZ) (M. Neilson).

Shortly after making the crossing MARLBOROUGH (NZ) (M. Neilson) rolled out brushing BUX THE TREND (A. Herrmann).

MICKIEM (C. Lever) raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

HERE'S ARCHIE (S. Cahill) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and in the home straight. HERE'S ARCHIE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: COOPERS DR TIMS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1111 metres

VILLE DE BERNE (J. Maund) was slow to begin.

DYNAMIC LOVER (B. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly.

Shortly after the start, MEADOWS STORM (C. Lindop) was tightened for room and had to be steadied when LADY ALASKA (P. Gatt) shifted out and away from JUST RANGER (Jemma Frew), which shifted out marginally.

RACE 4 : GAWLER TAXI / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 15511 metres

PINT MUG (S. Cahill) and WICKED ROMEO (J. Potter) were slow to begin.

BLEVIC LAD (M. Schrapel) raced wide without cover in the early stages.

Racing to the 800 metres ARADANCHI (B. Claridge) had a tendency to lay in resulting in I'M A MENICE (C. Lever) having to be steadied to avoid the heels of ARADANCHI.

- J. Potter was questioned regarding the poor performance of WICKED ROMEO. J. Potter stated that his instructions were to be in a forward position but the gelding was slow to begin and as a result he rode his mount hard in the early stages. He added the gelding didn't travel as well as he had expected between the 1200 metres to the 1000 metres and approaching the 800 metres the gelding had finished its run. He was also of the opinion that WICKED ROMEO was maybe at the end of its preparation. WICKED ROMEO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Mr. D. Jolly, the Trainer of WICKED ROMEO, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.
- P. Gatt, the rider of KANGAROO JACK, explained that his instructions were to go forward and to try and keep improving the gelding throughout the race. After horses to his inside showed early speed he tried to restrain the gelding to obtain cover but was unable to do so as the gelding was pulling hard. Stewards also spoke to Mrs. H. Frew, the joint Trainer of KANGAROO JACK who confirmed the instructions given to the rider. Stewards determined that the riding tactics employed today was not a significant variation to that adopted by the stable in recent starts as Mrs Frew explained in its previous starts it had been the intention to be more forward but circumstanses prevented them from doing so. Notwithstanding the explanation provided by the Frew stable, Stewards reminded Mrs. Frew of the stables obligations in respect of the rule relating to varying the tactics in a race.

RACE 5: KINGSFORD HOTEL RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1511 metres

STYLISH SPENDER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and found to be lame in the off foreleg. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew STYLISH SPENDER at 2.13pm. Mrs. S. Murphy, the Trainer of STYLISH SPENDER, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

ROYAL STORMY (J. Holder) and SLACKSMITH (NZ) (B. Clardige) were slow to begin.

CRUZ'N NOW (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly.

FRENCH ACADEMY (P. Gatt) knuckled at the start.

ROYAL STORMY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and was found to have excess upper respiratory noise. D. Koch, the Trainer of ROYAL STORMY, was advised a laryngoscopic examination would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

SLACKSMITH (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: MARCELLIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1211 metres

AUBURN TIGER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon after Trainer, Mr. B. Mueller raised concerns with stewards in respect of this mare's near fore tendon. The mare was found to be lame in the upper flexor tendon region on the near foreleg. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew AUBURN TIGER at 2.28pm. Mr. B. Mueller, the Trainer of AUBURN TIGER, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

PARK RANGER (Jemma Frew) and ZIP IN TIME (J. Toeroek) reared at the start.

WHOLETTHECATOUT (E. Boyd) was slow to begin.

Racing to the 800 metres SILVER MOMENT (M. Schrapel) was inclined to race keenly and had to be steadied off the heels of ENERGIZED (IRE) D. Stra.

RACE 7: WATERSEARCH RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2122 metres

STURGIS (NZ) (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly, shifting in brushing JEUNE'S LAGOON (J. Toeroek).

COOL CLASSIC (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was momentarily unbalanced.

C. Lindop, the rider of FOXTROT NOVEY, accidentally dropped her whip round the home turn. C. Lindop was reprimanded under ARR.137(a) for carelessness.

RACE 8 : COOPERS PALE ALE CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1211 metres

On arrival on course LYNVAN ROSE which had not raced for over twelve months was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

LYNVAN ROSE (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 8: COOPERS PALE ALE CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1211 metres (Cont'd)

Shortly after the start LITTLE SIP (Jemma Frew) had to be momentarily steadied when LYNVAN ROSE (L. Hopwood) rolled out marginally.

Rounding the home turn EMMOOKI'S DASH (S. Westover) was inclined to race greenly.

Rounding the home turn BEEARCH (A. Patterson) was inclined to hang out.

Shortly after the entrance to the straight, FANTASTIC REIGN (K. Bishop) was held up for clear ground for a short distance on the heels of REGAL MONTY (C. Lever).
