RACE 1 : AUSTIN CONDON OAM MEMORIAL / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

QUENCH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race.

LADY ALASKA (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

KLONDIKE LIL (T. Pannell) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres BON CHERIE (E. Boyd) rolled in and had to be momentarily steadied off the heels of QUENCH (J. Holder).

RACE 2: IAN THOMAS MEMORIAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

On jumping away FERRARI STAR (M. Neilson) and SMUG (J. Kah) came together and brushed.

DUPLICITOUS (J. Bowditch) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

IZIDES (S. Cahill) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

At the entrance to the straight AMICI MIEI (J. Maund) shifted out and contacted IZIDES (S. Cahill) which was taken wider onto the track.

On straightening, ORIGATO (NZ) (C. Lever) shifted out to improve, inconveniencing DUPLICITOUS (J. Bowditch) which was taken wider on the track.

RACE 2: IAN THOMAS MEMORIAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

M. Neilson, the rider of FERRARI STAR, was questioned regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres. M. Neilson pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR.137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

DUPLICITOUS and ORIGATO (NZ), which performed below expectations, were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: RICHARD GREEN AM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to BLACK ABBEY making heavy contact with a perimeter fence in the mounting yard and dislodging its rider. BLACK ABBEY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew BLACK ABBEY at 1.13pm. J. Toeroek, the rider of BLACK ABBEY, was examined by the on course ambulance personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

POLLY GARTER (B. Claridge) stood flat footed and missed the start several lengths. Mr. D. Halliday, the Trainer of POLLY GARTER, was advised that the mare would be required to jump with the field in an official barrier trial prior to accepting of a future race.

Approaching the 600 metres AGENT NESS (C. Lever) became keen when racing on the heels of FINLEY PIG (J. Potter) and shifted out making contact with OUR RUBY (P. Gatt).

In the vicinity of the 450 metres POLLY GARTER (B. Claridge) improved to the inside of KOODA CHANCE (K. Bishop) and made contact with that gelding's hind quarters.

MY BIG GIRL lost its off fore plate during the event.

GET UP STAND UP lost its near hind plate during the event.

FINLEY PIG was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the colt to be exhibiting upper respiratory noise. Mr. T. McEvoy, the Trainer of FINLEY PIG, was advised the results of an endoscopic exam would be required prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

RACE 4: HAROLD LANE OAM RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2200 metres

MOUNTAIN CLIMBER (J. Toeroek) and FAINEANT (D. Tourneur) were slow to begin.

FRESH TELL (J. Maund) and ROCK LEGEND (M. Tyndall) came together and made contact on jumping away.

BLUE SIMONE (J. Potter) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BELL RINGER (Jordan Frew) raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

A. Patterson, the rider of COOL CLASSIC, which performed poorly, explained that the gelding had travelled fairly in the early and middle stages of the event however, when placed under pressure inside the 700 metres, failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly. COOL CLASSIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

After the running of this event, jockey B. Claridge requested to be examined by the on course ambulance personnel who ruled him unfit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 5: RAY WILLIAMS CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

On arrival on course, THAT'S ALL GOLD, which was fractious in its float en route to the course, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a laceration over the left eye and ruled the filly unfit to race. Acting on this advice, Stewards withdrew THAT'S ALL GOLD at 12.55pm. First aid was administered.

TWO BEES (D. Tourneur) was slow to begin.

KINSELMAC MANNER (J. Toeroek) attempted to buck for a short distance after the start.

GAILAMOUR (J. Maund) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 6: PHYLLIS O'DEA MEMORIAL / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ORCHESTRAL (K. Bishop) shifted out on jumping away contacting DELPHERE (T. Pannell) taking that mare back in onto KOODA DIVA (T. Zanker) which shifted out marginally.

SANDQUILL (T. Baker) was slow to begin.

MOUNTAIN CAT (J. Kah) reported that the mare hung out over the final 200 metres. MOUNTAIN CAT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

KATE'S DREAM, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: LINDSAY THIELE MEMORIAL RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

OUT DO ME (A. Patterson) and NEVELE TOL (C. Lever) were slow to begin.

TEAM LAGO (T. Zanker) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

T. Zanker, the rider of TEAM LAGO, reported that in her opinion, the gelding had not handled the track conditions. TEAM LAGO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

OUT DO ME was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 8: IAN BARTON MEMORIAL COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SEVENTH BULLET (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting GULLY KING (J. Kah).

KELPORT (L. Hopwood) was slow to begin.

OUR DESTINATION (C. Lindop) and ANY MINUTE NOW (K. Bishop) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Inside the 500 metres KELPORT (L. Hopwood) improved onto the heels of SIR READY (A. Patterson) and had to be steadied.

DAPAMAC lost its off fore plate during the running of the event.

DAPAMAC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. First aid was administered.
