**RACE 1 : EMOYENI WINES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE -**  
**1210 metres**

On arrival at the barriers DINKY DI GOLD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to start.

DARCY'S FOLLY (L. Stojakovic) was slow to jump.

BERT DA FLYER (M. Schrapel) and LIGHT SUPREME (T. Baker) brushed on jumping.

LIGHT SUPREME (T. Baker) was inclined to race greenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Racing inside the 400 metres BERT DA FLYER (M. Schrapel) was obliged to alter course to the outside of DINKY DI GOLD (J. Holder) to obtain clear running when DINKY DI GOLD shifted in under pressure.

BERT DA FLYER (M. Schrapel) and KING CADEL (M. Neilson) were inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

BERT DA FLYER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near fore shin. Mr. R. Jolly, the Trainer of BERT DA FLYER, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

**RACE 2 : ARDROSSAN HOTEL MOTEL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2210 metres**

TAPEKA POINT (NZ) (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres, TAPEKA POINT (NZ) (P. Gatt) was inclined to pull hard.

Approaching the 600 metres SIR PRESIDENTE (NZ) (J. Toeroek) shifted out to improve its position and as a result brushed MARLBOROUGH (NZ) (C. Lever).

**RACE 2 : ARDROSSAN HOTEL MOTEL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2210 metres**  
**(Cont'd)**

MARLBOROUGH (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have a slower than expected cardiac recovery. Mr. M. Kavanagh, the Trainer of MARLBOROUGH (NZ), was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

**RACE 3 : ECKERSLEY ENGINEERING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1055 metres**

DANZEROUND THE SUN (K. Bishop) and NADIVA (M. Neilson) brushed on jumping.

SCHUMACHER (C. Lever) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out inconveniencing LADY KAHUNA (D. Tourneur) which shifted out, brushing BLACK ABBEY (L. Hopwood).

BLACK ABBEY (L. Hopwood) was inclined to race ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

From in the vicinity off the 200 metres NULLARBOR NYMPH (P. Gatt) was inclined to race greenly.

SCHUMACHER (C. Lever) was inclined to race greenly throughout the event.

**RACE 4 : WHEATSHEAF HOTEL-PRICE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1055 metres**

BREAK THE DRY, which reared and fell over in the mounting yard, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race. Mr. D. O'Leary, the Trainer of BREAK THE DRY, was advised that a Warning has been placed on this mare in relation to its pre-race manners.

OUR DESTINATION (K. Bishop) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

BREAK THE DRY (M. Neilson) reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start BELLEAP (J. Potter) shifted out bumping OUR DESTINATION (K. Bishop) who, as a result, shifted out inconveniencing BREAK THE DRY (M. Neilson) which lost its position when being taken out onto the hindquarters of WANAKA GOLD (J. Holder).

Approaching the 700 metres NADAKA (C. Lindop) raced ungenerously on the heels of BELLEAP (J. Potter).

In the vicinity of the 600 metres NADAKA (C. Lindop), which continued to race ungenerously, raced in restricted room between OUR DESTINATION (K. Bishop), to its inside, and THREE STAR GENERAL (J. Toeroek), to it outside.

BREAK THE DRY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

WANAKA GOLD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had abrasions to the near hind fetlock.

**RACE 5 : SHANE ALLEN PLUMBING / SABOIS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1410 metres**

MYKONOS SUNSET (K. Bishop) and BARJAS (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly.

SMUG (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in brushing MOONBOOTS (C. Lindop).

FULL BORE (J. Toeroek) was inclined to pull hard in the early and middle stages of the event.

**RACE 6 : ARDROSSAN HOME, TIMBER & HARDWARE / SABOIS F&M RATING 0-68  
HANDICAP - 1410 metres**

S'AMUSE (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

SHARADA (J. Toeroek) stood flat footed and was very slow to begin and as a result missed the start by several lengths. Mr. D. Halliday, the Trainer of SHARADA, was advised the mare would be required to complete a satisfactory barrier trial prior to presenting for a future race.

Racing to the 1200 metres JULIE MARIE (J. Potter) jumped a patch on the track.

Approaching the 800 metres RUB DOUBT (Jordan Frew) raced ungenerously and had to momentarily steady off the heels of JEWEL OF CADENCE (J. Kah).

**RACE 7 : TEAM WISS FOUR-YEAR-OLD & OVER RAATING 0-71 HANDICAP -  
1210 metres**

ASSO BELLO (T. O'Donnell) was slow to begin.

FRENCH CHARGE (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in, and brushed VALUE AS (P. Gatt).

FRENCH CHARGE (L. Hopwood) was inclined to race keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Racing to the 800 metres AMERICAN TRILOGY (M. Neilson) appeared to dip for no apparent reason.

Racing from the 500 metres to the 300 metres VALUE AS (P. Gatt) was held up for clear ground when racing on the heels of AMERICAN TRILOGY (M. Neilson).

FRENCH CHARGE (L. Hopwood) was inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

J. Frew, the rider of UMALUKA, was questioned regarding his use of the whip in the straight. J. Frew was reprimanded under ARR.137A(3) in that he used his whip, in the Stewards opinion excessively. He was also cautioned that a similar breach in the future will result in a penalty being imposed.

**RACE 8 : CROWELL CONCRETE ENTIRES & GELDINGS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP -  
1410 metres**

SACHSE lost its near hind plate during the event.
