Report on Race Meeting held at the Mindarie-Halidon Racecourse

RACE 1 : MALLEE DIPPING & MULESING / MURRAY ZIRCON / SABOIS C, G & E
MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes initially owing to SWISS CHALET proving difficult to load. Thereafter it was established that the back gate on barrier stall 5 was unable to be locked in place and as a consequence SWISS CHALET backed out of its barrier stall. SWISS CHALET and SET ON STONE were moved out one barrier position and barrier stall 5 was left vacant.

BRAY VIEW (D. Tourneur) stood flat footed and lost many lengths at the start. BRAY VIEW was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SHARK EYE (Jordan Frew) shifted out shortly after the start and inconvenienced DEPUTY GEORGE (S. Price).

In the vicinity of the 600 metres SET ON STONE (J. Potter) raced in restricted room inside the heels of HIGHLAND HENRY (K. Bishop) for a number of strides and became ungenerous.

Jordan Frew, the rider of SHARK EYE, reported that his mount hung out during the event. He explained that from inside the 600 metres SHARK EYE commenced to hang out placing him at a disadvantage and thereafter, shortly after entering the straight, when asked for an effort, the horse initially responded to his riding but continued to hang out and as a consequence he did not ride his horse out fully to the end of the race. Stewards advised Jordan Frew that whilst they acknowledged that the horse hung out during the event and whilst they were satisfied that the result of the race had not been effected, under similar circumstances in future, he is to continue to ride his mounts to the line. SHARK EYE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : KELVIN WESTBROOK TRANSPORT / LOXTON IRRIGATION / SABOIS F&M
MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

GIVE HER A GO (A. Patterson) was slow to begin.

DEHAVILLAND DIVA (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly making contact with its outside barrier gate.

**RACE 2 : KELVIN WESTBROOK TRANSPORT / LOXTON IRRIGATION / SABOIS F&M
MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres (Cont'd)**

STARFIRE LADY (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting ILLYAKHA (K. Bishop) which then raced in restricted room for a short distance as FLYING HANKERCHIEF (J. Potter) shifted in and away from BUSH GEM (S. Westover).

In the vicinity of the 900 metres FLYING HANKERCHIEF (J. Potter), when being corrected as it was taken in slightly by BUSH GEM (S. Westover), shifted out and was obliged to steady off the heels of BUSH GEM.

DEHAVILLAND DIVA (E. Boyd), which was inclined to lay out throughout the event, raced very wide without cover in the early stages and raced wide on the home turn and into the straight. DEHAVILLAND DIVA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

ILLYAKHA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a laceration to its near hind cannon. First aid was administered.

TIGARA'S GEM lost its off hind plate during the event.

**RACE 3 : NORM HUMPHRYS MEMORIAL / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE -
1800 metres**

DANCES WITH SPURS (D. Tourneur) reared as the gates were released, began awkwardly and shifted out at the same time as BANGLES (J. Kah) began awkwardly and shifted in resulting in contact between these two horses.

DANCES WITH SPURS (D. Tourneur), BANGLES (J. Kah) and SET TO EXCITE (S. Westover) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

INSATIABLE (C. Lindop) laid in, in the straight.

ALWAYS IN DA'NILE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported minor lacerations to the inside of its off hind hock. First aid was administered.

**RACE 4 : FLEA & DOUG FULLSTON MEMORIAL RATING 0-61 HANDICAP -
1800 metres**

JUST RANGER (Jordan Frew) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted NO DOUBTFIRE (D. Tourneur) which was taken in and tightened onto ORCHESTRAL (J. Kah) who in turn was tightened onto AFRISKY BUSINESS (T. Zanker) resulting in ORCHESTRAL and AFRISKY BUSINESS being inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres AFRISKY BUSINESS (T. Zanker) was inconvenienced and had to be steadied off the heels of JUST RANGER (Jordan Frew), when taken in by NO DOUBTFIRE (D. Tourneur) which rolled in slightly.

T. Zanker, the rider of AFRISKY BUSINESS, explained that after receiving slight interference near the 500 metres the gelding appeared reluctant and failed to respond to her riding in the straight. She added that in her opinion the horse may not have been fully suited to today's shorter distance.

RACE 5 : COLLINS INDUSTRIAL MINDARIE-HALIDON CUP - 1800 metres

RACE 6 : RADIO 801-5RM / RADIO 5MU & POWER FM RATING 0-59 HANDICAP -
1000 metres

FOR GLORY (T. Zanker) reared and jumped away very awkwardly resulting in this gelding being very slow to begin. T. Zanker explained that it was her intention to settle in a forward position but as a result of the horse rearing at the start, she was unable to do so. FOR GLORY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

TORTURED was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : ZADOW WELL DRILLING / LANDMARK GREENFIELD KAROONDA RATING
0-59 HANDICAP - 1380 metres

SERIOUS DANGER (B. Claridge) and CABERNET NOW (D. Tootell) were slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres BREAK THE DRY (J. Toeroek) contacted the inside running rail, shifted out abruptly making contact with JULIE MARIE (J. Potter) which was inconvenienced and as a consequence LOTTALAGO (C. Lindop), which was following, was obliged to steady off the heels of JULIE MARIE.

Rounding the home turn, shortly prior to entering the straight, JEWEL OF CADENCE (J. Kah) shifted out taking C'MON NOW (L. Hopwood) out across the running of LOTTALAGO (C. Lindop) which was obliged to be steadied and was inconvenienced. J. Kah, the rider of JEWEL OF CADENCE, was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground. Shortly thereafter, inside the 200 metres, as LOTTALAGO improved into a run between C'MON NOW (L. Hopwood), to its inside and SIR TRENTIN (J. Maund), to her outside, SIR TRENTIN commenced to shift ground inwards and crossed the running of LOTTALAGO (C. Lindop) which was obliged to be steadied and had to alter course to the outside of SIR TRENTIN. J. Maund was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future when his mounts commence to shift ground.

LOTTALAGO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Potter, the rider of JULIE MARIE, explained that after receiving slight interference from BREAK THE DRY (J. Toeroek) in the vicinity of the 700 metres, his mount was off the bridle and was reluctant to maintain its position despite his efforts. Thereafter, after straightening, he added the horse only finished the race off fairly. JULIE MARIE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. S. Oxlade, the Trainer of JULIE MARIE, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.
