STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse
by the Strathalbyn Racing Club on Monday, 1 October 2012

Stewards: M. Santoro (A/Chairman), J. Petzer (HT), S. Callanan (F) & N. Castle (M) (Stewards), A. Quinton (Deputy Steward) & Dr. P. Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon)

TRACK: Dead 5

WEATHER: Fine

RAIL: Normal

RACE 1 : BETFAIR / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

CHAPPY'S STAR (NZ) (J. Maund) laid out severely throughout the event. CHAPPY'S STAR (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. K. Frew, the Co-Trainer of CHAPPY'S STAR (NZ), was advised the mare would be required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race. Mr. Frew advised the stable would recommend to the owners the mare now be retired.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres KOODA CHANGE (A. Patterson) improved onto the heels of MEADOWS BOO (J. Kah) had to be steadied and raced keenly for a short distance.

RACE 2 : GLIDEROL MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

SUMMER WITH ROSIE (NZ) (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacting ANGEL EYES (L. Hopwood), which was inconvenienced.

PRIDE OF OLIVIA (D. Tourneur) was slow to begin.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow L. Hopwood, the rider of the fifth placegetter ANGEL EYES, to view the official photo image for fourth.

RACE 3 : BETFAIR / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

Acting on confirmed advice from Mr. M. Kavanagh, the Trainer of LIFE IN A METRO, that the filly had swelling to its off hind leg and would be unfit to start, Stewards withdrew LIFE IN A METRO at 9.00 am.

KRISTABELLA threw its head on a number of occasions en route to the barriers, striking its rider J. Kah. J. Kah was examined by the on course Ambulance personnel who reported she had a laceration to her nose and would be unfit to ride in this event. Acting on that advice, KRISTABELLA was withdrawn by Stewards at 1.59 pm.

LATVIAN AMBER (L. Stojakovic) shifted out on jumping away and brushed FLYING CLUB (A. Patterson).

RACE 4 : GLIDEROL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2050 metres

J. Kah was examined by the on course Ambulance personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

RACE 4 : GLIDEROL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2050 metres (Cont'd)

Mr. D. Koch, the Trainer of WHERE'S TIM, advised Stewards he would instruct Jockey J. Holder to ride the gelding in a more positive manner in the early stages than at its most recent starts, as in the Stable's opinion it was one paced and would derive a benefit from being ridden closer to the speed.

ALWAYS IN DA'NILE (L. Hopwood) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and was inclined to lay out throughout. ALWAYS IN DA'NILE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported very minor fresh bruising to the near side cheek.

In the early and middle stages STURGIS (NZ) (J. Kah) raced keenly whilst being restrained off the heels of ALWAYS IN DA'NILE (L. Hopwood).

Approaching the 200 metres STURGIS (NZ) (J. Kah) shifted out in an attempt to improve to the outside of WHERE'S TIM (J. Holder) and in doing so brushed with SPARKLING VICTORY (T. Baker), which held its line.

Rounding the home turn C. Lever, the rider of HOLLWOOD AND VINE, accidentally dropped his off side rein and rolled in onto ALWAYS IN DA'NILE (L. Hopwood), which had to be steadied.

RACE 5 : LION NATHAN MARES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

On jumping away THE PRINCESS (D. Tourneur) was forced to lose its position when tightened between GLENARIFF (J. Kah), which shifted out slightly, and TORTOSA (J. Potter), which shifted in.

WICKED DREAMS (J. Matthews) shifted out on jumping away and brushed OUR LARA (L. Stojakovic).

OUR LARA (L. Stojakovic) raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

VISUAL IMPACT (C. Lindop) was held up from inside the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight when awkwardly placed on the heels of OUR LARA (L. Stojakovic), which had commenced to give ground.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres THE PRINCESS (D. Tourneur) shifted out to improve and in doing so made contact with the hindquarters of OUR LARA (L. Stojakovic), which was momentarily unbalanced.

GLENARIFF was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to the outside of the off hind leg. First Aid was administered.

RACE 6 : GLIDEROL CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

HARRY HIGH PANTS (S. Price) shifted out on jumping away brushing NIC'S BUDDY (A. Patterson).

TIGGY (B. Claridge) jumped away awkwardly.

MAID OF FINNISS (J. Kah) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MAID OF FINNISS (J. Kah) made the home turn awkwardly and shifted out slightly onto NIC'S BUDDY (A. Patterson), which was taken out onto CURACA HILL (C. Lindop), which had to be steadied momentarily and was taken wider on the track.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow C. Lindop, the rider of the third placegetter CURACA HILL, to view the official footage from the vicinity of the 400 metres.

RACE 7 : BETFAIR RATING 0-81 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

RUSSIAN JAR (IRE) (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres RING ME NOT (J. Toeroek) shifted in and made contact with the running rail.

From the vicinity of the 800 metres until inside the 600 metres RUSSIAN JAR (IRE) (P. Gatt) raced keenly whilst being restrained off the heels of TASTEOFENERGY (T. Pannell).

J. Toeroek, the rider of RING ME NOT, was advised of his obligations under ARR.137(b) in riding his mounts out to the end of the race.

RACE 8 : NATIONAL JOCKEYS TRUST RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

REGIMENTAL DANCE (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing JUST TESS (B. Claridge).

JUST TESS (B. Claridge) and ROYAL STORMY (J. Holder) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

From inside the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight MOUNT NANCY (T. Baker) became held up when it improved onto the heels of BLUEPOLES (D. Tourneur) and was awkwardly placed to the inside of REGIMENTAL DANCE (A. Herrmann), which held its line.

Approaching the 200 metres JUST TESS (B. Claridge) shifted in under pressure onto BIGBADBARRY (P. Gatt), which was taken in slightly, resulting in REGIMENTAL DANCE (A. Herrmann) having to be steadied off the heels of BIGBADBARRY. B. Claridge was severely reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mount straight when they commence to shift ground.
