**RACE 1 : AUSTIN CONDON MEMORIAL – (LAURA RACING CLUB) / JOINERS ARMS HOTEL / NORTH LAURA HOTEL RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1000 metres**

On arrival at the barriers SHEPHERDS TALE had to be resaddled.

KING RODNEY (M. Schrapel) reared as the gates opened and was slow to begin.

BLUZAR (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly.

PERFECT BEAU (W. Kerford) was slow to begin.

SPECULATE (M. Henderson), which over-raced in the early and middle stages, hung out rounding the home turn and continued to do so in the straight.

**RACE 2 : KELLY TOYOTA / REDDEN BROS / WELKE TRANSPORT / JAMESTOWN CONTAINER DEPOT / MURRAY PEST CONTROL JAMESTOWN / CALTOWIE SHEDS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres**

UBER COOL (T. O'Donnell) and DELICIOUS SHOT (C. Ellis) were slow to begin.

L. Stojakovic, the rider of SHE'S MOLLY, which performed below expectations, explained the mare had continuing throat problems and had previously undergone a throat operation. The stable thought the drop in class may suit the filly, however, the rider stated its effort had been disappointing. Mr. D. Clarken, the Trainer of SHE'S MOLLY, advised Stewards the filly may now be retired. SHE'S MOLLY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 3 : TAMINGA HOTEL / CLARE VALLEY RACING CLUB RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1340 metres**

PITTSFIELD (W. Kerford) was slow to begin.

J. Toeroek, the rider of THORNY DEVIL, reported his mount had a tendency to over-race in the early stages of the event.

**RACE 4 : BUNDALEER WINES / CALTOWIE CRANE HIRE / CALTOWIE METAL  
FABRICATION / JOSLIN FAMILY & SPORTS CHIROPRACTIC /  
GEORGETOWN HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1340 metres**

HALOS LITTLE HUSSY (C. Ellis) stood flat-footed as the gates were released, refused to jump and did not take any part in the event. HALOS LITTLE HUSSY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to the tongue. Mr. D. Penna, the Trainer of HALOS LITTLE HUSSY, was advised the mare would be required to prove it can jump away with the field in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

On jumping away ORDYNKSI'S HILL (T. O'Donnell) and ALJEUNEE (W. Kerford) brushed.

On jumping away SAL'S SHINKO (T. Zanker) and FLIMFLAMMERY (L. Stojakovic) brushed.

ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD (M. Tyndall) jumped away awkwardly.

DEHAVILLAND DIVA (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly and brushed BRAY VIEW (J. Toeroek).

J. Toeroek, the rider of BRAY VIEW, reported his mount raced greenly throughout the event.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow M. Henderson, the rider of the second placegetter CHAMPAGNE KRIS, to view the official image for first.

Correct Weight was further delayed to allow Stewards to review the official footage of the start to ascertain whether HALOS LITTLE HUSSY (C. Ellis) was an official stater. After considering a report from the Starter, evidence provided by C. Ellis, the rider, and viewing the footage, the Stewards determined HALOS LITTLE HUSSY to be a runner.

**RACE 5 : CARLTON UNITED BREWERY / MAX CRANES / QUALITY RURAL  
JAMESTOWN CUP - 1800 metres**

MUSTY SPRINGS (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto FRAACHARM (W. Kerford) resulting in MUSTY SPRINGS being inconvenienced.

CROSS CONSTANCE (E. Boyd) shifted in under pressure in the straight onto MISS BALL (L. Stojakovic) and bumped on several occasions.

C. Ellis, the rider of OKAMAN, reported her mount laid out throughout the event.

**RACE 6 : KLR LANDMARK / SWAN PHARMACIES / JAMESTOWN COUNTRY RETREAT /  
IAN SMITH / COMMERCIAL HOTEL / WEBBS TYRES / REDDEN BROS /  
RYNNE HOME HARDWARE RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

JEWEL OF CADENCE, which struck the gate when leaving the mounting yard, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at barriers and passed fit to start.

MIAMI INK (M. Tyndall) was slow to begin.

IAN SMITH / COMMERCIAL HOTEL / WEBBS TYRES / REDDEN BROS /

E. Boyd, rider of REGAL RUBEN, reported her mount hung out from approximately the 600 metres until entering the straight.
