

THOROUGHBRED RACING SA LIMITED

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

MORPHETTVILLE – FRIDAY, 12 OCTOBER 2012

Stewards have inquired into the substances 11-nor-delta-9-tetrahydocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid, d,l-amphetamine and d-methamphetamine being detected in a urine sample provided by licensed track work rider, Darren Forrest at Morphettville on Saturday, 30 June 2012.

Evidence was taken from Darren Forrest and reports tendered by a medical expert and Mr S Willers, Senior Analytical Chemist, Racing Analytical Services Limited, in relation to this sample, were considered.

After considering the evidence taken, Darren Forrest pleaded guilty to an offence under ARR.81A(1) in that the sample he provided contained 11-nor-delta-9-tetrahydocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid, d,l-amphetamine and d-methamphetamine, substances banned under ARR.81B. He was suspended from riding track work from 16 July 2012, the date on which he was stood down following notification of the irregularity, until midnight 16 January 2013, a period of 6 months.

He was informed that under ARR.81A(4) he could only resume riding track work after providing a urine sample free of banned substances.

Darren Forrest was advised of his right of appeal.
