**RACE 1 : GIPSIE JACK WINES MAIDEN PLATE - 2050 metres**

HALOS LITTLE HUSSY, which was reluctant to leave the mounting yard, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and ruled fit to race.

IMAGINARIUM (K. Bishop) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto REGAL JASMINE (NZ) (T. Zanker), which was inconvenienced.

HALOS LITTLE HUSSY (L. Stojakovic) was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start PORTFOLIO (D. Tourneur), which was inclined to lay in, shifted in and tightened PACK SADDLE (M. Kelly) onto JUNOOD (C. Lindop), resulting in PACK SADDLE being inconvenienced and the hindquarters of JUNOOD being turned.

IMAGINARIUM (K. Bishop) pulled hard for a short distance in the vicinity of the 1300 metres.

PORTFOLIO, which laid in, in the early stages of the event, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

VIKING EXPRESS (NZ), which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 2 : ANGAS PLAINS WINES / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE –**  
**1350 metres**

OUR RUBY (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing BON CHERIE (J. Kah).

LADY SONRO (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly.

SO MANY PENNIES (T. Pannell) laid out in the straight when under pressure.

J. Holder, the rider of OUR RUBY, explained he had no specific instructions and was comfortable with the position he obtained in running. He stated the mare had every opportunity on straightening but failed to respond in the manner he expected and performed disappointingly. OUR RUBY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

### **RACE 3 : PEATS SOIL & GARDEN SUPPLIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres**

AUTUMNAL (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted MINAVILLA (D. Tourneur), which shifted back in, contacting AUTUMNAL. After contacting AUTUMNAL, MINAVILLA raced very greenly and continued to shift in, tightening AUTUMNAL onto the hindquarters of ABLUDAY (S. Cahill), resulting in AUTUMNAL racing in restricted room for a short distance. Thereafter MINAVILLA shifted out abruptly onto JEST A JILLY (C. Lever), inconveniencing that filly when tightened onto JANICE MAY (J. Potter), which was taken wider. MINAVILLA, which continued to race greenly, then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres EMILY BELLE (J. Holder) improved onto the heels of AUTUMNAL (C. Lindop) and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

Shortly after straightening AUTUMNAL (C. Lindop) rolled in and inconvenienced LECHENAULTIA (J. Matthews).

JEST A JILLY (C. Lever) laid in, in the straight, resulting in C. Lever having to stop riding and straighten his mount in the vicinity of the 100 metres. JEST A JILLY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Ms. K. Huxtable, the Trainer of JEST A JILLY, advised the filly would now be spelled.

MINAVILLA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. B. Mueller, the Trainer of MINAVILLA, advised the filly would now be spelled.

### **RACE 4 : LAKE BREEZE WINES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres**

The Thoroughbred Identification Card (TIC) for TRULY NORTH was not available for inspection and as Stewards were able to identify the gelding from their own records, TRULY NORTH was permitted to start. Mr. D. Jolly, the Trainer of TRULY NORTH, was fined \$50 under ARR.59A for failing to produce the TIC for inspection.

TRULY NORTH, which shifted its off fore plate prior to entering the mounting yard, was re-shod and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers who ruled the gelding fit to race.

DELTA STAR (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and made contact with MR PURRFECT (J. Holder), which was tightened onto DR JEKYLL (J. Potter), which in turn was tightened onto BUSH GEM (S. Westover), resulting in MR PURRFECT, DR JEKYLL and BUSH GEM making contact for a number of strides.

Approaching the 900 metres DR JEKYLL (J. Potter) raced in restricted room for a short distance inside BUSH GEM (S. Westover) and behind MR PURRFECT (J. Holder) and got its head up and raced ungenerously.

DR JEKYLL, which weakened in the straight, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slow recovery.

### **RACE 5 : BROTHERS IN ARMS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

The start of this race was slightly delayed owing to the Clerk of the Course having to proceed to an area of the track in the vicinity of the 600 metres to ensure the removal of ducks in the area.

On jumping away SUKI (J. Holder) and LOVE A GIGGLE (D. Tourneur) shifted ground resulting in TESTANOVA (M. Pegus) being tightened and inconvenienced.

LOVE A GIGGLE (D. Tourneur) raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

### **RACE 5 : BROTHERS IN ARMS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)**

In the vicinity of the 400 metres FLYING HANKERCHIEF (J. Toeroek) became held up and awkwardly placed on the heels of PRINCESS ZIETTA (C. Ellis), which weakened, and was severely hampered and unable to obtain clear running until in the vicinity of the 200 metres, where it was obliged to shift out to gain clear ground.

T. Baker, the rider of AMBITIOUS BRIDE, was dislodged from his mount on pulling up. T. Baker was uninjured in the incident.

### **RACE 6 : LANGHORNE CREEK GRAPE AND WINE VIGNERONS' CUP - 1600 metres**

On a request on arrival on course from Mr. K. Sweeney, the Trainer of JEUNEALISTIC, the gelding was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported abrasions to its head and ruled JEUNEALISTIC fit to race.

THE SHAMAN (A. Patterson) was slow to begin.

OWDATAY (E. Boyd) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

D. Tourneur, the rider of ACE OR JOKA, reported his mount felt awkward in its action behind and for that reason he did not persevere with his riding over the concluding stages. ACE OR JOKA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

### **RACE 7 : BREMERTON CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

DAYLIGHT'S DAUPHIN, which had not raced since September 2011, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to race.

GENARKA STAR (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SILENT ROCK (L. Hopwood), which was tightened onto COLLA VOCE (C. Lever). At the same time GOD'S WAY (J. Kah) was taken in by SALAME VELOCE (J. Maund), resulting in COLLA VOCE and GOD'S WAY being severely hampered and losing their positions.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres FORT CHAUVEL (C. Lindop) became held up on the heels of DAMAGES (E. Boyd) for a number of strides and was obliged to alter course to the outside of DAMAGES to obtain clear running.

At the entrance to the straight SILENT ROCK (L. Hopwood) rolled out taking SALAME VELOCE (J. Maund) and COLLA VOCE (C. Lever) wide into the straight.

MOUNT NANCY lost its near side winker shortly after passing the winning post. Mr. P. Moody, the Trainer of MOUNT NANCY, was spoken to with regard to the winkers fitted to the gelding and was advised to obtain a new set.

### **RACE 8 : BLEASDALE VINEYARDS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

The start of this race was slightly delayed owing to PINT MUG proving fractious in its barrier after being loaded. PINT MUG was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to start.

SLACKSMITH (NZ) (J. Potter) was slow to begin.

WHERE'S THAT (S. Westover) laid in after entering the straight placing its rider at a disadvantage in its run to the finish.

WHY NOT YOU and RISE ABOVE IT were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
