# THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

# Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 28 November 2012

TRACK: Dead 4 (Upgraded to Good 3 at 11.00 am) WEATHER: Fine

RAIL: Out 4 metres 800m to 400m, 1 metre 1700m to 1500m, true remainder.

#### RACE 1: ADELAIDE IMAGE PRINTING / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2109 metres

VIKING EXPRESS (NZ) (J. Frew) shifted out on jumping away and brushed BLENHEIM BELLE (J. Potter).

VIKING EXPRESS (NZ) (J. Frew) raced keenly in the middle stages whilst being restrained.

KYBY LADY (M. Neilson) was unable to obtain clear ground from the vicinity of the 500 metres when racing behind BLAZING MAX (S. Price) and inside PIERREMONT ROCKS (C. Lever) until inside the 300 metres when able to alter course to the outside of PIERREMONT ROCKS and BLENHEIM BELLE (J. Potter).

Approaching the 200 metres BLAZING MAX (S. Price) shifted in and away from PIERREMONT ROCKS (C. Lever), which shifted in under pressure, brushing VIKING EXPRESS (NZ) (J. Frew).

## RACE 2: JACOBS CREEK RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2109 metres

HONG KONG MISSY (J. Toeroek) was slow to begin.

KING ROSELAND (L. Hopwood) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

MASTER ROBBIE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SIR GWYNN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slow recovery and signs of minor heat stress. First Aid was administered.

#### RACE 3: LYNAS VALLEY JEEP BAROSSA MAIDEN PLATE - 1109 metres

BIG WEEKEND (J. Toeroek) reared on jumping away.

LE ROYHAIF (J. Bowditch) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, making contact with GOD'S CHILD (J. Maund) and shortly after was inconvenienced when taken back in onto STING LIKE A BEE (K. Bishop).

STING LIKE A BEE (K. Bishop) hung out rounding the home turn. STING LIKE A BEE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

At the entrance to the straight LAST DAY (NZ) (J. Holder) shifted out to improve and brushed GOD'S CHILD (J. Maund), resulting in that filly having to be steadied momentarily when awkwardly placed on the heels of WITHOUT FACE (M. Pegus).

### RACE 3: LYNAS VALLEY JEEP BAROSSA MAIDEN PLATE - 1109 metres (Cont'd)

J. Toeroek, the rider of BIG WEEKEND, reported the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

SMUG lost its off hind plate during the event.

#### RACE 4: WATERSEARCH MARES 0-68 HANDICAP - 1109 metres

NOONDIE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers as J. Bowditch was concerned with the mare's action and ruled fit to race.

SPARKLING BELLA (J. Matthews), SUKI (J. Holder) and NOONDIE (J. Bowditch) jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the 800 metres MAGICAL RUBY (D. Tourneur), which was racing fiercely when awkwardly placed inside the heels of NOONDIE (J. Bowditch), shifted in slightly onto WYARA MISS (J. Frew), which was inconvenienced when taken in and contacting the running rail.

STELLA JEUNE (J. Toeroek) raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

NOONDIE (J. Bowditch) laid out under pressure from the vicinity of the 600 metres. NOONDIE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Matthews, the rider of SPARKLING BELLA, which performed poorly, explained after beginning awkwardly, the mare failed to respond to his riding in the early stages and was reluctant to race. He added that after being placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, SPARKLING BELLA failed to respond to his riding and in his opinion performed disappointingly. SPARKLING BELLA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

# RACE 5 : LYNAS AUTO GROUP BAROSSA / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE 1209 metres

MOLLIE MAE (L. Stojakovic) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing SENSATIONAL CARD (M. Pegus).

BRIMARVI DUE FACE (D. Tourneur) shifted out making the turn inside the 800 metres onto FIDDY SCENTS (K. Bishop), which was tightened onto DESTINY VENGEANCE (A. Herrmann), which shifted out and away, inconveniencing MOLLIE MAE (L. Stojakovic) and JUST A SPARK (J. Maund), which were both taken very wide on the track.

BUTTERFLY QUEEN lost its off fore plate during the event.

### RACE 6: HOLIATT DAANT ACCOUNTANTS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1509 metres

KATH'S SECRET, which was fractious in the float en route to the course, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival who reported abrasions to both hind legs and ruled the filly unfit to race. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew KATH'S SECRET at 12.50 pm.

Mr. M. Hickmott, the Trainer of GARNESH, advised Stewards he would instruct Jockey S. Cahill to be positive in the early stages of the event and attempt to have the gelding in a more forward position than in its most recent starts.

# RACE 6: HOLIATT DAANT ACCOUNTANTS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1509 metres (Cont'd)

BON TON, which was fractious, dislodged its rider M. Neilson at arrival at the barriers. BON TON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to race. M. Neilson was uninjured in the incident.

BON TON (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly.

BON TON (M. Neilson) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event and was inclined to shift about.

OUTRAGEOUS MAN (K. Bishop) was held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight when racing on the heels of TELLURIUM (B. Claridge) and inside GARNESH (S. Cahill).

TELLURIUM (B. Claridge) was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

Approaching the finish SHADY JADE (D. Tourneur) shifted out under pressure, inconveniencing GARNESH (S. Cahill), which was taken wider.

M. Neilson, the rider of BON TON, reported he had difficulty controlling the filly throughout the event. BON TON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GENIALITY, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 7: BAROSSA CUP - 1509 metres

LE COLUMBIA (E. Boyd) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

NOBLE ROMP (J. Maund) was held up when awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of COLONIAL (NZ) (J. Frew) from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres and when shifting out to obtain clear ground, made contact with JUST PUSH ON (T. Pannell), which was inconvenienced when its hindquarters were turned out.

Inside the 200 metres STYLISH SPENDER (B. Claridge) shifted out and brushed LE COLUMBIA (E. Boyd).

D. Tourneur, the rider of ECLAIR RALLY (NZ), explained the gelding had raced more keenly than he had hoped in the early and middle stages of the event, which in his opinion was due to the step up in distance. He added he had asked ECLAIR RALLY (NZ) for an effort in the straight, however, the gelding had not responded as he had expected. ECLAIR RALLY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported signs of heat stress. First Aid was administered.

### RACE 8 : COOPERS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1209 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to the bit on DAKADAN PRINCESS having to be re-adjusted after the mare was loaded.

JEULUNA (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, making heavy contact with DAKADAN PRINCESS (S. Cahill), which was hampered and lost its position.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres LADY PHOENIX (K. Bishop) shifted out to improve and brushed with CUTE TO BOOT (M. Neilson) on a number of occasions.

## RACE 8: COOPERS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1209 metres (Cont'd)

S. Cahill, the rider of DAKADAN PRINCESS, explained that after being interfered with at the start, the mare had raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and was under pressure approaching the 600 metres and finished the race off poorly. DAKADAN PRINCESS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities
