THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Friday, 7 December 2012

Stewards: M. Santoro (A/Chairman) & S. Callanan (HT) (Stewards), P. Dearman, R. Evans

TRACK: Good 3 WEATHER: Fine/Hot

RAIL: Out 1 metre home turn to Winning Post. True remainder.

RACE 1 : ALLIANCE ONE CREDIT UNION / SABOIS 3YO RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HEAVENS SHOUT (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing HANK'S NEPHEW (E. Boyd).

FREIGHT QUEEN (P. Roff) was slow to begin.

OUR BECCA (J. Potter) was slow into stride.

HOST WITH THE MOST (E. Brooks) made the home turn awkwardly and dipped on a couple of occasions in the straight. HOST WITH THE MOST was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

DEBEERSONUS (S. Cahill) laid in under pressure in the straight. DEBEERSONUS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be shin sore.

RACE 2: CARLTON DRAUGHT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

FORESHORE MAK (T. Pannell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, tightening SHE'SMISUNDERSTOOD (J. Potter) onto MUMAJET (A. Patterson), which shifted in slightly.

MEADOWS BOO (K. Bishop) was unable to obtain clear ground from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight when racing in restricted room to the inside of WHERE HEARTS LIE (T. Baker).

DANCING MARY (T. Zanker) made the home turn awkwardly and shifted wider on the track.

Approaching the 100 metres MEADOWS BOO (K. Bishop) had to be steadied when attempting a run between the heels of TRUTHS (S. Westover), which rolled out marginally, and SO MANY PENNIES (S. Cahill), which shifted in under riding. S. Cahill was reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten his mounts when they commence to shift.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Bishop, the rider of the third placegetter MEADOWS BOO, to view the official footage in the straight. After doing K. Bishop lodged an objection against SO MANY PENNIES (S. Cahill) being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference in the vicinity of the 100 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* K. Bishop's objection.

RACE 3: MORPHETTVILLE EQUINE CLINIC RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

THE CHAMPION (T. Baker) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event whilst being restrained.

In the vicinity of the 1300 metres JUST PURE FUN (J. Potter), which was racing on the heels of THE CHAMPION (T. Baker), had to be steadied when it improved onto that gelding's heels.

DANTE'S BEST (T. Zanker) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

From the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight MONTALTO (P. Roff) had difficulty obtaining clear ground when awkwardly placed between the heels of EL TORO (A. Patterson) and DASHAGH (E. Boyd).

MUSTY SPRINGS (B. Claridge) laid in under pressure in the straight and inside the 200 metres shifted in onto MONTALTO (P. Roff), which had to be steadied when tightened onto DASHAGH (E. Boyd), which shifted out slightly. In the incident MONTALTO was accidentally struck on the head by the whip of E. Boyd, the rider of DASHAGH. B. Claridge was severely reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten sooner than he had on this occasion.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow P. Roff, the rider of the second placegetter MONTALTO, to view the official vision in the straight.

THE CHAMPION and MEADOWS MAGIC, which performed poorly, were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : GRANOSITE TEXTURE SOLUTION RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SILVER CITY BOY (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

On jumping away DESTONY HAWK (L. Hopwood) shifted out onto HUNTED ANGEL (D. Tourneur), which was inconvenienced.

BUDDY FANTASTIC (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly.

MISS HARREB (T. Zanker) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

HUNTED ANGEL (D. Tourneur) was held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight when racing behind STRANGMEAD (T. Baker) and inside of OUR DESTINATION (K. Bishop).

Approaching the finish HUNTED ANGEL (D. Tourneur) shifted out onto OUR DESTINATION (K. Bishop), which was taken wider.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow the Stewards to view the official footage over the concluding stages.

RACE 5: THE WATTYL GROUP RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

OUTLOOK EXPRESS (E. Brooks) shifted out on jumping away and contacted NO VACANCY (L. Hopwood).

MEMORY COVE (T. Pannell) and NABALI (E. Boyd) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 5: THE WATTYL GROUP RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

From the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight VENTIC (J. Toeroek) was held up when racing on the heels of NO VACANCY (L. Hopwood) and inside MEMORY COVE (T. Pannell) and shortly after straightening, in the vicinity of the 200 metres, shifted to the outside of the heels of NO VACANCY to improve and in doing so inconvenienced MEMORY COVE. J. Toeroek was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

RACE 6: JOHN MARMION MEMORIAL RATING 60 AND OVER HANDICAP - 1250 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute owing to B. Claridge being dislodged from OUT FOR LUNCH en route to the start. OUT FOR LUNCH was quickly captured and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers who ruled the gelding fit to race.

GENEROUS HUKA (NZ) (K. Bishop) was slow to begin.

MUMSLAD (E. Boyd) and MISS ELIZA (S. Westover) came together and bumped on jumping away.

Inside the 1000 metres MISS ELIZA (S. Westover) dipped for no apparent reason and rolled in onto TESTATE (P. Roff), which had to be steadied momentarily.

MUMSLAD (E. Boyd) and GENEROUS HUKA (NZ) (K. Bishop) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

E. Boyd, the rider of MUMSLAD, accidentally dropped her whip in the vicinity of the 100 metres. She was reprimanded under ARR.137(a) and advised that future carelessness may result in a penalty being imposed.

B. Claridge, the rider of OUT FOR LUNCH, which performed poorly, reported to Stewards he was concerned with the gelding's action in the straight and in his opinion the gelding felt sore. Stewards ordered OUT FOR LUNCH be examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, however, the gelding had left the course prior to being examined. Mr. T. Dawson, the Trainer of OUT FOR LUNCH, was advised to report any abnormalities to Stewards on return to his stables.

RACE 7: LAWRENCE & HANSON RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

PROPSHAFT (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out abruptly, contacting JACKIE'S PAPER (L. Hopwood).

FRENCH ACADEMY (P. Roff) was slow to begin and shortly after was inconvenienced by MIGHTY MOMENT (S. Cahill), which shifted out abruptly.

FRENCH ACADEMY (P. Roff) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

PRIMAL INSTINCT (S. Westover) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Inside the 1000 metres LOW CUT (L. Stojakovic) had to be steadied off the heels of ATTITUDE PROBLEM (A. Patterson), resulting in PROPSHAFT (J. Potter), which was racing behind LOW CUT, having to be steadied and in doing so shifted out onto MIGHTY MOMENT (S. Cahill), which was inconvenienced. An inquiry into this incident was adjourned to a date to be fixed to permit riders to make a scheduled return flight to Adelaide.

Inside the 400 metres JACKIE'S PAPER (L. Hopwood) had to check when tightened between PRIMAL INSTINCT (S. Westover), which improved quickly to that gelding's inside and rolled in, at the same time as FRENCH ACADEMY (P. Roff) improved to its inside and rolled out slightly. S. Westover was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

RACE 7: LAWRENCE & HANSON RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1350 metres (Cont'd)

SONO PICCOLO and JACKIE'S PAPER, which performed poorly, were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
